Dayton Dragons (19-16) at Lake County Captains (19-16)

LH Seth Varner (4-1, 2.31) vs. RH Jordan Milbrath (1-4, 6.91)

Today's Game: The Dayton Dragons (affiliate of the Cincinnati Reds) meet the Lake County Captains (affiliate of the Cleveland Indians) in the second game of a three-game series.

Streaks: Dayton is 13-7 over the last 20. Lake County has won seven of the last eight. **Dragons-Captains Season Series:** Dragons lead, 1-0.

Last Game: Dayton 3, Lake County 2. The Dragons trailed 2-0 after one inning but shutout the Captains the rest of the night. Dayton scored two runs in the sixth to tie the game and took the lead in the eighth on Luis Gonzalez's RBI triple. The Captains ended the game with runners at second and third. Dayton had only six hits but five went for extra bases. Gonzalez was 2 for 4 with a single, triple, and two RBI.

Today's Dragons Starting Pitcher: **Seth Varner** earned the win in his last start at Great Lakes on Monday (7 IP, 6 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 1 BB, 6 SO). He has allowed only one walk this season in 35 innings with 39 strikeouts. Varner was drafted by the Reds in the 10th round in 2014 out of Miami (Ohio) University. He earned the Mid American Conference Pitcher of the Year award in 2014, going 7-3 with a 2.85 ERA. Varner pitched at Billings in his first pro season, appearing in 13 games with one start. Varner was 4-3, 4.91 at Billings. He is a native of the Southwest Ohio town of Batavia and was named Cincinnati Enquirer Division II Player of the Year as a senior at Clermont Northeastern High School.

Individual Notes

- **Luis Gonzalez** has a 10-game hitting streak (team high for 2015). He is batting .357 over the streak, raising his average from .216 to .262.
- **Brian O'Grady** has a nine-game hitting streak and has hit safely in 13 of his last 14 games. He is batting .314 over the 14 games.
- **Ty Washington** is batting .356 over his last 14 games with a home run, four doubles, two triples, and 10 RBI, raising his average to .304.
- **Jonathan Reynoso** is batting .326 over his last 12 games.
- **Garrett Boulware** is batting .316 over his last 12 games with two home runs and 10 RBI.
- **Seth Varner** has issued one walk this season in 35 innings.
- **Brian Hunter** has allowed just one earned run this season (12 G, 15.2 IP, 3 R, 1 ER, 4 saves, 3 wins, 0.57 ERA).
- **Jermei Kivel** over his last eight outings: 10.1 IP, 5 H, 0 R, 8 BB, 17 SO.
- **Brennan Bernardino** over his last five outings: 6.2 IP, 0 R, 2 BB, 8 SO.
- Four of the five Dragons starting pitchers have ERAs under 2.70 (Antone: 2.25; Varner: 2.31; Strahan: 2.41; Armstrong: 2.65).

Team Notes

- The Dragons are 13-7 their last 20 games. During the 20 games, they are batting .251 (169 for 674) and averaging 4.4 runs/game (87 R) with a team ERA of 2.28 (181.2 IP, 46 ER). They have committed 27 errors.
- Dragons relievers over the last 8 G: 29.2 IP, 2 ER, 0.61 ERA.
- The Dragons are 14-5 when allowing no unearned runs; 4-4 when allowing one unearned run; 1-7 when allowing two or more unearned runs.
- The Dragons have allowed the most unearned runs of any team in the Midwest League this season (37).
- The Dragons are 7-4 over their last 11 road games after starting the year by going 2-7 in the first nine road games.
- Over the last 11 games, Dragons pitchers have posted a Team ERA of 1.68 (101.2 IP, 19 ER).
- Dragons opponents have scored a total of 38 runs in the Dragons 19 victories (2.0 R/G) and 91 runs in the 16 Dragons losses (5.7 R/G).
- The Dragons are 11-2 this season when scoring the first run of the game (only losses came Wednesday-Thursday). They are 14-2 when scoring at least four runs. They have won only two games this season when the opponent scores more than three runs.
- Dragons pitchers walked 41 batters in 21 games in April (fewest walks in the month of any of the 120 Minor League teams currently active).
- The Dragons roster includes 15 players who played for the 2014 Pioneer League champion Billings Mustangs.

Current Dragons Past Accomplishments: **Brennan Bernardino** was the top relief pitcher in the Pioneer League in 2014 with Billings, posting a 1.01 ERA and nine saves...**Gavin LaValley** led his high school team to three straight state championships in Oklahoma, belting 54 home runs in high school...**Seth Varner** was the 2014 Mid American Conference Pitcher of the Year at Miami University...**Wyatt Strahan** was First Team All-PAC 12 at USC...**Jimmy Pickens** was First Team All-Big Ten at Michigan State...**Garrett Boulware** was 2nd Team All-ACC at Clemson...**Brian O'Grady** was 3rd Team All-America Athletic Conference at Rutgers...**Jake Ehret** was a member of the 2013 college baseball national championship team at UCLA...**Narciso Crook** hit four home runs in one game in 2013 in junior college, leading his team to the national Junior College World Series title.

- Four members of the Dragons are rated among the Reds top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America*: **3B Gavin LaValley** (#17), RHP **Wyatt Strahan** (#23), RHP **Tyler Mahle** (#26), and RHP **Jermei Kivel** (#29). Additionally, **OF Nick Benedetto** was selected by Baseball America as the "Best Defensive Outfielder" in the Reds organization.

The Dragons MVP Program

The Dragons have expanded their elementary school MVP Program into two additional counties, taking the program to more than 1,100 classrooms in 2015. A total of 274 classrooms in 34 schools in Miami and Warren counties have been added to the program, which already included 842 classrooms in Montgomery, Greene, and Clark counties. In 2015, the program includes 1,116 fourth and fifth grade classrooms in 183 schools over 48 school districts. About 34,000 children will participate (up from 26,000 in 2014). The program is in its 10th year in 2015. Due to the support of the participating sponsors, the program is completely free of charge to the schools.

How does the Dragons School MVP Program work? The teacher in each of the 1,116 classrooms over the five-county area will select five MVP's based on the teacher's judgment of performance, effort, citizenship, and improvement. The five MVPs selected by their teacher in each classroom will get four tickets to a Dragons game, tickets to a special Field Day event at the stadium during the season, an MVP certificate and a Dragons MVP hat. Dragons players and mascots visit selected classrooms over the course of the season. Additionally, 12 Dragons games during the season are designated as "MVP Game Nights." On those nights, one MVP gets to throw out the ceremonial first pitch to the game, another does an on-air interview during the Dragons game broadcast on Fox Sports 980, and another participates in an entertainment skit during the Dragons game. Two times each season, all classroom MVP's are invited to attend the Dragons MVP Field Day at Fifth Third Field and interact with Dragons players. The Dragons MVP Program presented by Bob Evans is also made possible by the generous support of Sinclair Community College, WDTN TV and Dayton's CW Television.

New HD Video Board

The Dragons have installed a new 2,050 square foot, high-definition video board at Fifth Third Field. The video board features the newest and latest high definition technology, and provides the clearest picture quality of any board ever utilized in a Minor League Baseball venue. The new addition is one of the first "13HD" video boards in a Minor League ballpark. Notably, only three of the 30 Major League Baseball stadiums have 13HD video boards. No Minor League ballpark featured a 13HD video board in 2014 or beforehand. The video board will be 35 feet high by 65 feet wide, making it the tallest and widest in all of Single-A baseball and among the top five tallest and widest in any Minor League stadium. It will have five times more display area than the previous video board at Fifth Third Field. It is twice the height and two and one-half times the width as the previous board.
