Last Game: Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp left fielder Alex Glenn hit a ninth-inning, two-out, walk-off RBI double for a 5-4 win over the Mississippi Braves, capping a game started by Miami Marlins rehabbing left-hander Jeff Locke in front of 7,437 on NAPA AutoCare Family Fireworks Friday night at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Making his first appearance for Jacksonville (16-26) and third rehab start this month, Locke lasted 5 1/3 innings, throwing 64 of his 87 pitches for strikes. In the first inning, Braves right fielder Ronald Acuna singled, stole second base and scored on a two-out RBI single by first baseman Joey Meneses. Locke retired the next eight in a row, including four on strikeouts. In the fifth inning, he allowed a two-out double to shortstop Dylan Moore and an RBI single by third baseman Luis Valenzuela that tied the game, 2-2. In the sixth inning, second baseman Travis Demeritte led off with a hit that got by center fielder Yefri Perez and ended as an inside-the-park solo home run for a 3-3 tie. Locke allowed a single and sacrifice before exiting, having allowed seven hits and no walks with seven strikeouts. The Jumbo Shrimp took a 2-1, first-inning lead against Braves left-hander Kolby Allard, as first baseman Taylor Ard grounded a two-run double down the third-base line. Jacksonville retook the lead at 3-2 with right fielder Cal Tovey's go-ahead RBI single in the fifth inning, and again at 4-3 on second baseman David Vidal's sixth-inning, bases-loaded walk. Following Locke, Jumbo Shrimp relievers Andy Beltre, Ryan Beckman, Daniel Schlereth and Esmerling De La Rosa (1-1) combined for 3 2/3 innings, allowing one hit – Valenzuela's game-tying double off Beckman in the seventh inning. In a 4-4, ninth-inning tie against Braves left-hander Michael Mader (3-2), Jumbo Shrimp third baseman Brian Anderson singled – his third hit – and went to second base on a wild pitch. After a two-out intentional walk to Ard, Glenn ripped a game-winning line drive down the right-field line. The last three Jumbo Shrimp home wins have come on walk-off hits.

NEWS AND NOTES

Breakdown of Locke's Rehab Start: Miami Marlins left-handed starting pitcher Jeff Locke made his first rehab appearance for the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp Friday night after making two starts in High-A Jupiter. Locke pitched five and a third innings allowing three runs (all earned), on seven hits, with one walk compared to seven strikeouts. Locke had a no decision in Jacksonville's 5-4 win, that ended with a walk-off RBI double by Alex Glenn.

The New Hampshire native signed with the Miami Marlins as a free agent in December after he spent six years in the majors with the Pittsburgh Pirates. He is recovering from left bicep tendinitis that first bothered him early during spring training. With High-A Jupiter Locke started two games recording no wins or losses while posting a 1.00 ERA in nine innings of work. His third rehab appearance came Friday night in Jacksonville against the Mississippi Braves where he labored through the first inning, facing five batters and surrendering the first run of the game before settling in. Locke consistently sat between 88-92 with his two seam fastball and off-speed pitches showing plenty of movement. Locke made quick work in the second, third, and fourth innings facing only ten batter and throwing thirty-two pitches before giving a run in the fifth and sixth inning. S.L. Leaders: Tonight's Jumbo Shrimp starter Matt Tomshaw sports the sixth-best ERA in the Southern League coming into tonight's start. Tomshaw is Jacksonville's winningest pitcher in 2017, with a 4-1. If he earns the win tonight, Tomshaw would be tied with Tennessee's Zach Hedges and Pensacola's Tyler Mahle for the league lead in wins. David Vidal is also fourth in the league in hitting with a .322 average, second in the league with 11 doubles, and fourth in the league with 48 hits. Taylor Ard is tied for first in the league with 42 games played, even with Biloxi's Mauricio Dubon.

Welcome M-Braves: Tonight marks the second series of the season between the Jumbo Shrimp and the M-Braves. The clubs started the 2017 season facing each other at Trustmark Park in Pearl, Mississippi, with the M-Braves winning 3 of 5 games. Mississippi is currently tied for second in the Southern League South Division standings, one game back of Pensacola. The Shrimp and Braves will next face each other from July 25-29, and the M-Braves return to Jacksonville from August 10-14.

LAST START: Tomshaw earned the win in his start on Mother's Day Sunday May 14. Tomshaw worked six and two-third innings where he allowed a run on six hits with three walks and two strikeouts as the Jumbo Shrimp ended a six-game losing streak with a 3-1 win.

SHUCKERS START: Tomshaw had a no decision in his start on Tuesday May 9 against the Biloxi Shuckers at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Tomshaw worked five innings where he allowed three runs on six hits with a walk and five strikeouts. Tomshaw left with the game tied 3-3, only to see the Shuckers win 6-4.

