Last Game: Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp right-hander Merandy Gonzalez pitched seven innings of one-run ball for a third straight start, while shortstop Joe Dunand had two hits and started three double plays in a 3-1 win over the Mississippi Braves in front of 3,504 at Publix Corks & Forks Wednesday at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. After Gonzalez (3-6) pitched a perfect first inning, the Jumbo Shrimp (18-27 second half, 46-67 overall) took the lead in the bottom of the first inning against Braves right-hander Elian Leyva (2-2). Right fielder Braxton Lee drew a leadoff walk, stole second base and scored when third baseman Brian Schales hit a two-out RBI single to right field. Dunand then doubled to center field, scoring Schales for a 2-0 Jacksonville lead. Jacksonville added a run when center fielder Monte Harrison led off the third inning with a solo home run to left field. Leyva did not allow another run in six innings, allowing six hits and one walk with seven strikeouts. Gonzalez retired the first nine Braves and held the 3-0 lead until the top of the fifth inning, when he began with a walk to Braves left fielder Travis Demeritte. First baseman Tyler Marlette then hit an RBI double to center field. Gonzalez kept the 3-1 lead by getting catcher Jonathan Morales on a foul popup, retiring Marlette in a rundown after fielding ground ball, and striking out Leyva with the tying runs on base. Gonzalez allowed four hits and one walk with four strikeouts. Jacksonville right-hander Kyle Keller worked around a leadoff walk with a strikeout and double play in a scoreless eighth inning. Right-hander Tommy Eveld worked around a hit and walk in a scoreless ninth inning for his second Southern League save and first as a Jumbo Shrimp in his Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville debut, giving Jacksonville its seventh win in the last 10 games.

NEWS AND NOTES

It's Neidert Day! The ace of the Jumbo Shrimp pitching staff in 2018, right-hander Nick Neidert takes the mound tonight for the Jumbo Shrimp against the Mississippi Braves. Neidert overall this season is 10-6 with a 2.95 ERA in his 21 starts, striking out 131 batters in his 125 innings of work. Neidert enters today's start leading the Southern League lead with 10 wins, and also is fourth in the league in ERA (2.95), second in strikeouts (131), and first innings pitched (125.0). In the Marlins minor league organization, Neidert leads with 10 wins, has the fourth-best ERA (2.95), and leads the organization with 131 strikeouts. Neidert is the Marlins No. 3 prospect according to MLB.com, and came to the Marlins organization from the Seattle Mariners last December in the Dee Gordon trade.

Home Run Harrison: Monte Harrison leads the Marlins organization with 15 home runs, homering last night for Jacksonville. Harrison has homered in the last two series for the Jumbo Shrimp. Last year he combined to hit 21 home runs for Wisconsin (11) and Carolina (10) while in the Brewers system.

Twine on Time: Justin Twine continues to swing a hot bat for the Jumbo Shrimp. Twine has hit safely in 17 of 18 games he's played for Jacksonville. Overall Twine is hitting .386 (27-for-70) with three home runs and 10 runs batted in, and 9 of the 17 games he's hit safely have been multi-hit games. Twine joined the Jumbo Shrimp on July 19 after the promotion of second baseman Isan Diaz to Triple-A New Orleans.

Braves Are Here: For the first time this season, Jacksonville's South Division foe the Mississippi Braves have made the trip to the Baseball Grounds. The Jumbo Shrimp are 5-6 this season against Mississippi, with all previous meetings at Trustmark Park in Pearl, Mississippi. After losing a five-game set in late May, Jacksonville and Mississippi split a six-game series in late June in the first series of the second half. Last season the Jumbo Shrimp posted a winning 12-8 record against the Braves, going 5-5 in 10 games at Trustmark Park, then going 7-3 against the Braves in Jacksonville.

Shrimp Have Prospects: On the roster, the Jumbo Shrimp have six players who were listed by *MLB.com* as Top 30 Miami Marlins prospects for the 2018 season: OF Monte Harrison (1), RHP Nick Neidert (3), OF Brian Miller (11), Joe Dunand (23), and Robert Dugger (24), and Braxton Lee (30).

