Last Game: Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp right fielder John Norwood hit his third walk-off home run of the season in the bottom of the 10th inning of a 3-2 win – the first-place club's third in four days – over the Biloxi Shuckers in front of 5,819 on Wednesday afternoon's Big Splash Day at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Norwood led off the bottom of the 10th inning against Shuckers left-hander Nick Ramirez (4-3). The first three pitches were balls, but Norwood hit the next offering to the right-field bleachers for his 14th home run – tied with teammate Brian Anderson for third in the Southern League and first in the South Division. Norwood has 10 home runs at the Baseball Grounds this season, including walk-off home runs April 30 against Mobile and May 20 against Mississippi. Right-hander Omar Bencomo made his first second-half start and went the first five scoreless innings against Jacksonville (11-9 second half, 41-49 overall). He scattered three hits and one walk with four strikeouts. He twice picked off baserunners from first base to keep Biloxi (9-11, 45-44) without a runner in scoring position. Shuckers right-hander Freddy Peralta also had a scoreless start until the sixth inning. With two outs, he hit Anderson with a pitch, and Norwood singled to center field. Left-hander Quintin Torres-Costa entered to face catcher Cam Maron, who hit an RBI single to left field for a 1-0 lead. Peralta allowed an earned run on three hits and a walk and five strikeouts in 5 2/3 innings. The 1-0 lead lasted until the eighth inning. With one out, right-hander Severino Gonzalez allowed third baseman Javier Betancourt's single and catcher Dustin Houle's two-run home run to right field, giving Biloxi a 2-1 lead. Right-hander Jorge Lopez began the bottom of the eighth inning and allowed a leadoff single to first baseman Miguel Rojas, who finished 1-for-3 while playing nine innings in the second game of his rehab assignment in Jacksonville. Norwood singled to put runners at first and third bases, and Maron hit a game-tying sacrifice fly. Gonzalez and Lopez each pitched scoreless ninth innings, although Jacksonville loaded the bases. Right-hander Clayton Mortensen pitched a scoreless top the 10th inning, working around a runner at second base with no outs after first baseman Dustin DeMuth struck out but reached on Maron's throwing error – a play manager Randy Ready argued before being ejected by home plate umpire Travis Godec.

NEWS AND NOTES

Rojas Joins Shrimp on Rehab Assignment: Miami Marlins infielder Miguel Rojas has had his major league rehab assignment transferred from High-A Jupiter to Jacksonville. In three games with the Hammerheads, Rojas was 2-for-8 at the plate with a run batted in. Rojas earlier this season with the Marlins played in 24 games in the big leagues where he hit .338 (22-for-65) with no homers and four runs batted in with four doubles. Rojas has been on the Marlins 60-day disabled list since May 9 with a right thumb fracture. Rojas has played in four big league seasons, first making his major league debut with the Los Angeles Dodgers in 2014. That offseason he was traded from the Dodgers to the Marlins as part of a seven-player trade. Rojas has played in parts of the past three seasons for Miami. Rojas in his four-year major league career has hit .249 with three homers and 44 runs batted in. Rojas previously played in the Southern League for the Carolina Mudcats (2010-11), Pensacola Blue Wahoos (2012), and Chattanooga Lookouts (2013). Rojas in the first game of his rehab assignment on Tuesday went 0-for-4 at the plate with a sacrifice bunt. Rojas played all of Tuesday's game at shortstop, and yesterday was Jacksonville's starting first baseman. In that contest, Rojas went 1-for-3 at the plate with a run scored, and left the game after scraping his knee in the ninth inning.

Lee Leads The League: Jumbo Shrimp centerfielder Braxton Lee continues to lead the Southern League in hitting with a .328 batting average, and his 102 hits are also tops in the Southern League, in addition to his 57 runs scored. Lee had been the Southern League Player of the Week after hitting .571 from June 26 to July 2 in his first week as a Jumbo Shrimp.

LAST START: Tomshaw suffered a loss in his start in Game One of Jacksonville's doubleheader at Montgomery on Saturday June 8. Tomshaw turned in five innings where he allowed six runs on eight hits with a walk and two strikeouts as Jacksonville lost 6-4.

BAYBEARS START: Tomshaw earned his eighth win of the year and second straight victory with a win over the Mobile BayBears on Sunday July 2 at the Baseball Grounds. Tomshaw turned in seven innings where he allowed two runs on four hits with no walks and three strikeouts as the Shrimp won 6-4.

