Last Game: Tennessee Smokies right-hander Michael Rucker held the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp to one hit in six innings, and Tennessee third baseman Trent Giambrone homered and tripled to drive in four runs and lead a 7-2 Smokies win before 9,481 saw NAPA AutoCare Family Fireworks Friday night at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. The Smokies (19-15) took the lead with a four-run top of the second inning against Jacksonville right-hander Max Duval (1-4). Center fielder Trey Martin drew a one-out walk, and second baseman Carlos Penalver singled to put runners at first and third bases. Rucker put down a sacrifice bunt in front of home plate that scored Martin. Two batters later, Giambrone hit a three-run home run to the left-field berm. After that point, however, Duval retired 13 of the next 14 batters – including the last 11 in a row – to complete six innings. He allowed five total hits and one walk with a season-high eight strikeouts. Rucker (3-2) kept the 4-0 lead for the first five innings, as he retired 16 of the first 17 batters, with third baseman Brian Schales' second-inning single as the only hit for Jacksonville (13-21). In the sixth inning, Rucker hit pinch hitter Skyler Ewing with a pitch and walked center fielder Monte Harrison. With two outs, right fielder John Norwood grounded to Giambrone, whose errant throw to first base allowed Ewing and Harrison to score – both unearned runs – and put Norwood at third base. Rucker then struck out first baseman Eric Jagielo – the last of Rucker's season-high nine strikeouts. With a 4-2 lead, Tennessee extended its advantage in the top of the seventh inning against Jacksonville right-hander Jorgan Cavanerio. With two outs and a runner at first base, Giambrone hit an RBI triple down the right-field line. Three straight singles by shortstop Zack Short, right fielder Eddy Martinez and catcher Will Remillard added two runs to make it 7-2. Jacksonville right-hander Marcus Crescentini pitched hitless eighth and ninth innings. Tennessee right-hander Jake Stinnett pitched a scoreless seventh inning, and right-hander Scott Efron pitched scoreless eighth and ninth innings.

NEWS AND NOTES

April Flowers Bring May Showers: So far the month of May has not been kind to the Jumbo Shrimp. Through 10 games in May, the Jumbo Shrimp are 1-9, getting swept by the Shuckers in Biloxi and dropping four out of five games in the last series against Tennessee. As a team, Jacksonville is hitting .174 this month with three home runs and 17 RBI, and the pitching staff is 1-9 with a 3.61 ERA with no saves. Individually, Chris Diaz leads the way at the plate this month, as the shortstop is hitting .318 (7-for-22) with a run batted in. Several hitters have had a slow start to the month, with John Norwood hitting .121 this month, Eric Jagielo .143, Isan Diaz .152, and Cade Gotta .125 among regular Jacksonville starters. The Jumbo Shrimp had a 12-12 record at the end of April, going 3-2 in five series played.

Harrison on the S.L. Leaderboards: Jumbo Shrimp centerfielder Monte Harrison continues to be a steady presence in some Southern League statistical leaderboards. Coming into Saturday's game, Harrison is third in the league in at-bats (140), second in the league for doubles (12, only one behind Jackson's Kevin Medrano), runs scored (23), however he does lead the league with 55 strikeouts. Harrison is in his first year playing at the Double-A level, and was acquired by the Marlins from the Milwaukee Brewers as part of January's trade for Christian Yelich. Harrison is regarded by MLB.com as Miami's top prospect in 2018.

Bring on the Biscuits: I've got a hunger, you've got a hunger, we've got a series about to begin, so Bring on the Biscuits. Yeah Bring on the Biscuits. Oh Bring on the Biscuits, and let the series begin! The Biscuits fight song is a good way to start the first of three series this season between the Jumbo Shrimp and the Montgomery Biscuits, the Double-A affiliate of the Tampa Bay Rays. This marks Jacksonville's only trip to Montgomery this season, while the Biscuits will return to Jacksonville from June 28 to July 3, and July 23-27. Last season the Jumbo Shrimp struggled against the Biscuits, going 2-8 against Montgomery overall, going 1-4 in series both in Montgomery and at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Jumbo Shrimp left fielder Cade Gotta spent parts of the last two seasons with the Biscuits, being a Southern League Midseason All-Star in 2017 and he was a Southern League Postseason All-Star in 2016.

