CLDS GAME 3: The Lynchburg Hillcats and Potomac Nationals had Game 3 of the CLDS suspended in the top of the sixth inning, with the P-Nats leading 4-0. The Nationals scored two runs in the second and two in the fourth. Nick Banks picked up two hits and drove in three runs, while Rhett Wiseman had an RBI single. Kyle Johnston was rolling for the P-Nats, firing 5.1 scoreless innings before the rain picked up. Tanner Tully allowed four runs in six hits in five innings. The game will pick up in the top of the sixth with Dillon Persinger at the plate, with a runner on first and one out.

PLAYOFF 'CATS: The Hillcats will have an opportunity to defend their 2017 Championship after clinching a post-season berth on Saturday. Lynchburg will meet the Potomac Nationals in the Carolina League Division Series in a best-of-five series. City Stadium will play host to games one and two on Wednesday and Thursday, before the series shifts to Woodbridge. The Hillcats went 10-12 against the P-Nats in the regular season. The Hillcats have now made the post-season in seven consecutive seasons, making it to the championship three times, including titles in 2012 and 2017. With eight championships, the Hillcats have the second-most in the league, behind Winston-Salem's 11.

AGAINST THE P-NATS: The Hillcats and Nationals met 22 times during the regular season, with Lynchburg going 10-12 in the head-to-head meetings. Statistically, the Hillcats and Nationals were dead even in the pitching department, as both teams accumulated a 3.95 team ERA against each other. Lynchburg batted .243 against Potomac, while the P-Nats hit .269 against the Hillcats. The Nationals had the second-best team batting average in the Carolina League in 2018, posting a .271 mark. They also had the second-best team ERA at 3.36.

BRILLIANT BULLPEN: Through two games this post season, the Hillcats bullpen has been rock solid. They have worked 7.1 innings, and have allowed just two runs (2.45 ERA). Anderson Polanco worked four innings on Thursday and allowed just one run, while Adam Scott has also helped lead the way with two scoreless frames.

IT'S MILLER TIME: 1B Anthony Miller had been on an absolute tear at the plate. Over his final 16 regular season games, the left-handed hitter batted .396 (21-for-53) with four home runs. He had a career game on August 31, going 5-for-5 with two home runs, a double, and four RBI. He became just the second Hillcats player to collect more than four hits in a game this year, joining Ernie Clement. Miller is riding an 11 game hitting streak (19-for-42). He was named the Carolina League Player of the Week for the final week of the regular season. During that week, he went a combined 16-for-35 (.457) at the plate with two home runs, 11 RBI, six doubles and four runs scored.

JONES JUST HITTING: Third baseman Nolan Jones has been a catalyst for the Hillcats at the plate as of late. He hit safely in 14 of his final 17 regular season games, going 21-for-61 with seven doubles, two home runs, 13 RBI and 17 walks. The Indians #2 ranked prospect also has an OPS of .910 since joining Lynchburg and has collected an RBI in eight of his last 13 regular season contests. His eight-game hitting streak came to a close on Monday, previously going 11-for-30 over the stretch.

BASHIN' BROOKS: Trenton Brooks has hot at the plate for Lynchburg. The outfielder is batting 20-for-55 (.363) over his last 16 games with a home run and 12 RBI. He had a seven-game hitting streak snapped in the second game of the double-header. He posted 15 hits over that span, including three three-hit ballgames.

SIRI-OUSLY: Dalbert Siri nailed down his career-best 15th save of the season in the finale against Salem, finishing third in the Carolina League. Siri has allowed just one earned run over his last 16.1 innings pitched, striking out 25 along the way. Siri finished off the regular season with an ERA of 2.35 and an opponent's average of .182. Siri picked up his first post-season save in Game 1 against Potomac.

LUCKY NUMBER 7: When a Hillcats starting pitcher has gone at least seven innings this season, it usually has led to wins. In fact, the Hillcats are 11-2 in such a scenario. Tanner Tully leads the way with four seven-inning outings, while Zach Plesac has three such games. The lone exceptions came on consecutive night, when Lynchburg lost 1-0 to the P-Nats August 23, when Eli Morgan went seven deep, and then Kirk McCarty did so the next day on August 24.

