**Last Game:** The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp overcame a 3-0, seventh-inning deficit and a 4-3, 11th-inning deficit, before Mobile BayBears left fielder Zach Gibbons hit a go-ahead two-run triple and threw out the tying run in the 12th inning of a 6-5 Mobile win before 6,316 saw Saturday Night Fireworks at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Mobile (22-20) took the lead against Jacksonville right-hander Robert Dugger in the second inning. Catcher Michael Barash walked, and second baseman Connor Justus singled. Shortstop Riley Unroe hit a two-out ground ball to first baseman Eric Jagielo, whose throw Dugger missed near first base, scoring two runs. Mobile added a fifth-inning run, as first baseman Matt Thaiss doubled, stole third base and scored when designated hitter Jose Rojas hit into a fielder's choice for a 3-0 lead. In his Southern League debut, Dugger allowed three runs – one earned – on four hits and five walks with two strikeouts in 4 1/3 innings before giving way to right-hander Jorgan Cavanerio, who went 3 2/3 scoreless innings, with the help of left fielder Cade Gotta, who threw out Mobile third baseman Taylor Ward at home plate for the final out of the seventh inning. BayBears right-hander Alex Klonowski held Jacksonville to one hit through the first six innings. In the bottom of the seventh inning, Jacksonville center fielder Monte Harrison singled to right field and scored on Gotta's RBI double to left-center field. Against left-hander Conor Lillis-White, Jagielo hit an RBI single to right field. Right fielder John Norwood singled, and with two outs catcher Rodrigo Vigil hit a game-tying single to left-center field. The 3-3 tie remained through a scoreless 10th inning. In the 11th inning, Jacksonville right-hander Jose Pena (0-1) hit a batter and walked two others to score a run, but Gotta hit a game-tying double off BayBears right-hander Jeremy Rhoades (4-0). In the 12th inning, Gibbons hit a two-run triple off Pena for a 6-4 lead. In the bottom of the inning, third baseman Brian Schales hit an RBI single to left field, but Gibbons threw him out at second base. Right-hander Samil De Los Santos allowed two more hits before recording the final two outs with the tying and winning runs on base for his first save.

## NEWS AND NOTES

**Gotta Southern League Player of the Week:** Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp outfielder Cade Gotta has been named the Southern League Player of the Week for May 14-20, announced by the league office on Monday morning. Gotta over the past week hit .423 (11-for-26) with eight extra-base hits, five runs batted in, four doubles, three triples (in three consecutive games from May 14-16), a home run, three walks, and seven runs scored. Over the past week, Gotta led the league in extra-base hits (8), total bases (24), triples (3), slugging percentage (.923), on-base plus slugging percentage (1.406), and was tied for the league lead in doubles (4). Gotta enjoyed a dominant series against his former club the Montgomery Biscuits from May 12-16, where he had hits in every game and hit .474 (9-for-19) with a home run, two runs batted in, and three consecutive games with triples.

**Jumbo Shrimp Announce Roster Moves:** The Miami Marlins announced a pair of transactions that impact their Double-A affiliate Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp roster prior to Sunday's game against the Mobile BayBears at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville at 3:05 p.m. Jumbo Shrimp second baseman Isan Diaz has been placed on the disabled list with a concussion, retroactive to Friday May 18. Diaz has not played since Wednesday when he was hit in the helmet by a pitch against the Montgomery Biscuits. Diaz has played in 37 games for the Jumbo Shrimp, hitting .194 with four home runs and 13 RBI, and he is listed by MLB.com as the Miami Marlins No. 7 prospect. In a corresponding move, infielder Luis Pintor has been transferred from Marlins extended spring training to Jacksonville. Pintor had played earlier this season for High-A Jupiter, where in eight games he hit .207 (6-for-29) with no home runs and five runs batted in. Pintor, 22, is a native of Yabucoa, Puerto Rico, and this is the first call-up to the Double-A level in his career.

**Goodbye BayBears:** Today's doubleheader wraps up the second of four series this season between the Jumbo Shrimp and the Mobile BayBears, the Double-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Angels. Earlier this season the Jumbo Shrimp won three out of four games played in the first home series of the year from April 11-14. The game on Sunday April 15 was postponed due to rain, creating the need for a doubleheader on Friday May 18. This is the last trip for the BayBears to Jacksonville, and the two Jumbo Shrimp visits to Hank Aaron Stadium in Mobile will be in the second half from July 4-7 and July 28-August 1. Last year Jacksonville had a winning record against Mobile, going 14-7 overall. The clubs split the two series at Hank Aaron Stadium 5-5, while the Jumbo Shrimp were 9-2 against the BayBears at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville last season.