Shrimp Have Prospects: On the roster, the Jumbo Shrimp have five players who were listed by *MLB.com* as Top 30 Miami Marlins prospects for the 2018 season: OF Monte Harrison (1), Isan Diaz (7), RHP Nick Neidert (8), RHP Pablo Lopez (21), and John Norwood (30). Four of these five prospects were acquired by the Marlins in trades within the past 12 months.

TONIGHT'S JUMBO SHRIMP STARTING PITCHER

23 – NICK NEIDERT, RHP

LAST START: Neidert suffered his second straight loss, falling to the Tennessee Smokies on Monday May 7 at the Baseball Grounds. Neidert worked five innings where he allowed three runs (all earned) on six hits with a walk and a season-high seven strikeouts. Neidert received no run support, as the Shrimp lost 3-0.

SHUCKERS LOSS: Neidert suffered his second loss of the season on Wednesday May 2 against the Biloxi Shuckers at MGM Park. Neidert worked seven innings allowing two runs (both earned) on six hits with two walks and six strikeouts, as the Jumbo Shrimp fell by a 2-1 score to the Shuckers. Both runs allowed were in the bottom of the fourth, and that included a solo homer by Brewers catcher Stephen Vogt, with Biloxi on a major league rehab assignment.

SMOKIES WIN: Neidert earned his second win of the season with a victory on Wednesday April 25 at Tennessee against the Smokies. Neidert turned in five innings where he allowed two runs (both earned) on seven hits with no walks and three strikeouts as Jacksonville won the rubber match of the series 4-2.

DENBO ON NEIDERT: "He's another starting pitcher candidate for us," Marlins vice president of player development and scouting Gary Denbo said. "We believe he will have a chance in the future to join our starting rotation. He's only 21 years old. He has the ability to command his fastball," Denbo said. "His changeup is plus. We like the movement he has on the fastball because it's different than what you normally see. He's got deception, which makes it very difficult for batters to pick up the ball, and he's a good athlete. There's a lot of qualities there that make us believe he will help us in our starting rotation in Miami."

PROSPECT: Neidert enters the 2018 season as the Marlins No. 5 prospect according to Baseball America and the No. 8 prospect according to MLB.com.

#23 NICK NEIDERT RHP | 6-1, 180 lbs | Born: Nov. 20, 1996 in Atlanta, Ga. 21 Years Old.

Acquired by the Miami Marlins in a trade with the Seattle Mariners with RHP Robert Duggar, INF Chris Torres in exchange for Dee Gordon on Dec. 7, 2017.

2017 Highlights: Named the California League Pitcher of the Year after going 10-3 with a 2.76 ERA in 19 starts for Single-A Modesto in Seattle's system. Was a California League Midseason and Postseason All-Star, going 5-3 with a 3.31 ERA in 14 starts before the break, then 5-0 with a 1.45 ERA in five starts after the break. Earned California League Pitcher of the Week honors for July 3-9 after tossing seven shutout innings on July 6 at Visalia. Finished the season at Double-A Arkansas, making Travelers debut on July 22. With Arkansas he was 1-3 with a 6.56 ERA in six starts. Lost first three starts for Arkansas, snapped skid with a win in his fifth start on August 12 against Midland.

2016 Highlights: Spent all of 2016 with Single-A Clinton in the Midwest League, going 7-3 with a 2.57 ERA in 19 starts. Went 6-1 with a 2.22 ERA over his first eight starts. Factored in just three decisions (1-2) over final 11 starts, despite allowing one-or-zero runs in eight of those outings. Won four consecutive starts from June 15-July 3, posting 2.67 ERA during that span, setting a career high with 12 strikeouts on June 23 vs. Kane County, and also had 11 on July 3 at Peoria.

2015 Highlights: After he was selected by the Seattle Mariners in the second round of the 2015 draft, made 11 starts for the AZL Mariners, going 0-2 with a 1.53 ERA. There he held opponents scoreless in six of 11 starts.

Personal: Attended Peachtree Ridge High School in Suwanee, Georgia. Selected as a First Team All-American and Southeastern All-Region First Team by Perfect Game in 2015. Had signed to pitch at the University of South Carolina before signing with Mariners.
