**Last Game:** The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (13-23) fell to the Mobile BayBears (15-21) by a 4-1 score in the first game of the five-game series at Hank Aaron Stadium on Saturday night. Jacksonville starting pitcher Severino Gonzalez (0-3) took the loss, allowing four runs (all earned) on five hits (all doubles) with two walks and two strikeouts. Mobile starter Alex Klonowski (2-2) earned the win, working six and two-third innings where he allowed just one run on one hit with four walks and six strikeouts. Ivan Hernandez worked a scoreless ninth inning to earn his first save of 2017. Doubles helped the BayBears early against Gonzalez. Andrew Daniel started the scoring in the bottom of the second inning with an RBI double to give Mobile a 1-0 lead. An inning later Michael Herмосillo scored from third when a fielding error by second baseman David Vidal helped Forrest Allday reach base to make it a 2-0 score. Mobile added two more runs in the fourth inning on RBI doubles by Alberto Triunfel and Zach Gibbons grew the BayBears lead to 4-0. Jacksonville didn't have a hit through the first four innings against Klonowski, but that changed in the fifth inning when Brian Anderson led off the frame with a towering home run to left field to put the score at 4-1. James Buckelew took over for Gonzalez out of the bullpen in the fifth inning and worked three perfect innings in relief, inducing six groundball outs with three strikeouts. Ryan Beckman also worked a scoreless eighth out of the Jumbo Shrimp bullpen. The Jumbo Shrimp have now lost their last six games, and on the road the club is now 6-15 this season.

## NEWS AND NOTES

**Hello BayBears:** After a bus ride through the night from Florida to Alabama, the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp are now facing the Mobile BayBears from Saturday through Wednesday at Hank Aaron Stadium. The Jumbo Shrimp and BayBears recently met at the Baseball Grounds, with Jacksonville winning the series 4-1. The BayBears took the first game 8-3 before Jacksonville rallied off four straight victories to close out the series. Jacksonville's final two wins were in walk-off fashion, with John Norwood hitting a walk-off homer in the bottom of the eleventh inning on April 30, and then Brian Anderson hitting a walk-off RBI double on May 1 to complete the series.

**Power Against Mobile:** The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp have had no problems hitting home runs against the Mobile BayBears so far in 2017. 10 of Jacksonville's 21 home runs have been hit against Mobile in only six games this year. Brian Anderson has especially liked hitting homers against the BayBears, with half (three) of his six home runs against the BayBears, including a solo homer for Jacksonville's lone run in last night's game at Hank Aaron Stadium. At the Baseball Grounds from April 27 to May 1, Jacksonville hit nine home runs against the BayBears, with John Norwood hitting three homers against Mobile, including a walkoff homer against the BayBears on April 30 at the Baseball Grounds in the bottom of the 11<sup>th</sup> inning to deliver Jacksonville a 3-2 win. The only other team that Jacksonville has hit more than two home runs against is Chattanooga, with three homers against the Lookouts in 2017.

**Tomshaw against Mobile:** Today's Jacksonville starter Matt Tomshaw looks to continue his success against the BayBears in today's matchup at Hank Aaron Stadium. Tomshaw worked seven scoreless innings allowing five hits with a walk and four strikeouts as Jacksonville on 4-0 back on April 28 at the Baseball Grounds. Tomshaw overall is 3-2 with a 4.95 ERA against the BayBears in nine appearances and seven starts over the past three seasons pitching for Jacksonville.

**18 – MATT TOMSHAW, LHP**

**3-1, 2.27 ERA, 7 games and 7 starts**

**2017:** 3-1, 2.27 ERA (10 ER/39.2 IP) in 7 G and 7 GS.  
**CAREER:** 38-34, 3.66 ERA (264 ER/649.0 IP) in 153 G and 98 GS.

**2017 vs. MOB:** 1-0, 0.00 ERA (0 ER/7.0 IP) in 1 G and 1 GS.  
**CAREER vs. MOB:** 3-2, 4.95 ERA (22 ER/40.0 IP) in 9 G and 7 GS.

**LAST START:** Tomshaw had a no decision in his start on Tuesday May 9 against the Biloxi Shuckers at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Tomshaw worked five innings where he allowed three runs on six hits with a walk and five strikeouts. Tomshaw left with the game tied 3-3, only to see the Shuckers win 6-4.

**SMOKIES START:** Tomshaw had a no decision in his start on Thursday May 4 at Tennessee. Tomshaw worked seven scoreless innings where he allowed six hits, walked none and struck out two. Tomshaw left the game with the score 0-0, only to see Jacksonville score a run in the eighth to put him in line for the win. Tennessee had a two-run homer by David Bote in the bottom of the eighth to go in front 2-1, however Jacksonville scored five runs in the ninth to win the game 6-2.

**BAYBEARS WIN:** Tomshaw ended a three-game Jumbo Shrimp losing streak by earning the win on Friday April 27 against the Mobile BayBears at the Baseball Grounds. Tomshaw worked seven scoreless innings allowing five hits with a walk and four strikeouts as Jacksonville on 4-0.