**Shrimp Have Prospects:** On the roster, the Jumbo Shrimp have five players who were listed by *MLB.com* as Top 30 Miami Marlins prospects for the 2018 season: OF Monte Harrison (1), Isan Diaz (7), RHP Nick Neidert (8), RHP Pablo Lopez (21), and John Norwood (30). Four of these five prospects were acquired by the Marlins in trades within the past 12 months.

**20 – CODY POTEET, RHP**

**2-3, 4.83 ERA, 8 games and 8 starts**

**2018:** 2-3, 4.83 ERA (22 ER/41.2 IP) in 8 G and 8 GS.  
**CAREER:** 9-21, 3.57 ERA (105 ER/265.0 IP) in 57 G and 54 GS.

**2018 vs. MOB:** 0-0, 3.86 ERA (2 ER/4.2 IP) in 1 G and 1 GS.  
**CAREER vs. MOB:** Same.

**LAST START:** Poteet had a no decision in his start on Tuesday May 15 against the Montgomery Biscuits at Riverwalk Stadium. Poteet worked five and a third innings where he allowed four runs (all earned) on seven hits with three walks and a strikeout. Poteet left the game in the sixth inning with Jacksonville trailing 4-1, only to see the Shrimp tie the game with three runs in the seventh, and win the game 5-4 thanks to an eighth inning home run by Cade Gotta.

**SMOKIES LOSS:** Poteet suffered his third loss of the season on Thursday May 10 against the Tennessee Smokies at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Poteet pitched a season-short two and two-third innings, allowing five runs (four earned) on six hits with no walks and three strikeouts, as Tennessee won 7-3 to clinch a series victory.

**SHUCKERS LOSS:** Poteet suffered his second loss of the season despite turning in a quality start on Saturday May 5 against the Biloxi Shuckers at MGM Park. Poteet turned in six innings where he allowed one run on four hits with four walks and six strikeouts, as Jacksonville lost 1-0.

**LAST BAYBEARS START:** Poteet had a no decision (was one out shy of qualifying for a win) in his start on Wednesday April 11 at the Baseball Grounds against the Mobile BayBears. In front of an Opening Night crowd of 6,960 fans, Poteet worked four and two-third innings while allowing two runs (both earned) on three hits with four walks and seven strikeouts as Jacksonville won 9-5.

**PROSPECT BUZZ:** Poteet had been regarded as Baseball America's No. 14 Marlins prospect entering the 2017 season, but fell out of the Top 30 rankings in the Marlins farm system for the 2018 season. Poteet had been Miami's No. 19 prospect entering 2016.

## #20 CODY POTEET RHP | 6-1, 180 lbs | Born: San Diego, Calif. Age: 23

Selected by the Miami Marlins in the fourth round of the 2015 draft out of UCLA.

**2017 Highlights:** Poteet had success in 2017 with the High-A Jupiter Hammerheads. With Jupiter Poteet was a 2017 League Midseason All-Star and Marlins Organizational All-Star. Poteet with the Hammerheads was 2-3 with a 2.53 ERA in seven starts in the first half of the season, eventually going 3-7 with a 4.16 ERA in his 14 starts. Poteet was selected by the Marlins in the fourth round of the 2015 draft out of UCLA. In home games at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium, Poteet was 2-4 with a 3.30 ERA in eight appearances and six starts, while on the road Poteet was 1-3 with a 5.20 ERA in his eight starts away from Jupiter.

**2016 Highlights:** Poteet spent all of 2016 with the Single-A Greensboro Grasshoppers. With Greensboro he was 3-7 with a 4.16 ERA in 16 appearances and 14 starts. He was 3-5 with a 2.43 ERA in 13 starts in the first half of the year, while going 1-4 with a 3.48 ERA in 11 starts in the second half of the season.

**2015 Highlights:** After he was selected by the Marlins in the fourth round of the draft out of UCLA, Poteet spent time at rookie level Batavia in the New York-Penn League. With the Muckdogs he was 0-1 with a 2.13 ERA in five appearances and four starts.

**College:** Poteet was part of a strong pitching staff at UCLA that included Yankees first rounder James Kaprielian and closer David Berg, a second round pick by the Cubs in 2015. In 2015 Poteet was 7-1 with a 2.45 ERA in 27 appearances and 13 starts as he transitioned to being a mid-week starter for the Bruins. Honorable Mention Pac-12 All-Academic selection in 2015. Sunday starter in 2014, going 3-5 with a 4.46 ERA in 17 appearances and 15 starts. In 2013 as a freshman was a midweek starter, going 4-6 with a 4.84 ERA in 29 appearances and 11 starts. In summer of 2014 pitched in the Cape Cod League for the Yarmouth-Dennis Red Sox, going 4-0 with a 3.09 ERA in seven starts. In summer of 2013 pitched in the West Coast League for the Walla Walla Sweets, going 3-2 with a 3.78 ERA with 27 strikeouts in 38 innings pitched.

