

## **RAZORBACKS SET TO RETURN TO DICKEY-STEPHENS PARK IN 2018**

**LITTLE ROCK** – The Arkansas Razorbacks are set to return to Dickey-Stephens Park for the ninth time on Tuesday April 10, 2018 as they will host the Grambling State Tigers. First pitch is scheduled for 6:30 pm. This game will follow a 2018 regular season game between the Arkansas Travelers and Corpus Christi Hooks which is scheduled for 11:00 am.
