Today's Game: The Nashville Sounds and Memphis Redbirds play their regular season finale this afternoon at First Tennessee Park. Memphis leads the four-game series, two games to one, with a 2-1 win last night. Today, right-hander Sam Bragg starts for the Sounds against right-hander Chris Ellis for the Redbirds.

Sam Bragg: 25-year-old Sam Bragg starts for the Sounds in today's season finale. The right-hander is making his Sounds and Triple-A debut after spending all of 2018 with the Double-A Midland RockHounds. In 33 games (5 starts) with Midland, Bragg was 4-5 with a 3.62 ERA. He covered 69.2 innings and allowed 78 hits and 26 walks to go along with 44 strikeouts. He last pitched on August 26 in a start against the Frisco Roughriders and tossed 4.0 innings in Midland's 7-3 win. He allowed two runs (both unearned) on one hit. He walked two and struck out three among his 58 pitches. In his minor-league career, he's 24-14 with a 3.38 ERA in 218 games (7 starts). The Athletics drafted Bragg in the 18th round of the 2012 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Georgia Perimeter College.

Chris Ellis: 25-year-old Chris Ellis starts for the Redbirds today. The right-hander is 6-4 with a 3.86 ERA in 15 games (13 starts) with Memphis in 2018. He started the year with Double-A Springfield where he went 4-0 with a 4.19 ERA in 15 games (7 starts). Overall in 2018, Ellis is 10-4 with a 3.99 ERA in 30 games. He has covered 130.2 innings and has allowed 118 hits and 37 walks to go along with 124 strikeouts. Ellis last pitched on August 29 in a start against Round Rock and blanked the Express over five innings. He allowed two hits and walked one in his sixth win of the season. In his career, Ellis is 40-35 with a 4.48 ERA in 123 games (98 starts). He was drafted in the third round of the 2014 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Ole Miss.

2018 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following amount of days in the American Southern Division standings in 2018: First: 1, Second: 104, Third: 42, Fourth: 3.

The Finale: Today's contest in the final game of the year for the Sounds. Nashville has won four consecutive regular season finales with wins over New Orleans (2017), Omaha (2015), Round Rock (2014) and Iowa (2013). The regular season finale in 2016 due to rain in New Orleans. The last time the Sounds lost on the final day of the regular season was a 2-1 setback to Memphis in 2012.

Powell's 10-Game Streak: Outfielder Boog Powell is the latest Sound to put together a 10-game hitting streak. Powell's 10-game streak represents the 10th separate 10+ game hitting streak by a Sounds player in 2018. He joins Ramon Laureano, Nick Martini and Sheldon Neuse who have each had two 10+ game hitting streaks, and BJ Boyd, Dustin Fowler and Anthony Garcia who have each had a 10+ game hitting streak this year.

Jorge's League-Leading 16 Triples: Shortstop Jorge Mateo has 16 triples this year, setting a single-season Sounds triples record. The last time a Sounds player led their respective league in triples was when Rich Thompson had 13 in 2004.

Debutants: Six different Sounds made their Triple-A debuts in the last three games and more are anticipated in today's finale. Pitchers Aiden McIntyre, Daniel Martinez, Ismael Aquino and Calvin Coker, catcher Sean Murphy and infielder Nick Ward have all made their Triple-A debuts in the last three games. Sam Bragg is making his Sounds and Triple debut today and right-hander Richard Morban is expected to make a relief appearance which will also be his Sounds and Triple-A debut.

Attendance Chase: Last night's sellout crowd of 11,692 was the largest of the season at First Tennessee Park. It was the 20th sellout of the year and 75th all-time. With 595,353 fans this year, the Sounds have set a First Tennessee Park single-season attendance record.

Murphy's Debut: 23-year-old catcher Sean Murphy made his Sounds and Triple-A debut Saturday. He went 2-for-4 and threw out a would-be base-stealer in the debut. Murphy is the #3 prospect in the A's organization and the #4 catcher prospect in all of baseball, according to MLB Pipeline. Murphy began the season in Double-A Midland where he hit .288 (74-for-257) with 51 runs, 26 doubles, 8 home runs and 43 RBI in 68 games before he suffered a broken hamate bone in July.

Roster Revamp: The Sounds made another roster move yesterday after 24 in the previous two days.

Against Memphis: The Sounds have done well against the division champion Memphis Redbirds this season, winning 8 of the first 15 games against them. Pitching has been the key factor in the season series as Nashville's pitching staff has posted a 3.21 ERA against the Redbirds while the offense has hit just .233. Anthony Garcia and Jorge Mateo are the only Sounds players to play in all 15 games against Memphis this season. Garcia is batting .315 (17-for-54) with 9 runs, 12 RBI and 5 home runs while Mateo is hitting .250 (13-for-52) with 8 runs and 7 RBI.

Sheldon's Steady Rise: After a slow start to the season in which he hit .141 (10-for-71) in April and .218 (22-for-101) in May, third baseman Sheldon Neuse has found his groove at the plate. Neuse hit .306 (30-for-98) in June and .306 (34-for-111) in July, and hit .284 (31-for-109) in 27 games in the month of August. After the All-Star break, Neuse is hitting .320 (62-for-195) with 29 RBI, 20 runs scored and 13 extra-base hits.

He struck out three and threw 37 of his 58 pitches for strikes. Bragg got a no-decision in Midland's 7-3 win.
