SNAPPER SNIPPETS

LATE HEROICS: With the win in their last at-bat on Friday night, the Snappers have come through with 8 victories via a run scored in their last trip to the plate. 4 of those wins have been walk-off winners at home. **Nate Mondou's** go-ahead triple in the 11th was his 3rd game-winning hit of the year.

RIGHT OFF THE BUS: The road trip to Quad Cities is Beloit's 6th of the season. The Snappers have had good success in the First Half in the first game of those trips & are now 4-2 in road trip openers.

TRENDS TO WATCH: Beloit has scored 5 runs or more in 22 games this season & are 19-3 when they hit that plateau. The Snappers have also won their last 16 games in which they have hit at least 1 home run & are 9-1 when they hit multiple dingers in the same game. However, the Snappers have the 2nd-lowest total of homers on the road with 11 while Burlington & Lansing have each hit only 9 home runs when playing as visitors.

.500 DAYS OF SUMMER: After bouncing between .500 & 2 games below for a month, the Snappers now have a winning record for the first time since April 8 when they won their 3rd game of the year to move to 2-1. **Nate Mondou** hit a go-ahead RBI triple in that game at Cedar Rapids as he did last night in Davenport.

ALL ABOARD: With a pair of hits on Friday night, Eric Marinez has reached base in his last 19 games played to pull one game shy of the team's longest on-base streak of the season, 20 consecutive games by **Nate Mondou**. **JaVon Shelby** has also been on in his last 18 games while **Edwin Diaz** has gotten on in his last 15 games giving Snappers hitters 3 of the 6 longest active on-base streaks in the Midwest League. The Midwest League's longest active streak is 21 games by **Fernando Tatis Jr.**

DIAZ DIALED IN: **Edwin Diaz** has quietly beefed up the bottom of the Beloit order over the last 10 days. Diaz has hit safely in his last 7 games & matches his longest hitting streak in a Snappers uniform after he hit in 7 consecutive games from July 22-28, 2016.

HIT MACHINES: **Luke Persico** & **Nate Mondou** lead the Snappers & are 2nd & 3rd in the A's system in hitting. They each have a team-best 14 multi-hit games.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: **Brendan Butler** takes the mound today for his 8th start of the season. Butler is 2nd among pitchers in the Athletics Minor League system in both ERA (2.03) & strikeouts (51). Teammate **Dalton Sawyer** leads the organization in ERA (2.00) & top pitching prospect **A.J. Puk** paces Oakland's system in punch outs (61). Butler has one of just 2 quality starts by Beloit starters this season & one of 4 total pitching performances to go 6 innings or more.

FACING THE RIVER BANDITS: The Snappers will visit Quad Cities for a crucial series to jostle for position in the Western Division. Beloit was 2-5 in Davenport in 2016. The River Bandits carry 6 of the Astros top-30 prospects according to MLB.com with pitchers **Forrest Whitley** (#3) & **Cionel Perez** (#15) along with position players **Daz Cameron** (#6), **Ronnie Dawson** (#17), **Stephen Wrenn** (#24), & **Yordan Alvarez** (#26).