FIRST LOOKOUTS START: Tomshaw earned his first win in 2017 on Thursday April 13 at the Baseball Grounds when he defeated Chattanooga. Tomshaw turned in five innings where he allowed one run (no earned runs) on three hits with two walks and four strikeouts as the Jumbo Shrimp won 5-3.

ALL-STAR: Tomshaw was named a 2017 Southern League All-Star, along with fellow left-handed starting pitcher Mike Kickham, third baseman Brian Anderson, and outfielder John Norwood. This is the first All-Star honor of Tomshaw's career.

#18 MATT TOMSHAW LHP | 6-1, 205 lbs | Born: Kingston, NY. Age: 28

Acquired by the Marlins in the 2014 Rule 5 draft from the Minnesota Twins

Originally drafted by the Twins in the 42nd round of the 2011 June First-Year Player Draft out of Jacksonville University.

2016 Highlights: Tomshaw had three stints with Jacksonville from May 30-June 20, June 22-July 30, and August 5 through the end of the season. With Jacksonville he was 4-4 with a 3.63 ERA in 15 appearances and 14 starts. He struck out at least six batters in his last five starts for Jacksonville, beginning with a season-high of 10 on August 12 vs. Mississippi. Tomshaw was 0-1 with a 2.12 ERA in eight games in relief for the New Orleans Zephyrs, with his first five appearances coming in the month of May, and the final three in late July, early August. Tomshaw took his lone loss when he allowed a pair of runs in the 12th inning against the Colorado Springs Sky Sox on May 12. Tomshaw returned to the Zephyrs where he made an appearance June 21 allowing a hit with no walks with four strikeouts. Tomshaw in late July and August pitched for the Zephyrs in two relief outings on July 30 and August 3, turning in scoreless outings against the Nashville Sounds and Iowa Cubs. After some time in extended spring training, Tomshaw earned the win in his lone appearance with the High-A Jupiter Hammerheads on May 1. He worked three scoreless innings, allowing a hit with a strikeout.

2015 Highlights: Spent the majority of his first season in the Marlins system with Double-A Jacksonville. Tomshaw went 6-10 with a 4.33 ERA in 20 appearances and 18 starts. In his first year as reliever: 1-1, 4.50 ERA in 11 G, started season as starter: 4-6, 5.35 ERA in 12 GS. Made two starts with Triple-A New Orleans in Mid-August, going 0-2 with a 17.18 ERA, allowing 15 runs (14 earned) in 7.1 IP.

2014 Highlights: He spent all of last year with advanced-A Fort Myers Miracle, going 11-6 with a 3.50 ERA in 25 games and 21 starts over 136.1 innings. On the campaign he set career highs for innings pitched (136.1) and tied his career high with 82 strikeouts. Tomshaw led the Miracle in wins (11), games started (21), and was second in total strikeouts (82).

2013 Highlights: He split 2013 with Fort Myers (A+) and Cedar Rapids (A-). With Fort Myers the southpaw posted a 4-4 mark to go along with a 3.94 ERA in 17 games and 14 starts over 96.0 innings. His 42 earned runs given up with FM were good for second-most he has allowed in a single stop. With CR, Tomshaw went 2-0 with a 5.10 ERA in nine games and four starts over 30.0 innings pitched. Batters hit .290 against Tomshaw at the low-A stop which was the worst of his career.

2012 Highlights: Tomshaw split 2012 between the GCL Twins and the Beloit Snappers (A). With GCL, he appeared in only two games and over his three innings pitched he allowed two hits. He spent the majority of the year with Beloit, going 4-6 attached to a 3.02 ERA in 20 games and 14 starts over 86.1 innings pitched. At the time that had been Tomshaw's first season with 20

2011 Highlights: After being drafted he had stops between the GCL Twins and Fort Myers. In his first year in rookie ball the southpaw mustered up a 3-0 record while pitching to a 2.16 ERA in 11 games over 16.2 innings. He would receive his first call up to Fort Myers and enter into the starting rotation setting a 2.13 ERA in seven games and four starts over 25.1 innings.

Personal: Tomshaw was drafted out of Jacksonville University, and in an interview with *twinsdaily.com* he highlighted some of his bright spots with JU. "One of my biggest wins was against University of Florida during the regular season at their stadium. They just came off taking two from Vanderbilt that weekend. At the time, Florida was ranked 4th in the nation, and we ended up beating them 11-2. After the College World Series was over and Florida finished 2nd only to South Carolina, did it hit me how big of a win that was. Also in my senior year in game 1 of the conference tournament against Eastern Tennessee State University, I threw a complete game allowing 5 hits, 1 unearned run and winning 2-1."