**Personal:** Three-year varsity baseball letterwinner at Christian High School (El Cajon, Calif.) under head coach Michael Mitchell...selected in the 27th round of the 2012 MLB Draft by the Washington Nationals. Batted .509 with 55 hits, 13 doubles, 20 stolen bases, 23 RBI and 45 runs as a junior in 2011, pitching 17.2 innings that season...broke school records with 55 hits and a .509 batting average in 2011...did not play for Christian in 2012, instead competing for club team ABD Bulldogs ... went 10-1 with a 2.10 ERA and 112 strikeouts in 66.2 innings pitched for the Bulldogs in 2012.

**LAST START:** Duval suffered his third straight loss and fifth of the season as eh fell to the Montgomery Biscuits on Wednesday May 16 at Riverwalk Stadium. Duval turned in five and a third innings where he allowed three runs on eight hits with no walks and six strikeouts, as the Biscuits won 3-1. Duval's first five innings had been scoreless before the Biscuits did their damage in the sixth.

**SMOKIES LOSS:** Duval suffered his second straight loss and fourth of the season as he fell to the Tennessee Smokies on Friday May 11 at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Duval worked six innings where he allowed four runs (all earned) on five hits with a walk and a season-high eight strikeouts as Jacksonville lost the finale of the series 7-2. All of the runs that Duval allowed came in the top of the second inning.

**SHUCKERS LOSS:** Duval suffered a loss in his start on Sunday May 6 against the Biloxi Shuckers at MGM Park. Duval worked four and a third innings where he allowed six runs (all earned) on seven hits with three homers allowed, four walks, and three strikeouts as Jacksonville lost 6-5.

**#43 MAX DUVAL RHP | 6-5, 235 lbs | Born: April. 15, 1991 in San Luis Obispo, California. 27 years old.**

Signed by the Marlins as a minor league free agent on July 28, 2017.

**2017 Highlights:** Started the season pitching for the Evansville Otters in the independent Frontier League. With Evansville, Duval went 8-2 with a 2.28 ERA in 14 starts, striking out 113 batters in 87 innings of work and he won the 2017 Frontier League Brian Tollberg Award for Most Valuable Pitcher, and he was also a Frontier League All-Star. After he signed with the Marlins on July 28, he went 4-0 with a 2.09 ERA in six starts for the Single-A Greensboro Grasshoppers. Came within two outs of a seven inning perfect game on August 9, 2017. He retired the first 19 batters he faced before ultimately allowing a run on two hits with seven strikeouts in a complete game win.

**2016 Highlights:** Started the season pitching for the Evansville Otters in the independent Frontier League, where he was 4-1 with a 4.40 ERA in seven starts. Signed with the Arizona Diamondbacks as a minor league free agent on June 23, 2016. Pitched at four different levels of the Diamondbacks organization, making one relief outing with High-A Visalia where he was 1-0 with a 9.64 ERA, going 2-6 with a 3.02 ERA in 10 starts for the Single-A Kane County Cougars, then with Short Season Class A Hillsboro had no wins or losses and a 7.36 ERA in two appearances and one start, then also two appearances and a start for the AZL Diamondbacks, going 1-1 with a 1.13 ERA in two appearances and one start. All of his moving around different affiliates mainly happened in a 14-day span in late June and early July.

**2015 Highlights:** Split the season pitching in the Frontier League, making four appearances with the Schaumburg Boomers where he had no wins or losses and a 13.50 ERA. He also pitched for the Frontier Greys, where he was 1-3 with a 3.51 ERA in 15 appearances and eight starts. The Greys were a team that played strictly road games in the Frontier League, hence the name Greys after the traditional road jersey color.

**2014 Highlights:** Duval made his professional baseball debut pitching for the Schaumburg Boomers in the independent Frontier League, with no wins or losses and a 6.75 ERA in three relief outings.

**College:** Started college career at Cuesta College before transferring to Hawaii for his junior season. At Hawaii in 2012 he hit .186 with one home run and 18 RBI as an infielder. At the plate in 2013, Duval hit .192 with no homers and 3 RBI. He also pitched that season, with no wins or losses and a 6.48 ERA in six games in relief. After college considered quitting baseball but mom encouraged him to keep playing, which landed him in independent baseball to give pitching a real chance.

Duval lived in the RV with his friend and trainer Kevin Mixon, with the 29-foot motorhome parked just outside of Salinas, California and near their training facility.
