LEADING OFF: Scranton/Wilkes-Barre edged Charlotte 4-3 on Sunday in a rain-shortened, six-inning contest. The RailRiders scored three times in the top of the third on an L.J. Mazzilli sac fly, an RBI double by Kyle Higashioka and a run-scoring single from Mike Ford. Zack Zehner hit a solo home run in the fourth to extend the lead. The Knights scored three in the bottom of the fourth to cut the lead to one. The rain began in the fourth, the game went into a delay two batters into the sixth inning, and ultimately, was completed early. Brody Koerner earned the win while T.J. House took the loss. The RailRiders took three out of four in the series in Charlotte.

TOP HONORS: Gleyber Torres was honored by the International League earlier today as its Player of the Week for April 5-15. The infielder appeared in all ten games, batting .385 with 15 hits over 39 at-bats with one home runs and ten runs batted in. He started nine games and was used as a pinch hitter in the other. His 22 total bases are tied for second in the league while his ten runs batted in are second behind teammate Abiatal Avelino.

MATCH GAME: The RailRiders have matched their second-best start since becoming a New York Yankees affiliate before the 2007 season. The 2009 club began the season with ten wins over their first ten games. The 2018 edition has matched the 2008 and 2016 teams with its 7-3 start.

GONE FISHIN': The RailRiders play their first ever series against the Stripers tonight. During the off-season, the Gwinnett Braves changed their team identity to the Stripers. Scranton/ Wilkes-Barre has gone 42-25 against Gwinnett dating back to the 2009 campaign when the Richmond Braves moved to Georgia.

BOTTOMS UP: The bottom third of the RailRiders raked during the Charlotte series. In the four-game set, the combination of Zack Zehner, Erik Kratz, Rashad Crawford and Abiatal Avelino have gone 20-43 (.465) with three home runs, 14 runs scored and 14 runs batted in from the seven-eight-nine spots of the batting order.

EVERYDAY PEOPLE: Six players have seen action in all nine games this season. Mike Ford, Ryan McBroom, Billy Fleming, Zack Zehner and Abiatal Avelino have started all eight games, while Gleyber Torres was used as a pinch hitter in the only game he didn't start. Cody Asche played in the first eight and had last night off.

BACK TO SWB: Luis Cessa was optioned to the RailRiders on Sunday and Shane Peterson was outrighted to Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. Both players have yet to report and countermoves will need to be made by New York to clear roster space. Cessa did not appear in a game with the RailRiders prior to being recalled. Robinson, however, played in two games over the opening homestand and went 2-8.

HERE AND GONE: Prior to Sunday's RailRiders game, the Yankees transferred infielder Daniel Barrios to Extended Spring Training and added right-handed pitcher Paul Young from Extended Spring. Barrios appeared in three games for the RailRiders, though only had one hitless at-bat. Young was signed as a Minor League Free Agent last August and appeared in one game for Staten Island in the New York-Penn League.

OFF THE RAILS: Kyle Higashioka has hit safely in all seven games he has played in this season. The catcher had one hit in each of his first six games and had two yesterday over three at-bats... Mike Ford is now riding a seven-game hitting streak and a nine-game on-base streak. The eight-game run is the longest by a RailRiders player in 2018 and goes back to day two of the season... Abiatal Avelino had seven runs batted in the Charlotte series and leads the International League with 11 RBI this year. The infielder drove in a career-best five runs on Thursday in the win at Charlotte... Jace Peterson was designated for assignment on April 10 and has elected to become a free agent...

AROUND THE ORGANIZATION: New York had both halves of a doubleheader in Detroit postponed. The Yankees are back at home against the Marlins tonight... Trenton's game at Akron was postponed due to rain. The Thunder open a series in Erie tonight... Tampa topped Fort Myers 6-1 in a rain-shortened, seven-inning game... Charleston's game against Kannapolis was postponed due to impending weather.
