Last Game: After the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp took a 3-0 lead in the top of the first inning, the Mobile BayBears tied the game in the bottom of the inning and took the lead with a three-run third on the way to a 7-3 win and Jacksonville's season-high eighth straight loss in the second game of a four-game series at Hank Aaron Stadium Thursday night. The Jumbo Shrimp (3-11 second half, 31-51 overall) took their first-inning lead against Mobile right-hander Jesus Castillo (7-4), who allowed four straight one-out hits. Center fielder Monte Harrison singled to left field and went to third base on second baseman Isan Diaz's single to right field. Castillo's wild pitch scored Harrison, and designated hitter Peter O'Brien drove in Diaz with a double to center field. After shortstop Joe Dunand singled to left field, first baseman Eric Jagielo hit a sacrifice fly to make it 3-0. Castillo allowed only one more hit in the rest of his six-inning start, with one walk and five strikeouts, before right-handers Samil De Los Santos (one inning) and Daniel Procopio (two innings) pitched hitless relief. In the bottom of the first inning, Jumbo Shrimp right-hander Kolton Mahoney (3-4) walked Mobile shortstop Luis Rengifo, who went to second base on a groundout and scored on catcher Jack Kruger's RBI single to right field. First baseman Jared Walsh then hit a two-run home run to left field, tying the game, 3-3. In the third inning, Mobile center fielder Brennon Lund hit a leadoff infield single and went to third base on Mahoney's errant pickoff throw. Kruger hit a go-ahead RBI single to right field, stole second base, advanced to third base on a flyout and scored on third baseman Zach Houchins' RBI single to right field. Designated hitter Jose Rojas singled, and right fielder Brandon Sandoval hit a two-out RBI single to make it 6-3. Mahoney allowed six earned runs on eight hits and one walk with two strikeouts in three innings. The BayBears (8-5, 45-36) added their final run in the sixth inning against Jacksonville right-hander Lukas Schiraldi, who walked the first three batters of the inning before getting Lund to ground into a double play that tallied a run. Schiraldi pitched 2 1/3 innings, while fellow relievers Ryan Newell, Miguel Del Pozo and Kyle Keller combined for shutout relief.

NEWS AND NOTES

Miller Gets Hits: At the top of the order, Jacksonville is getting plenty of production from outfielder Brian Miller. Miller has hit safely in 12 of 14 games played for the Jumbo Shrimp since joining the club in the second half, and just saw a six-game hitting streak come to an end with last night's 0-for-4 game. Additionally, three of the games that he has hit safely he has had multi-hit games against the Biscuits. Miller was a 2018 Florida State League Midseason All-Star with Jupiter, where in 62 games hit .324 with 29 runs batted in along with 13 doubles, three triples, and 19 stolen bases. At time of promotion ranked first in the Florida State League in hits (83), third in FSL in average (.324), second in at-bats (256), third in stolen bases (19). Miller was selected by the Marlins just last year in the 2017 draft, picked in the first round.

Monte Ranked: Jumbo Shrimp center fielder and Marlins No. 1 prospect Monte Harrison has been among the league leaders in many categories this season. Coming into tonight's game, Harrison is tied for first in games played (82), tied for second in stolen bases (19), second in runs scored (55), tied for fourth in at-bats (304), and he also leads the league in strikeouts (132). Harrison was honored earlier this season as a Southern League Midseason All-Star.

Hello BayBears: This is the third of four series this season between the Jumbo Shrimp and the Mobile BayBears, the Double-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Angels. Earlier this season the Jumbo Shrimp won three out of four games played in the first home series of the year from April 11-14. The game on Sunday April 15 was postponed due to rain, creating the need for a doubleheader on Friday May 18. During the second series, the BayBears won four out of six games against the Jumbo Shrimp from May 18 to May 21. The BayBears do not return to Jacksonville, and the Jumbo Shrimp will make a return trip to Mobile from July 28-August 1. Last year Jacksonville had a winning record against Mobile, going 14-7 overall. The clubs split the two series at Hank Aaron Stadium 5-5, while the Jumbo Shrimp were 9-2 against the BayBears at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville last season.

