TODAY'S GAME: Your Rancho Cucamonga Quakes take on the Lancaster JetHawks (Colorado Rockies affiliate) of the South Division tonight in the final game of a four-game set with the Lancaster (JetHawks lead series 2-1). The Quakes are back out on the road after a brief visit home for three games against the Lake Elsinore Storm. Rancho Cucamonga ended up sweeping the Storm and the Quakes were riding a four-game winning streak into this series against Lancaster. The Quakes will return home on Friday (4/21) for the first of three with the Inland Empire 66ers.

PITCHING RETURNS FOR QUAKES IN WIN: Runs were plentiful in the first two games of the series against Lancaster. That was not the case last night's 2-1 victory for the Quakes. Caleb Ferguson struggled in his third start of the season, but only allowed one run despite walking five and hitting a batter in three and two-thirds innings. Tony Gonsolin (1-0) came on in relief and earned the win in his first appearance with the Quakes. After allowing a single to his first batter, he retired 10 straight in three and a third innings. Shea Spitzbarth picked up his third save of the season by striking out four in two scoreless frames. On the offensive side, the Quakes tied the game in the seventh on a solo home run by Will Smith and two batters later, took the lead on a home run by Ariel Sandoval. Smith led the way with three hits and was a triple away from the cycle. Max Schuh (0-2) was tagged with the loss for the JetHawks.

TODAY'S MOVES: While there are no moves today, the Dodgers' system has been busy lately. Yesterday, the Quakes had four roster moves. Infielder Erick Mejia was transferred to Double-A Tulsa and RHP Chris Powell was transferred to Extended Spring Training in Arizona. Rancho added RHP Chris Mathewson from Extended Spring Training and infielder Zach McKinstry from Class-A Great Lakes. On Tuesday, right-handed pitcher Tony Gonsolin (from Single-A Great Lakes) and catcher Garrett Hope (from Extended Spring Training) joined the team. On Sunday, Yadier Alvarez joined the Quakes from Extended Spring Training and Kevin Brown was moved to the DL. Outfielder Logan Landon was moved to Double-A Tulsa and Gavin Pittore was placed on the DL.

WILL SMITH STARTING TO HEAT UP: With a 3-for-4 day yesterday, the Quakes' catcher is now 6-for-12 in this series with a couple runs scored and a pair of RBIs. He now has four extra-base hits in the last four games (two doubles, a triple and a home run). He has increased his batting average from .211 to .314 during his four-game hitting streak.

DENNIS SANTANA TAKES THE HILL FOR RANCHO: Santana was signed by the Dodgers out of San Pedro de Macoris, Dominican Republic for the start of the 2015 season. At just 18 years old, Santana debuted in Rookie-Level Ogden before playing in the Arizona League. During his second season, he spent the entire year with Class-A Great Lakes and dominated in the first half of the season. His efforts as a starter earned a nod as a Midwest League mid-season All-Star. Starting on July 13th, Santana was moved to the bullpen for Great Lakes and made 10 appearances out of the pen the rest of the way. In his first start of this season, he ran into bad luck. He gave up three unearned runs in the fourth inning and picked up the loss. In his second start, he yielded another unearned run in the Quakes' win. He now sits with a record of 0-1, but he still has a 0.00 ERA.

OPPOSING PITCHER: Carlos Polanco, also a San Pedros De Macoris, Dominican Republic native, is in his second full season in the California League after playing with Modesto last year. The 23-year-old was signed by the Rockies out of the DR in 2012 and has played in the organization ever since. For the Nuts last season, he went 2-7 in 18 appearances (15 starts) with a 4.57 ERA and 61 strikeouts to 50 walks in 69 innings pitched. This season, Polanco is 0-1 with a 5.40 ERA. He struggled his last time out as he just lasted two-thirds of an innings before giving up two runs on one hit, three walks and one hit batter. He received the loss in the game, a 9-2 win for Modesto.

NO-HITTER FOR WHITE AND HERM: History. Throughout the previous 24 seasons in Quakes history, there had never been a no-hitter. That changed on the night of April 7th, 2017. In the second game of the doubleheader, the Quakes sent Mitch White (the Dodgers' number 11 prospect according to MLB Pipeline.com) to the hill and he dominated in four shutout innings. He did not allow a hit and struck out five batters, but he did walk three. Then came Alex Hermeling. He sat the Ports down in order (nine up, nine down) in his three innings and completed the first no-no in franchise history by inducing a weak groundball back to him for the final out. Though it was just a seven inning no-hitter (due to MiLB double header rules), it will live on in the history books and it was a perfect way to start the 25th season in Quakes history. It was the 31st seven-inning no-hitter in California League history.