I'VE GOT THE POWER! After belting just 25 home runs in the first half of the season, the Hillcats hit 48 long balls in the club's 70 games of the second half. Jodd Carter had seven to lead the way, while Li-Jen Chu went gone deep six times in the second half of play before their respective promotions. Lynchburg hit a season-high five home runs in the July 2 win against the Keys, including three in one inning. Additionally after tallying just six multi-homer games in the first half, they accounted for six in the second half.

TOP-30 IN THE HILL CITY: Nolan Jones (No. 2) Sam Hentges (No. 8), Eli Morgan (No. 16), and Mitch Longo (No. 23) are all Hillcats players that are ranked on the Indians Top-30 prospect list. Jones, the Tribe's 2nd round pick in 2016, batted .317 with four HR and 33 RBI with Short-season Mahoning Valley last season. This year, his power numbers jumped to 16 HR and 49 RBI, while hitting .279 for Lake County before his promotion to Lynchburg on August 3. Hentges, a left-hander, missed the majority of last season while he was rehabbing from Tommy John surgery, but leads the Hillcats in strikeouts this season. With Mahoning Valley, Morgan appeared in 13 games (8 starts) and sported a 3-2 record with a 1.03 ERA over 35 innings. He played at Gonzaga and was drafted in the 8th round of the 2017 MLB draft. Longo, an outfielder, battled injuries last season, but while he as healthy, he hit a combined .376 with 4 HR and 28 RBI between Lake County and Lynchburg, helping the Hillcats to a Carolina League Championship.

HILLCATS COACHING STAFF

Rougie Odor
 Manager (1st Season)
 Career Record: 295-308

Odor is in his 18th year coaching in the Indians organization. He played in the minor leagues for the Indians & Brewers from 1988-1995. Odor brings a decade of skipper experience to Lynchburg. He led San Felipe in the Venezuelan Summer League for two seasons from 1999-2000, the Burlington Indians for four seasons from 2001-2004, the Mahoning Valley Scorpions for two years from 2005-2006 and the Gulf Coast League Indians for two campaigns from 2007-2008. He spent the past three seasons as the hitting coach for the Columbus Clippers, Cleveland's Triple-A affiliate.

Tony Arnold
 Pitching Coach (2nd season)
 26th overall

Arnold returns to Lynchburg after serving as the pitching coach for the Hillcats in 2015. The former right-handed pitcher played collegiately at the University of Texas and was drafted by the Baltimore Orioles in the 10th round in the 1981 MLB Draft. The El Paso, Texas native played in parts of two MLB with the Orioles in 1986 and 1987. Arnold has coached in the Indians organization since 1992 and most recently was the pitching coach of the Akron RubberDucks, Cleveland's Double-A affiliate, for the past two seasons.

Justin Toole
 Hitting Coach (1st season)
 3rd overall

2018 marks Toole's first year on Lynchburg's coaching staff and third in the Indians organization. The former infielder played in parts of seven minor league seasons with Cleveland from 2009-2015, reaching Triple-A Columbus. The Council Bluffs, Iowa native worked as the hitting coach last year for Single-A Lake County.

Grant Fink
 Bench Coach (1st season)
 2nd overall

Fink joins the Hillcats as bench coach for the first time in 2018, entering his second season as a coach in the Indians organization. The former infielder was drafted by Cleveland in the 23rd round of the 2013 MLB Draft out of Missouri Western State University. A native of St. Joseph, Mo., Fink played in parts of three minor league seasons for the Indians from 2013-2015, reaching Single-A Lake County. Fink was the bench coach last season for Short-Season Mahoning Valley.

Bobby Ruiz
 Athletic Trainer (4th season)
 5th overall

Ruiz is in his eighth season in the Indians organization. He graduated from the University of La Verne in 2008. He spent two years at the University of Connecticut as a Graduate Assistant Athletic Trainer for the Huskies baseball team, while earning his Master's degree

Eric Ortego
 Strength Coach (1st season)
 2nd overall

Ortego is in his second season in the Indians Organization. He graduated from the University of Louisiana at Lafayette in 2012. Following graduation, Ortego served as the Assistant Director of Strength and Conditioning at McNeese State.
