Yesterday's Game: The River Cats were shut out for the fifth time this year, and second time at home. RHP Cy Sneed and two Grizzlies relievers pitched nine scoreless allowing just four singles to take the series finale. **C Ryan Hanigan** reached base three times to lead the offensive effort for the River Cats as he recorded a base hit and two walks. **INF Kelby Tomlinson** was on base twice before being replaced by Orlando Calixte in the seventh inning. Grizzlies backstop Garrett Stubbs scored two of the team's five runs as he found himself on base four times (two singles and two walks).

Today's Starter: LHP Matt Gage will kick things off for the River Cats as a five-game series gets underway in Reno. Gage has pitched well as of late, going six innings in each of his last two starts with a combined five earned runs and eight strikeouts. Though it will be his 11th game in the Pacific Coast League this season, it will be the first time Gage has faced the Aces. Reno bats .253 as a team against left-handers in 2018 compared to .289 off righties.

Hometown Kid: RHP Jordan Johnson was making his Triple-A debut just 20 minutes north of the town in which he grew up — Elk Grove. He attended Franklin High School before playing collegiately for California State University - Northridge. He pitched five innings on Tuesday night in front of a sold-out crowd, giving up four runs on six hits and four walks. After allowing all four of those runs in the first three innigs, Johnson retired eight of his final nine batters.

Streak Snapped: OF Steven Duggar had his second longest hitting streak of the season going at eight before his 0-for-4 performance ended things. During the run, Duggar batted .294 with four doubles and a home run amongst 10 total hits.

O-for-Osich: LHP Josh Osich has been one of the strongest arms out of the Sacramento bullpen lately. He pitched two more scoreless frames on Tuesday night to lower his ERA to 2.84. He has allowed just two earned runs over his last 11.1 innings pitched.

This Day in River Cats History: July 4, 2005: **INF Brant Colamarino** went 3-for-5 with 3 RBIs as the River Cats rocked the Colorado Springs Sky Sox 14-6 on the Fourth of July. The lefty had one of four Sacramento doubles and also scored a run in the rout. **INF Andrew Beattie** crushed his sixth home run of the season, a three-run shot in the sixth inning. River Cats starter **RHP Mike Ziegler** only lasted three innings, allowing 5 runs on 11 hits and a walk, but the bullpen shut things down as the Sacramento offense came to life.

ADVANCED HITTING STATS GLOSSARY*

PA: Plate Appearances

Plate Appearances are the total number of times a hitter completes a turn batting.

OPS: On-Base Plus Slugging

On-base Plus Slugging (OPS) is the sum of a player's on-base percentage (how often a player reaches base safely) and their slugging percentage (how many bases a player reaches per at bat).

ISO: Isolated Power

Isolated Power (ISO) is a measure of a hitter's raw power. Or, to look at it another way, it measures how good a player is at hitting for extra bases. The simplest way to calculate ISO is to subtract a player's Batting Average from their Slugging Percentage, which leaves us with a measure of just a player's extra bases per at bat.

BABIP: Batting Average on Balls In Play

Batting Average on Balls In Play (BABIP) measures how many of a batter's balls in play go for hits. Affected greatly by defense and luck, BABIP can dramatically affect a hitter's batting average. If a large number of a batter's balls in play go for hits, that can boost their batting average quite high. Similarly, if a large number of balls in play get caught, it can reduce a player's total offensive value.

wRC+: Weighted Runs Created Plus

Weighted Runs Created Plus measures the total number of runs a player contributes to their team. The formula accounts for a player's ability to get on base, their total number of bases, and their baserunning. The Plus version of the stat is park and league adjusted.

wOBA: Weighted On-Base Average

Weighted On-Base Average combines all the different aspects of hitting into one metric, weighting each of them in proportion to their actual run value. While batting average, on-base percentage, and slugging percentage fall short in accuracy and scope, wOBA measures and captures offensive value more accurately and comprehensively. (Due to no constant in minor league baseball, the wOBA statistic is approximate).

K% & BB%: Strikeout Rate and Walk Rate

Strikeout rate (K%) and walk rate (BB%) measure how often a position player walks or strikes out per plate appearance. They're measured in percentage form, so it's easy to compare between players and years.

ADVANCED PITCHING STATS GLOSSARY*

TBF: Total Batters Faced

Total Batters Faced measures the total number of plate appearances hitters have made against him.

AVG: Batting Average

Batting average is the rate of hits per at bat, calculated as hits/at bats.

BABIP: Batting Average on Balls In Play

Batting Average on Balls In Play (BABIP) measures how often a ball in play goes for a hit. Typically around 30% of all balls in play fall for hits, but there are several variables that can affect BABIP rates for individual players, such as defense, luck, and talent level. Hitters have more control over their BABIP than pitchers do.

LOB%: Left On Base Percentage

Left on Base Percentage (LOB%) measures the percentage of base runners that a pitcher strands on base over the course of a season. This stat does not use the left on base numbers reported in box scores, but instead is calculated using a pitcher's actual hits, walks, and runs allowed results.

FIP: Fielding Independent Pitching

Fielding Independent Pitching (FIP) measures what a player's ERA should have looked like over a given time period, assuming that performance on balls in play and timing were league average. (Due to no constant in minor league baseball, the FIP statistic is approximate).

K% & BB%: Strikeout Rate and Walk Rate

Strikeout rate (K%) and walk rate (BB%) measure how often a pitcher walks or strikes out a player per plate appearance. They're measured in percentage form, so it's easy to compare between players and years.

xFIP: Expected Fielding Independent Pitching

Same as FIP, but it normalizes a pitcher's home runs allowed based on their fly ball rate rather than simply using the raw number of home runs allowed.
