**Last Game:** The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp won a 3-2, seven-inning Game 1, and left fielder Alex Glenn hit a seventh-inning, walk-off single in a 1-0 Game 2, to win a doubleheader and the last first-half series over the Pensacola Blue Wahoos in front of 5,138 on Baptist Health Sunday Family FUNday at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. In Game 1, Pensacola (40-30) took a first-inning lead, as Blue Wahoos shortstop Alex Blandino hit a two-out solo home run off right-hander Omar Bencomo. Trailing 1-0 in the third inning against All-Star right-hander Deck McGuire (6-5), the Jumbo Shrimp (30-40) began a rally with center fielder Yefri Perez's leadoff double. Bencomo put down a sacrifice bunt, but Pensacola catcher Adrian Nieto threw past third base, allowing Perez to score the tying run and putting Bencomo at second base. Miami Marlins rehabbing shortstop Adeiny Hechavarria singled Bencomo to third base, and All-Star right fielder John Norwood hit a go-ahead sacrifice fly to center field. Catcher Cam Maron's fourth-inning home run made it 3-1. While McGuire allowed three runs – two earned – on four hits, Bencomo allowed a run on two hits in three innings. Miami Marlins rehabbing right-hander Junichi Tazawa began the fourth inning and struck out the first two batters in a perfect inning. Right-hander Severino Gonzalez (2-4) followed with 2 1/3 innings, allowing one run. In the seventh inning, a walk and two singles put the tying and go-ahead runs on base, but right-hander Clayton Mortenson got his second save when pinch hitter Gabriel Guerrero flied out to Norwood, who threw to first base to retire Nieto for a game-ending double play. Through the first six scoreless innings of Game 2, Jacksonville right-hander Chris Mazza allowed five hits and a walk with three strikeouts, while Pensacola and former Jacksonville right-hander Luis Castillo (4-4) allowed one baserunner – All-Star third baseman Brian Anderson's fourth-inning single. In the seventh inning, right-hander Andy Beltre (2-0) allowed three straight two-out singles before an inning-ending strikeout. In the bottom of the inning, catcher Austin Nola singled, and Castillo hit Anderson with a pitch before striking out Norwood and walking first baseman Taylor Ard. With one out and the bases loaded, Glenn hit the first pitch down the right-field line, scoring Nola with the winning run.

## NEWS AND NOTES

**Roster Moves:** In a corresponding move, left-handed relief pitcher Daniel Schlereth was transferred from Triple-A New Orleans to Jacksonville. Schlereth pitched in two games for the Baby Cakes, not allowing a run in his two and a thirds innings pitched. Earlier this season Schlereth had no wins or losses and a 2.70 ERA in his nine appearances with the Jumbo Shrimp. Additionally, left-handed relief pitcher Greg Nappo and right-handed relief pitcher Hunter Adkins were released by the Marlins organization. Nappo was 0-1 with a 1.50 ERA in his nine relief outings for the Jumbo Shrimp, while Adkins was 1-2 with a 3.90 ERA in 15 appearances and one start with two saves for Jacksonville. In a corresponding move, right-handed relief pitcher Tyler Higgins has been activated from Jacksonville's disabled list to the active roster. Higgins has worked in 19 games in relief with a 1-3 record and a 4.28 ERA, and he was placed on the disabled list on June 14 with a right back strain. Also in a corresponding move, left-handed relief pitcher Jeff Kinley has been transferred from High-A Jupiter to Jacksonville. Kinley was 2-0 with a 1.30 ERA in his 21 relief outings with six saves for the Hammerheads, and this is the first call-up to the Double-A level in his career. Right-handed pitcher Omar Bencomo was placed on the disabled list, retroactive to June 19, with a left quad strain. Bencomo has been 4-4 with a 4.76 ERA in his 13 appearances and 11 starts for Jacksonville this season. In a corresponding move, right-handed starting pitcher Trevor Richards has been transferred from High-A Jupiter to Jacksonville. Richards has been 7-4 with a 2.17 ERA in his 13 appearances and 11 starts for the Hammerheads.

**LAST START:** Gunkel suffered the loss in his start of what was scheduled to be Game One of a doubleheader on Thursday June 15. Gunkel worked five innings where he allowed a run on six hits with three walks and a strikeout, in a game Jacksonville lost 1-0 in a rain-shortened game that only went to the top of the sixth inning.

**SHUCKERS WIN:** Gunkel earned his first victory as a Jumbo Shrimp on Friday June 10 against the Biloxi Shuckers. Gunkel worked a season long seven innings where he allowed one run (unearned) on five hits with a walk and three strikeouts as the Jumbo Shrimp won 5-2.

**FIRST GENERALS START:** Gunkel had a no decision in his start during Game One of Jacksonville's doubleheader with Jackson on Friday May 26 at the Baseball Grounds. Gunkel worked four and two-third innings where he allowed five runs on seven hits with two walks and two strikeouts. Gunkel left with the score 5-0, only to see the Shrimp rally for eight runs with two outs in the bottom of the fifth, and win the seven-inning game 9-5.

**2017 SO FAR:** Gunkel was in spring training with the Orioles this season, however Baltimore designated him for assignment on April 7, then the club traded him to the Dodgers on April 10 for a player to be named later. Gunkel started the season with the Triple-A Oklahoma City Dodgers, where he had no wins or losses and a 4.00 ERA in his three appearances and one start. He was designated for assignment by the Dodgers on April 25, and the Marlins claimed him off waivers two days later on April 27.

**PROSPECT:** Gunkel entered the 2017 season as the Baltimore Orioles No. 20 prospect according to Baseball America.

Claimed by the Marlins off waivers from the Los Angeles Dodgers on April 29, 2017.

**2017 Highlights:** Gunkel was in spring training with the Orioles this season, however Baltimore designated him for assignment on April 7, then the club traded him to the Dodgers on April 10 for a player to be named later. Gunkel started the season with the Triple-A Oklahoma City Dodgers, where he had no wins or losses and a 4.00 ERA in his three appearances and one start. He was designated for assignment by the Dodgers on April 25, and the Marlins claimed him off waivers two days later on April 27.

**2016 Highlights:** Started the season with Double-A Bowie, making four starts for the Baysox. Promoted to Triple-A Norfolk on 5/1...Led the Tides in starts (24), innings pitched (141.1), and strikeouts (94), and finished second on the team in wins (eight). Earned his first win with Norfolk on 5/22 at Syracuse after throwing 7.0 shutout innings with two walks and three strikeouts. Tossed an 8.0-inning complete game on 6/9 at Durham, allowing three runs on five hits, two home runs, with four strikeouts and suffered the loss. Was the only Norfolk pitcher to have a complete game...Tossed a season-high 100 pitches in his complete game on 6/9. Had a streak of 25.2 innings in which he allowed only one run, 7/22-8/13. Left-handers hit .260 (57-for-219) with four home runs off of him, while right-handers hit .294 (99-for-337) with 10 home runs. Entered 2016 as the Orioles No. 23 prospect, according to MLB.com
