**AWAY FROM MAINE FOR A BIT:** The Portland Sea Dogs begin a nine-game road trip on Tuesday night against the Altoona Curve (Pirates affiliate) from Peoples Natural Gas Field in Altoona, PA...Portland is 5-5 against the Western Division but took three of four from the Curve at Hadlock Field on May 24-27...RHP **Denyi Reyes**, who beat Altoona on May 24, makes his team-leading 12th start of the season...The 'Dogs have won a season-high, three-straight road games.

**SEA DOGS FALL IN 12 INNINGS:** Bowie scored two runs in the top of the 12th inning against RHP **Matthew Gorst** (0-4) and held on for a 4-2 win on Sunday afternoon at Hadlock Field...Portland dropped two of three in the series and four of six on the homestand...The Sea Dogs received their runs on a run-scoring single from **Bobby Dalbec** and an RBI double from **Jarren Duran**...Bowie's bullpen allowed one unearned run over six innings on just one hit.

**A TRUE BULLPEN GAME:** LHP **Daniel McGrath** made the spot-start for Portland on Sunday and worked five scoreless frames on two hits, two walks, and five strikeouts...RHP **Jake Cosart** retired all six batters in relief and has allowed just one unearned run in five appearances with Portland.

**GOOD LUCK DARWINZON:** LHP **Darwinzon Hernandez** makes his first Major League start tonight against the Texas Rangers...This marks the third stint for Hernandez with Boston.

**QUITE THE SEA DOGS CONNECTION:** Altoona has two coaches with Portland ties, Hitting Coach **Jon Nunnally** served the same role with the Sea Dogs in 2016...Coach **Salvador Paniagua** played with Portland in 2007.

**MAY 31ST IN THE MEDIA GUIDE:** Portland established a franchise record for runs (20), hits (26), and total bases (48) in their 20-2 win on May 31 over the Binghamton Rumble Ponies at NYSEG Stadium.

**AGAINST THE OPPONENT:** Portland dropped four of seven to the Curve in 2018, and are 9-8-3 All-Time in season series...This series marks the final time these two teams meet in the regular season.
