Last Game: The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (5-9) fell to the Pensacola Blue Wahoos (11-3) by a 8-5 score in the fourth game of the five-game series at Blue Wahoos Stadium on Thursday night. Pensacola right-handed starter Deck McGuire (1-0) earned the win with six innings where he allowed four runs on six hits with two walks and seven strikeouts. Jacksonville starting pitcher Mike Kickham (0-2) took the loss, allowing seven runs on eight hits with no walks and four strikeouts. Domingo Tapia earned his first save of the year with a perfect ninth inning of relief. Jacksonville took the game's first lead in the top of the second on a solo homer by David Vidal, who previously played with Pensacola from 2012-13, as the Shrimp led 1-0. Pensacola came roaring back in the bottom of the second, with Gabriel Guerrero beginning the inning with a double before Aristides Aquino hit a two-run homer to right field to put the Wahoos in front 2-1. Taylor Sparks followed with an RBI double and then Brian O'Grady added an RBI triple to give the lead to 4-1, then Blake Trahan brought in a run when he reached on a fielder's choice to make it a 5-1 lead in the second. The Jumbo Shrimp cut into the lead with an RBI double by Vidal in the top of the fourth to make it a 5-2 game, then an inning later Alex Glenn had a two-run triple to make it a 5-4 ballgame. Aquino then started the bottom of the sixth inning against Kickham with a triple, then Angelo Gumbs blasted a two-run homer to left to put Pensacola's lead at 7-4. A wild pitch by reliever Hunter Adkins later scored Brian O'Grady to give the Wahoos an 8-4 advantage. Jacksonville scored its last run in the seventh when Jeremias Pineda brought in a run on a fielder's choice to put the score at 8-5, which would be the final. The Wahoos have now won the first four games of the series, as Jacksonville's losing streak has reached six games.

NEWS AND NOTES

Vidal Returns to Pensacola: Jacksonville second baseman David Vidal is making a homecoming of sorts this week in Pensacola. Vidal played for the Blue Wahoos in parts of the 2012 and 2013 seasons. In 2012 after starting the season at High-A Bakersfield, Vidal played in 97 games for the Blue Wahoos in their inaugural season, hitting .230 with 11 home runs and 39 runs batted in. In 2013 Vidal played in 46 games for the Blue Wahoos, hitting .206 with a home run and nine runs batted in. Counting his time in Jacksonville to start the season, Vidal is a career .229 hitter in the Southern League with 12 home runs and 50 runs batted in during 154 games. Vidal shined at the plate Monday for the Jumbo Shrimp, collecting two of Jacksonville's three hits. He also drove in Jacksonville's lone run in the top of the first on an RBI single, as the Jumbo Shrimp fell to the Blue Wahoos 3-1 in the opening game of the series. Vidal also had a big performance Tuesday going 2-for-5 with a run scored, as he had his sixth multi-hit game of the season. Vidal went 1-for-4 on Wednesday, driving in the go-ahead run with an RBI single in the eighth inning. Vidal's homecoming hit a high note on Thursday, going 2-for-3 with his first home run of the season, and he also had an RBI double to total a pair of runs batted in on the night. Vidal is currently in the midst of a six-game hitting streak, the longest active streak on the team.

Goodbye Wahoos: Today marks the final game of this series between the Shrimp and Wahoos, but the clubs will meet again in the first half from May 30-June 3 in Pensacola, the last Shrimp trip here this season. The Wahoos will be in Jacksonville from June 14-18, and at the end of the year from August 31 to Sept. 4.

Record Attendance in Jacksonville: With 41,276 in attendance over five days, Jacksonville fans made the inaugural Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp home series the highest-attended series in the 15-year history of the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Jacksonville's opening series attendance increased by 57 percent over last season, and has increased by 110 percent over the first two seasons of new ownership by Fast Forward Sports Group. After their game Sunday, the Jumbo Shrimp led all of the Southern League and Double-A baseball, while also ranking fifth in all of Minor League Baseball, in home attendance for the 2017 season. Wednesday's Opening Night sellout of 10,477 was the largest crowd at a Southern League game at the ballpark since July 3, 2012, and Jacksonville's largest opening crowd since a stadium record of 12,943 attended the ballpark's first-ever game on April 11, 2003.

LAST START: Mazza had a no decision in his start on Sunday April 16 at the Baseball Grounds against the Chattanooga Lookouts. Mazza turned in six scoreless innings where he only allowed two hits with no walks and six strikeouts. The game was scoreless when he left, and the difference in the game came on a Jonathan Rodriguez solo homer off Tayron Guerrero in the top of the seventh as the Lookouts won 1-0.

