TODAY'S GAME: Game two of a four-game series against the Charlotte Stone Crabs (TB) at Spectrum Field (1-0)...Game six of an eight-game homestand against Charlotte and the Bradenton Marauders (PIT) (2-3)...Clearwater is coming off a series loss to the Marauders at Spectrum Field (1-3)...Third of four series (13 games) between the two clubs in 2019...The Threshers dropped two of three against the Tampa Bay Rays affiliate from May 17-19 in Clearwater.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: 21-year-old Andrew Brown makes his 19th appearance - 16th start - of the season in game two of the four-game series against the Charlotte Stone Crabs at Spectrum Field...The 6-foot-1 hurler allowed two runs across five innings in a no-decision against the St. Lucie Mets on July 21...The right-hander scattered five hits, walked a man and struck out two on 69 pitches - 41 strikes...Friday will be the Alpine, Calif. native's second career start against the Tampa Bay Rays affiliate...Brown faced off against the Stone Crabs on May 29, and limited Charlotte to one run on three hits, two free passes and four punch outs.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Clearwater Threshers started a four-game series with a come-from-behind, 5-3 victory over the Charlotte Stone Crabs on Thursday night at Spectrum Field...The Threshers jumped out to a 1-0 advantage with an RBI double by Nick Maton in the first, but allowed a solo home run in the third and a two-run blast in the fourth to fall into a 3-1 deficit...The home team used a four-run rally against the Stone Crabs' bullpen in the seventh to jump back out in front for the final score...Colton Eastman picked up the win with three runs allowed across seven stanzas...Tyler Carr earned his third save in as many chances through the final 1.1 innings.

LET'S GO FOR A RIDE: Tyler Carr was thrust into a difficult situation in the top of the eighth inning...The right-hander entered the game with the bases loaded and two outs, while trying to protect a two-run lead...The 23-year-old struck out Michael Smith to escape the jam, then worked a perfect ninth to earn his third save in three chances with Clearwater...The South Alabama product has been a staple for the bullpen in July, posting a 1.42 ERA (2er/12.2ip) across seven games (one start)...The reliever has had three consecutive scoreless appearances, stretching across 3.1 innings, while not allowing any base runners and picking up five strikeouts.

DOUBLING DOWN: The Threshers benefitted from five doubles in the series opener against the Charlotte Stone Crabs...Clearwater's season-high is six against the Tampa Tarpons (NYY) and St. Lucie Mets (NYM)...The Threshers are fourth in the Florida State League with 164 doubles on the season, seven less than the Fort Myers Miracle (MIN) for first place in the league.

MASHIN' MATERA: Nick Matera entered Thursday night's contest as a replacement for Rodolfo Duran in the top of the seventh innings, and wound up producing the game-winning two-run double in the bottom of the frame...The Rutgers product was off to an 0-for-7 start with Clearwater with four walks before the clutch hit...The 22-year-old has an OBP of .417 in four games with the Threshers.

PILING ON THE PUNCH OUTS: Colton Eastman tallied four punch outs on the mound, while Tyler Carr added three out of the bullpen to lift the Threshers' staff total to 961 on the season...Clearwater continues to pace the Florida State League as one of two teams with at least 900 strikeouts...The Philadelphia Phillies affiliate leads the Fort Myers Miracle (MIN) by 59 for the top-spot.

HOME SWEET HOME?: With the 4-11 start to the month of July, Clearwater continues to stay below .500 with a 24-29 record at Spectrum Field in 2019...The discrepancy in stats between home and road games is not that different for the Threshers...The club has a .257 average at home compared to .236 on the road, and has scored nine more runs at Spectrum Field (209-200)...Clearwater has a .704 OPS at Spectrum Field, but has posted a .668 on the road...On the mound, the pitching staff does have a higher ERA on the home bump (3.88-3.22), and has a higher average against (.237-.233)...The Threshers have been swept four times this season, with three coming at home...The Threshers snapped a five-game losing streak at home with the 2-1 loss in Tuesday's opener of the twin bill against the Bradenton Marauders.
