TODAY'S GAME: Rubber match of a three-game series against the Dunedin Blue Jays (TOR) from Spectrum Field (1-1)...Finale of a six-game stretch at Spectrum Field with three against the Tarpons and three against the Dunedin Blue Jays (TOR) (1-4) - two "road" games against Dunedin...Clearwater is coming off a three-game sweep at the hands of the Tampa Tarpons Aug. 2-4...Fourth of five series against the two clubs in 2019...Clearwater dropped two of the first three games of the season against Dunedin at Spectrum Field, and dropped two of three against the Blue Jays at home May 31-June 2.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: 21-year-old Andrew Brown makes his 21st appearance - 18th start - of the rubber match of the three-game set against the Dunedin Blue Jays on Wednesday afternoon at Spectrum Field...The 6-foot-1 hurler suffered his sixth loss of the season on Aug. 1 against the Florida Fire Frogs (ATL) at Osceola County Stadium...The right-hander allowed four runs on seven hits, two walks and five strikeouts across five innings of work...Wednesday will be the Alpine, Calif. native's second start against the Blue Jays...Brown squared off against the Toronto Blue Jays affiliate on May 9 at Jack Russell Memorial Stadium and earned the win with just one run allowed on three knocks, a free pass and four punch outs...The starter has not earned a win since that appearance.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Clearwater Threshers blasted three long balls to help take down the Dunedin Blue Jays, 5-1, Tuesday night at Spectrum Field to even up the three-game series at a game apiece...Simón Muzziotti, Dalton Guthrie and Luke Miller each deposited dingers, giving the Threshers five through the first two games of the series...José Taveras tossed seven quality frames in his first start at the Advanced-A level in the winning effort...The 25-year-old allowed the one run on a home run off the bat of Norberto Obeso, but otherwise scattered six hits throughout the contest while issuing just one walk and striking out three...Austin Ross picked up his fourth save in five chances with two scoreless innings of work out of the bullpen.

SIMÓN SAYS: Simón Muzziotti has strolled around the bases just three times this season, but two of the 20-year-old's home runs have come against the Dunedin Blue Jays...The left-handed batter is hitting .353 in eight games against the Toronto Blue Jays affiliate in 2019, with a .405 OBP and a .994 OPS...The native of Venezuela has hit .315 over his past 15 games dating back to July 22, helping to lift his average from .277 to .286.

MILLER TIME: Luke Miller has found the power stroke against the Blue Jays at Spectrum Field...The Indiana product has smacked five home runs on the season, but two have come the past two nights to start out the three-game series...The right-handed batter had not left yard since taking the Palm Beach Cardinals' Alvaro Seijas deep on July 11 in Clearwater.

THE FIGHT OF THE IRISH: Matt Vierling extended his hitting streak to five games with a lead-off double in the second inning...The Notre Dame product finished the night 1-for-4, but is still hitting .400 (8-for-20) since the streak began on Aug. 2...The 22-year-old had been on a cold streak over the previous 58 games, seeing his batting average fall from .304 on May 16 to .226 on Aug. 1...The current streak has raised the 2018 fifth-round picks average by nine points from .226 to .235.

GATOR CHOMP: Dalton Guthrie continued to swing a hot bat in the second half with a 1-for-3 night in the win...The Florida product stroked his first round tripper since going deep against the Florida Fire Frogs on July 13 with a solo blast in the sixth...The 23-year-old is hitting .314 since the start of the second half after posting a .193 mark prior to the All-Star break...The right-handed hitter has 11 multi-hit performances in the second half, helping to raise his season average to .254...Guthrie has 15 more hits (37-22), an equal amount of doubles (6), one more triple (2-1), two more home runs (3-1), and four more RBIs (12-8) in the second half compared to the first.

PILING ON THE PUNCH OUTS: The duo of José Taveras and Austin Ross combined for just four strikeouts on the mound in the win on Tuesday night, but the Clearwater Threshers remain the only team in the Florida State League with at least 1,000 punch outs on the season...The Threshers sit atop the league with 1,034, and lead the Fort Myers Miracle (MIN) by 52 for the top-spot.