M-BRAVES LOSS: Mazza took the loss in his first start of the season on Monday April 10 against the Mississippi Braves at Trustmark Park. Mazza worked five innings, allowing five runs on seven hits with two walks and three strikeouts as he also allowed two homers. The M-Braves won the rubber match of the series by a 7-4 score.

2016 with JACKSONVILLE: Mazza spent most of 2016 in Jacksonville after starting the season with High-A Jupiter, and he was the first Hammerhead to be called up to Jacksonville that hadn't previously played at the Double-A level before. Mazza made his first professional start in an emergency start on May 15 when Jarlin Garcia was called up to the big leagues, and Mazza earned the victory with a five scoreless innings against the Montgomery Biscuits, and remained in the rotation until injury in mid-June.

INJURY AND GCL TIME: Following his win against the Shuckers on June 15, Mazza was placed on the disabled list on June 16 with right shoulder tendinitis. Mazza had a rehab assignment in early July with the GCL Marlins, where he was 1-1 with a 1.80 ERA in four appearances and three starts. Mazza returned to the Suns on July 23.

2016 with JUPITER: Mazza began the season in the bullpen for the High-A Jupiter Hammerheads in the Florida State League. Mazza was 1-0 with a 1.20 ERA in his seven relief outings, collecting eight strikeouts in his 15 innings of work. Mazza was called up to the Suns on May 1, and was the first player called up from High-A to Double-A for the Marlins in 2016.

Mazza was 1-0 with a 1.20 ERA in his seven relief outings, collecting eight strikeouts in his 15 innings of work. Mazza was called up to the Suns on May 1, and was the first player called up from High-A to Double-A for the Marlins in 2016. Mazza spent most of 2016 in Jacksonville after starting the season with High-A Jupiter, and he was the first Hammerhead to be called up to Jacksonville that hadn't previously played at the Double-A level before. Mazza made his first professional start in an emergency start on May 15 when Jarlin Garcia was called up to the big leagues, and Mazza earned the victory with a five scoreless innings against the Montgomery Biscuits, and remained in the rotation until injury in mid-June. Following his win against the Shuckers on June 15, Mazza was placed on the disabled list on June 16 with right shoulder tendinitis. Mazza had a rehab assignment in early July with the GCL Marlins, where he was 1-1 with a 1.80 ERA in four appearances and three starts. Mazza returned to the Suns on July 23. All told, Mazza was 6-5 with a 4.16 ERA in 19 appearances and 14 starts with Jacksonville.

2015 Highlights: Split the season between the Twins and the Marlins organizations. Mazza had five relief appearances with the GCL Twins with no record and a 0.00 ERA in six innings pitched. With the Cedar Rapids Kernels in the Midwest League, Mazza had no wins or losses and a 9.00 ERA in two games in relief and three innings pitched. Mazza was released by the Twins organization on July 22, 2015. The Miami Marlins signed him as minor league free agent on August 4, 2015, and assigned him to High-A Jupiter. With the Hammerheads, Mazza went 0-1 with a 3.60 ERA in 11 games in relief, striking out 11 batters in 15 innings pitched.

2014 Highlights: Mazza spent all of 2014 with Single-A Cedar Rapids in the Midwest League. With the Kernels, Mazza was 4-4 with a 2.79 ERA in 25 games pitched, and struck out 62 batters compared to 11 walks in 48 and a third innings pitched.

2013 Highlights: Mazza spent all of 2013 with Single-A Cedar Rapids in the Midwest League. With the Kernels, Mazza had no wins or losses and a 6.23 ERA in seven games pitched in relief with a pair of saves.

2012 Highlights: After he was drafted by the Twins, Mazza was 2-1 with a 0.60 ERA in nine relief outings for the GCL Twins. In the Appalachian League with Elizabethton, Mazza was 3-1 with a 3.45 ERA in nine games in relief, striking out 15 batters in his 15 and a third innings pitched.

College: Mazza pitched collegiately at Menlo College. Mazza is the program's all-time record holder in triples, saves, and is tied for home runs with an astounding 19. During the 2011 campaign, Mazza helped lead the Oaks to their first ever Conference Title with an impressive team leading .337 batting average, five home runs, and 41 RBIs while accumulating equally imposing stats on the mound, with a team low 2.37 ERA and nine saves. He was the first player ever drafted out of Menlo, although Gino Cimoli (1956-1965, All Star in 1957 with the Brooklyn Dodgers), and Bill Renna (1953-59) have played in the majors.

Personal: Mazza was originally selected by the Minnesota Twins in the 27th round of the 2011 draft out of Menlo College in Atherton, California. Mazza attended Clayton Valley HS in Concord, California, same alma mater as former major leaguers Clyde Mashore and Damon Mashore.