Shrimp Have Prospects: On the roster, the Jumbo Shrimp have eight players who were listed by *MLB.com* as Top 30 Miami Marlins prospects for the 2018 season: OF Monte Harrison (1), Isan Diaz (7), RHP Nick Neidert (8), OF Brian Miller (10), Merandy Gonzalez (13), Joe Dunand (16), Robert Dugger (22) and John Norwood (30).

LAST START: Gonzalez had a no decision in Game One of Jacksonville's doubleheader against the Montgomery Biscuits at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville on Sunday July 1. He turned in five innings where he allowed four runs (all earned) n six hits with four walks and four strikeouts. His first four innings where scoreless before he allowed a grand slam home run to Nick Solak in the top of the fifth. Jacksonville lost 5-4.

BRAVES LOSS: Gonzalez took a loss in his start on Sunday June 24 against the Mississippi Braves at Trustmark Park. Gonzalez worked four plus innings, allowing a season-high seven runs on five hits with seven walks and two strikeouts as Jacksonville lost 17-1.

SHUCKERS START: Gonzalez had a no decision in his start on Sunday June 10 against the Biloxi Shuckers at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. He worked five innings where he allowed three runs (two earned) on four hits with three walks and three strikeouts in a game Jacksonville lost 11-4.

MARLINS TIME: He made his major league debut on April 19 at Milwaukee, working a scoreless two innings where he allowed two hits to the Brewers in a 12-3 loss. He earned his first major league win on April 25 at Los Angeles against the Dodgers, working three innings where he allowed three runs on five hits with a walk and no strikeouts, as he worked the fifth through the eighth inning in a game Miami won 8-6. He earned a win his next time out on April 30 in Miami against the Phillies, working two scoreless innings where he allowed a hit in the fifth and sixth as the Marlins won 8-4. He also had a scoreless two innings at Cincinnati on May 4, and then his last big league outing he gave up three runs on eight hits in three innings of work in a 13-4 loss to the Chicago Cubs at Wrigley Field. Gonzalez last pitched for the Marlins in the big leagues last Sunday June 17 at Baltimore, working four and a third innings of relief where he allowed four runs (all earned) on five hits with a walk and five strikeouts. Gonzalez overall this season with the Marlins in the majors is 2-0 with a 5.71 ERA in seven relief outings.

PROSPECT: Gonzalez, a member of the Marlins 40-man roster, enters 2018 as the Marlins No. 15 prospect according to Baseball America and No. 16 prospect according to MLB.com.

#38 MERANDY GONZALEZ RHP | 6-0, 216 lbs | Born: Oct. 9, 1995 in Cotui, Dominican Republic. 22 years old.

Acquired by the Miami Marlins in a trade with the New York Mets with OF Ricardo Cespedes in exchange for RHP AJ Ramos on July 28, 2017.

2017 Highlights: Combined to go 13-3 with one save and a 1.66 ERA between three teams and two organizations in 2017. Established career bests in ERA, appearances (22), starts (20), innings pitched (130.1), and strikeouts (103). Began season with Single-A Columbia Fireflies in the South Atlantic League where he was teammates with Tim Tebow, and went 8-1 with a 1.55 ERA in his 11 starts. Over first four starts of season, tossed 28.1 scoreless innings, allowing just 15 hits and three walks while striking out 23. Went 4-0 with 0.00 ERA (28.1/0) in four April starts, earning South Atlantic League Player of the Month honors. Struck out 23 while holding opponents to a .160 average. Named South Atlantic League Midseason All-Star after going 8-1 with 1.55 ERA (69.2/12) in 11 starts before break. Promoted to High-A St. Lucie on June 22 and with the St. Lucie Mets was 4-2 with a 2.23 ERA in six starts. Following trade to Marlins organization, went 1-0 with a 1.11 ERA in five appearances and three starts for the High-A Jupiter Hammerheads.

2016 Highlights: Made 14 starts for Single-A Short-Season Brooklyn, going 6-3 with a 2.87 ERA.

2015 Highlights: Split the year between the GCL Mets where he was 2-1 with a 2.05 ERA in four appearances and two starts, and also the Kingsport Mets in the rookie Appalachian League where he was 2-2 with a 2.82 ERA in nine appearances and seven starts.

2014 Highlights: With the DSL Mets2 he was 0-2 with a 5.48 ERA in six appearances and five starts, while with the DSL Mets1 he was 2-1 with a 2.05 ERA in four appearances and two starts.
