Giants Begin Three-Game Series Against Stockton... The San Jose Giants open a three-game series against the Stockton Ports (Oakland Athletics affiliate) this evening at Municipal Stadium. Sandro Cabrera (6-0, 3.12 ERA) is slated to make the start on the mound for the Giants tonight. In two appearances (one start) against Stockton this season, Cabrera has pitched nine innings with one unearned run allowed.

Homestand Update... The Giants are currently in the midst of a season-high 10-game homestand. San Jose is 4-3 thus far on the homestand having taken three out of four from Visalia before dropping two out of three to Modesto. During the homestand, the Giants have fashioned a 2.59 ERA, but own just a .220 team batting average.

First Half Race... The Giants (30-27) are five games behind first-place Stockton (35-22) in the first half North Division race. 13 games remain in the first half. Beginning today, San Jose will play seven out of their next ten games against the Ports. In addition to the current series, the Giants play a four-game set in Stockton from June 11-14.

Inside The Season Series... San Jose is 5-2 against Stockton this season. Three out of the five wins for the Giants have come by one run, including back-to-back extra-inning triumphs on April 14 and 15 at Municipal Stadium. During their most recent meeting (May 18-20 at Stockton), San Jose allowed only five runs during the three-game series (won two of three). The Giants are batting only .203 against Ports pitching this season. Conversely, Stockton hitters have posted just a .214 batting average versus San Jose.

Best Home Record... At 17-12, the Giants boast the top home record in the California League. San Jose owns six walk-off wins this year. The Giants possess a sparkling 2.91 team ERA at home this season (4.10 ERA on the road). San Jose does need a win tonight to avoid dropping three straight home games for the first time this year.

Miller Among League Leaders... Jalen Miller enters tonight's contest ranked eighth in the California League in batting average (.304) and second in hits (65). Miller smacked two home runs in the homestand opener on May 28 against Visalia – the first multi-homer game of his career. He also delivered a walk-off RBI single in the bottom of the 11th inning the next night. Miller's six home runs this season have already equaled his total from all of last year with San Jose (in 117 games played). The former third round draft pick has a batting average 77 points higher than his final mark in 2017 in the California League (.227).

On The Mound... The Giants' team ERA of 3.47 ranks second in the California League (Visalia leads at 3.24). San Jose picked-up their sixth shutout of the season last Friday – one off the league lead (Inland Empire). The Giants have also allowed the fewest home runs in the league (27) this year. However, San Jose pitchers have issued the most walks of any staff in the league (223, 3.9 per game).

Hitting Woes... Over their last 10 games, the Giants are batting only .214 as a team, including a .189 mark (18-for-95) with runners in scoring position.

Streak Ends... San Jose saw a long streak come to an end last Saturday when Modesto scored four runs in the top of the ninth inning to rally for a 7-4 victory. The defeat snapped a streak of 78 consecutive wins for the Giants when leading after eight innings dating back to August 30, 2016. San Jose had been 21-0 this season when leading after eight innings after going 55-0 last year. The Giants were the only team in the league last season to own a perfect record when leading after eight.

30 Wins... At 30-27 overall, the Giants have already equaled their first half win total from last season (30-40).

* Tonight marks his fifth start and 12th overall appearance of the season ... Leads the California League with six wins ... Has struck out 49 batters in 52 innings ... Has induced nine double plays to lead the Giants staff.

* Last three appearances have been as a starter ... Is 1-0 with a 1.45 ERA over the three starts ... Has pitched 18 2/3 innings with four runs (three earned) allowed, eight walks and 15 strikeouts.

* Most recent start came on May 30 against Visalia ... Tossed a career-high tying seven innings with two runs (both earned) and seven hits allowed ... Walked four and struck out four ... Threw a season-high 93 pitches ... Received a no-decision (left game with score tied 2-2, Giants eventually lost 3-2 in 10 innings).

* Has made one previous start against Stockton on May 19 at Banner Island Ballpark ... Picked-up the win after pitching 5 2/3 innings with one unearned run allowed ... Gave up five hits, walked four and struck out five ... Took a shutout into the sixth ... Giants won the game 2-1.

* Is 1-0 with a 2.28 ERA as a starter (4 GS).

* Has recorded the win in five out of his seven relief appearances ... Has followed Mac Marshall in every relief outing ... Owns a 3.81 ERA as a reliever ... Has pitched at least three innings in every relief appearance (at least four innings in five out of seven outings).

* Has fared better against left-handed hitters (.246 AVG) compared to versus right-handed batters (.317 AVG) ... Limiting the opposition to a .197 batting average with runners in scoring position ... Opponents are batting .354 against him leading off an inning.

* Spent the entire 2017 season pitching for Augusta (A) ... Was 1-2 with a 4.14 ERA in 42 games (one start) ... Struck out 72 and walked 36 in 67 1/3 innings ... Allowed only four home runs for the entire year ... Limited left-handed hitters to a .231 AVG (.276 AVG vs. right-handed batters).