**BARONS WIN:** Tomshaw earned the win in his start on Sunday April 23 against the Birmingham Barons at Regions Field. Tomshaw worked five and two-third innings where he allowed a run on six hits with four walks and five strikeouts as Jacksonville snapped an 8-game losing streak with a 6-1 win.

**WAHOOS START:** Tomshaw had a no decision in his last start on Tuesday April 18 against the Blue Wahoos at Blue Wahoos Stadium. Tomshaw turned in five innings where he allowed four runs (all earned) on eight hits with a walk and two strikeouts. The game was tied at four when Tomshaw left, then the Wahoos scored three runs in the bottom of the eighth to win 7-4.

**#18 MATT TOMSHAW LHP | 6-1, 205 lbs | Born: Kingston, NY. Age: 28**

Acquired by the Marlins in the 2014 Rule 5 draft from the Minnesota Twins

Originally drafted by the Twins in the 42<sup>nd</sup> round of the 2011 June First-Year Player Draft out of Jacksonville University.

**2016 Highlights:** Tomshaw had three stints with Jacksonville from May 30-June 20, June 22-July 30, and August 5 through the end of the season. With Jacksonville he was 4-4 with a 3.63 ERA in 15 appearances and 14 starts. He struck out at least six batters in his last five starts for Jacksonville, beginning with a season-high of 10 on August 12 vs. Mississippi. Tomshaw was 0-1 with a 2.12 ERA in eight games in relief for the New Orleans Zephyrs, with his first five appearances coming in the month of May, and the final three in late July, early August. Tomshaw took his lone loss when he allowed a pair of runs in the 12<sup>th</sup> inning against the Colorado Springs Sky Sox on May 12. Tomshaw returned to the Zephyrs where he made an appearance June 21 allowing a hit with no walks with four strikeouts. Tomshaw in late July and August pitched for the Zephyrs in two relief outings on July 30 and August 3, turning in scoreless outings against the Nashville Sounds and Iowa Cubs. After some time in extended spring training, Tomshaw earned the win in his lone appearance with the High-A Jupiter Hammerheads on May 1. He worked three scoreless innings, allowing a hit with a strikeout.

**2015 Highlights:** Spent the majority of his first season in the Marlins system with Double-A Jacksonville. Tomshaw went 6-10 with a 4.33 ERA in 20 appearances and 18 starts. In his first year as reliever: 1-1, 4.50 ERA in 11 G, started season as starter: 4-6, 5.35 ERA in 12 GS. Made two starts with Triple-A New Orleans in Mid-August, going 0-2 with a 17.18 ERA, allowing 15 runs (14 earned) in 7.1 IP.

**2014 Highlights:** He spent all of last year with advanced-A Fort Myers Miracle, going 11-6 with a 3.50 ERA in 25 games and 21 starts over 136.1 innings. On the campaign he set career highs for innings pitched (136.1) and tied his career high with 82 strikeouts. Tomshaw led the Miracle in wins (11), games started (21), and was second in total strikeouts (82).

**2013 Highlights:** He split 2013 with Fort Myers (A+) and Cedar Rapids (A-). With Fort Myers the southpaw posted a 4-4 mark to go along with a 3.94 ERA in 17 games and 14 starts over 96.0 innings. His 42 earned runs given up with FM were good for second-most he has allowed in a single stop. With CR, Tomshaw went 2-0 with a 5.10 ERA in nine games and four starts over 30.0 innings pitched. Batters hit .290 against Tomshaw at the low-A stop which was the worst of his career.

**2012 Highlights:** Tomshaw split 2012 between the GCL Twins and the Beloit Snappers (A). With GCL, he appeared in only two games and over his three innings pitched he allowed two hits. He spent the majority of the year with Beloit, going 4-6 attached to a 3.02 ERA in 20 games and 14 starts over 86.1 innings pitched. At the time that had been Tomshaw's first season with 20

**2011 Highlights:** After being drafted he had stops between the GCL Twins and Fort Myers. In his first year in rookie ball the southpaw mustered up a 3-0 record while pitching to a 2.16 ERA in 11 games over 16.2 innings. He would receive his first call up to Fort Myers and enter into the starting rotation setting a 2.13 ERA in seven games and four starts over 25.1 innings.

**Personal:** Tomshaw was drafted out of Jacksonville University, and in an interview with *twinsdaily.com* he highlighted some of his bright spots with JU. "One of my biggest wins was against University of Florida during the regular season at their stadium. They just came off taking two from Vanderbilt that weekend. At the time, Florida was ranked 4th in the nation, and we ended up beating them 11-2. After the College World Series was over and Florida finished 2nd only to South Carolina, did it hit me how big of a win that was. Also in my senior year in game 1 of the conference tournament against Eastern Tennessee State University, I threw a complete game allowing 5 hits, 1 unearned run and winning 2-1."