SMOKIES START: Tomshaw had a no decision in his start on Thursday May 4 at Tennessee. Tomshaw worked seven scoreless innings where he allowed six hits, walked none and struck out two. Tomshaw left the game with the score 0-0, only to see Jacksonville score a run in the eighth to put him in line for the win. Tennessee had a two-run homer by David Bote in the bottom of the eighth to go in front 2-1, however Jacksonville scored five runs in the ninth to win the game 6-2.

FIRST BRAVES START: Tomshaw took the loss in his 2017 debut on Friday April 7 at Mississippi. Tomshaw allowed two runs (both in the first inning) on seven hits with no walks and six strikeouts in his five innings of work, his final four innings in scoreless fashion. Tomshaw did not receive any run support, as the Shrimp were blanked 2-0 by the M-Braves.

#18 MATT TOMSHAW LHP | 6-1, 205 lbs | Born: Kingston, NY. Age: 28

Acquired by the Marlins in the 2014 Rule 5 draft from the Minnesota Twins

Originally drafted by the Twins in the 42nd round of the 2011 June First-Year Player Draft out of Jacksonville University.

2016 Highlights: Tomshaw had three stints with Jacksonville from May 30-June 20, June 22-July 30, and August 5 through the end of the season. With Jacksonville he was 4-4 with a 3.63 ERA in 15 appearances and 14 starts. He struck out at least six batters in his last five starts for Jacksonville, beginning with a season-high of 10 on August 12 vs. Mississippi. Tomshaw was 0-1 with a 2.12 ERA in eight games in relief for the New Orleans Zephyrs, with his first five appearances coming in the month of May, and the final three in late July, early August. Tomshaw took his lone loss when he allowed a pair of runs in the 12th inning against the Colorado Springs Sky Sox on May 12. Tomshaw returned to the Zephyrs where he made an appearance June 21 allowing a hit with no walks with four strikeouts. Tomshaw in late July and August pitched for the Zephyrs in two relief outings on July 30 and August 3, turning in scoreless outings against the Nashville Sounds and Iowa Cubs. After some time in extended spring training, Tomshaw earned the win in his lone appearance with the High-A Jupiter Hammerheads on May 1. He worked three scoreless innings, allowing a hit with a strikeout.

2015 Highlights: Spent the majority of his first season in the Marlins system with Double-A Jacksonville. Tomshaw went 6-10 with a 4.33 ERA in 20 appearances and 18 starts. In his year as reliever: 1-1, 4.50 ERA in 11 G, started season as starter: 4-6, 5.35 ERA in 12 GS. Made two starts with Triple-A New Orleans in Mid-August, going 0-2 with a 17.18 ERA, allowing 15 runs (14 earned) in 7.1 IP.

2014 Highlights: He spent all of last year with advanced-A Fort Myers Miracle, going 11-6 with a 3.50 ERA in 25 games and 21 starts over 136.1 innings. On the campaign he set career highs for innings pitched (136.1) and tied his career high with 82 strikeouts. Tomshaw led the Miracle in wins (11), games started (21), and was second in total strikeouts (82).

2013 Highlights: He split 2013 with Fort Myers (A+) and Cedar Rapids (A-). With Fort Myers the southpaw posted a 4-4 mark to go along with a 3.94 ERA in 17 games and 14 starts over 96.0 innings. His 42 earned runs given up with FM were good for second-most he has allowed in a single stop. With CR, Tomshaw went 2-0 with a 5.10 ERA in nine games and four starts over 30.0 innings pitched. Batters hit .290 against Tomshaw at the low-A stop which was the worst of his career.

2012 Highlights: Tomshaw split 2012 between the GCL Twins and the Beloit Snappers (A). With GCL, he appeared in only two games and over his three innings pitched he allowed two hits. He spent the majority of the year with Beloit, going 4-6 attached to a 3.02 ERA in 20 games and 14 starts over 86.1 innings pitched. At the time that had been Tomshaw's first season with 20

2011 Highlights: After being drafted he had stops between the GCL Twins and Fort Myers. In his first year in rookie ball the southpaw mustered up a 3-0 record while pitching to a 2.16 ERA in 11 games over 16.2 innings. He would receive his first call up to Fort Myers and enter into the starting rotation setting a 2.13 ERA in seven games and four starts over 25.1 innings.

Personal: Tomshaw was drafted out of Jacksonville University, and in an interview with *twinsdaily.com* he highlighted some of his bright spots with JU. "One of my biggest wins was against University of Florida during the regular season at their stadium. They just came off taking two from Vanderbilt that weekend. At the time, Florida was ranked 4th in the nation, and we ended up beating them 11-2. After the College World Series was over and Florida finished 2nd only to South Carolina, did it hit me how big of a win that was. Also in my senior year in game 1 of the conference tournament against Eastern Tennessee State University, I threw a complete game allowing 5 hits, 1 unearned run and winning 2-1."