TONIGHT'S JUMBO SHRIMP STARTING PITCHER

23 – NICK NEIDERT, RHP

10-6, 2.95 ERA, 21 games and 21 starts

2018: 10-6, 2.95 ERA (41 ER/125.1 IP) in 21 G and 21 GS.
CAREER: 28-17, 2.90 ERA (122 ER/379.0 IP) in 76 G and 76 GS.

LAST START: Neidert became the first pitcher in the Southern League or the Marlins organization to reach 10 wins when he earned a victory on Saturday August 4. Neidert worked eight innings, striking out a career-high 13 batters as he allowed just one run on five hits with no walks. Neidert enjoyed a dominant stretch from the second inning to the seventh where he set down 15 hitters in a row, including striking out seven straight batters which came just one strikeout shy of tying the Southern League for most consecutive strikeouts.

BAYBEARS WIN: Neidert earned his ninth win of the year in his start on Saturday July 28 against the Mobile BayBears at Hank Aaron Stadium. Neidert worked six and two-thirds innings where he allowed two runs on five hits with two walks and five strikeouts as Jacksonville won 7-4.

2018 S.L. ALL-STAR: Neidert was one of seven Jumbo Shrimp and four Jacksonville pitchers to be named a 2018 Southern League Midseason All-Star. On Tuesday June 19, Neidert worked a scoreless second inning against the North Division All-Stars, allowing a hit and striking out a batter as the South Division won 9-5 at Regions Field in Birmingham.

LAST BRAVES START: Neidert earned a victory in his start on Monday June 25 at Mississippi against the Braves. Neidert turned in seven innings where he allowed two runs (both earned) on six hits with a walk and three strikeouts as Jacksonville won 7-2.

NEIDERT RANKED: Neidert enters today's start leading the Southern League lead with 10 wins, and also is fourth in the league in ERA (2.95), second in strikeouts (131), and first innings pitched (125.0). In the Marlins minor league organization, Neidert leads with 10 wins, has the fourth-best ERA (2.95), and leads the organization with 131 strikeouts.

PROSPECT: Neidert enters the 2018 season as the Marlins No. 5 prospect according to Baseball America and is currently the No. 3 Marlins prospect according to MLB.com.

#23 NICK NEIDERT RHP | 6-1, 180 lbs | Born: Nov. 20, 1996 in Atlanta, Ga. 21 Years Old.

Acquired by the Miami Marlins in a trade with the Seattle Mariners with RHP Robert Duggar, INF Chris Torres in exchange for Dee Gordon on Dec. 7, 2017.

2017 Highlights: Named the California League Pitcher of the Year after going 10-3 with a 2.76 ERA in 19 starts for Single-A Modesto in Seattle's system. Was a California League Midseason and Postseason All-Star, going 5-3 with a 3.31 ERA in 14 starts before the break, then 5-0 with a 1.45 ERA in five starts after the break. Earned California League Pitcher of the Week honors for July 3-9 after tossing seven shutout innings on July 6 at Visalia. Finished the season at Double-A Arkansas, making Travelers debut on July 22. With Arkansas he was 1-3 with a 6.56 ERA in six starts. Lost first three starts for Arkansas, snapped skid with a win in his fifth start on August 12 against Midland.

2016 Highlights: Spent all of 2016 with Single-A Clinton in the Midwest League, going 7-3 with a 2.57 ERA in 19 starts. Went 6-1 with a 2.22 ERA over his first eight starts. Factored in just three decisions (1-2) over final 11 starts, despite allowing one-or-zero runs in eight of those outings. Won four consecutive starts from June 15-July 3, posting 2.67 ERA during that span, setting a career high with 12 strikeouts on June 23 vs. Kane County, and also had 11 on July 3 at Peoria.

2015 Highlights: After he was selected by the Seattle Mariners in the second round of the 2015 draft, made 11 starts for the AZL Mariners, going 0-2 with a 1.53 ERA. There he held opponents scoreless in six of 11 starts.

Personal: Attended Peachtree Ridge High School in Suwanee, Georgia. Selected as a First Team All-American and Southeastern All-Region First Team by Perfect Game in 2015. Had signed to pitch at the University of South Carolina before signing with Mariners.
