ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Hillcats capitalized on a big first inning against the Carolina Mudcats and held on to win 4-2 on Monday in the series opener. Lynchburg scored three runs in the bottom of the first inning, capped off by a two-run triple off the bat of **Oscar Gonzalez**. The Hillcats went 2-for-3 with runners in scoring position, making the most of the few opportunities the Mudcats gave them. On the hill, Lynchburg received a solid start from **Matt Solter** in his Carolina League debut, and the bullpen fired three perfect innings to close out the game.

HANG TEN: The Hillcats continue their season-high ten-game home stand on Tuesday when the Carolina Mudcats come to town. The stretch contains series against the Red Sox, the Carolina Mudcats, and the Myrtle Beach Pelicans. In total, Lynchburg has 17 scheduled home games for the month of May (one of which has already been rained out and moved to a road contest, and two of which have been canceled due to rain). To make up for it, the Hillcats have a 15-game road stretch starting in the end of July and lasting through the middle of August.

GIVE HIM AN OSCAR: **Oscar Gonzalez** had a very complete game for the Hillcats on Monday, going 2-for-3 while drawing his first walk of the season. Prior to Monday's game, Gonzalez had collected the most at-bats in the Carolina League without a walk (129). The outfielder also added his third triple of the season along with a double, two RBI, and two runs scored.

DOING SOME SWEEPING: **Robert Broom** earned his first save of the season on Monday with a clean ninth inning of work, striking out one batter in a perfect frame. The right-hander lowered his ERA to a team-best 0.55 and now has 23 strikeouts against just seven walks in 16.1 innings of work out of the pen.

THE WILD NORTH: The Lynchburg Hillcats find themselves in a strange spot in the Carolina League Northern Division as the season stretches well into its second month. The Hillcats are currently in second place in the division and sport the division's third-best run differential (18-17, -6). The Wilmington Blue Rocks lead the division despite having the north's worst run differential (20-15, -23) while the team with the best run differential, the Salem Red Sox, are in fourth place out of five (15-20, +22).

TOP-30 IN THE HILL CITY: Lynchburg enters the season with a trio of top-30 prospects according to *Baseball America*. Third baseman **Nolan Jones**, the second overall prospect in the system, returns to Lynchburg after playing in 30 games for the Hillcats in 2018. Starting pitcher **Jean Carlos Mejia**, listed at No. 17, appeared in one game for Lynchburg last year after spending the majority of the season with Lake County. Outfielder **Oscar Gonzalez** rounds out the group, as the No. 22 overall prospect. He spent all of 2018 with the Lake County Captains, where he ranked fifth in the Midwest League in hits with 135.

VETERAN AT THE HELM: The Hillcats are led this season by veteran MiLB skipper Jim Pankovits, who managed Mahoning Valley, Cleveland's Short-Sea-son affiliate last year. Pankovits has managed more than 2,600 games in his minor league career, which includes stops in the Boston Red Sox, Seattle Mariners, and Houston Astros organizations. Pankovits picked up his 1,300th career managerial victory on April 21 against Myrtle Beach.

Pankovits is in his second year managing in the Indians organization after leading the Mahoning Valley Scrappers in 2018. Pankovits has 16 years of managerial experience under his belt with the Red Sox, Astros, Mariners, and Indians organizations. 2019 marks Pankovits' second stint in the Carolina League after he led the Salem Red Sox from 2006-2008. The Pennington Gap, Virginia native enjoyed a Major League career with the Astros and Red Sox as an infielder that spanned six seasons from 1984-1990.

Torres enters his first season with the Hillcats after serving as the pitching coach for Lake County in 2018. The former left-handed pitcher was selected with the 10th overall draft pick in 2000 by the Anaheim Angels and played in the minor leagues for 13 seasons, eventually reaching Triple-A. The 36-year-old Torres is a native of the Bronx, NY.

Narron comes to Lynchburg by way of Triple-A Columbus where he served in the same capacity for the Clippers in 2018. Narron is entering his third season in the Indians organization and brings Major League coaching experience to the Hillcats' staff after serving as the Milwaukee Brewers hitting coach from 2012-2014. With the Brewers, he instructed stars such as Ryan Braun, Jean Segura, Aramis Ramirez, and Carlos Gomez.

2019 will mark Mergenthaler's first season coaching stateside after serving as the hitting coach for Cleveland's Dominican Summer League co-op for two seasons. Mergenthaler is no stranger to the Commonwealth, having starred at Richmond in his college days.

Legan is entering his first season with the Hillcats and fifth in the Indians organization. Legan held the same position with the Captains in 2018.

NOTABLES:

- Has struck out exactly 4-5 batters while walking 2-4 batters in every start so far this year
- Added the curve ball to his repertoire over the offseason after featuring just three offerings last season
- Was named to Arizona Fall League roster last year, playing for the Glendale Desert Dogs
- Went 1-3 with a 5.59 ERA in 19.1 innings while walking 14 and striking out 15 with the Desert Dogs in 2018
- Underwent Tommy John surgery less than a month before he was drafted by the Indians in 2015
- ON TOMMY JOHN: Garza learned his fate at the doctor's office on May 11, 2015. He couldn't face his parents waiting downstairs. They believed in him more than anyone else.
- His father, Charlie, hit with him for hours every Sunday; his mother, Linda, never missed a game. Garza, an only child, didn't want them to think his career was over, that the dreams they shared as a family were over.
- Two days earlier, Garza felt fine pitching the first three innings against UC Santa Barbara. His first pitch of the fourth inning hurt badly. The second, worse. The third, even worse. The fourth, unmanageable, as his arm burned.
- "I think right away we knew something was wrong because Justin would never take himself out of a game," Linda said.

Drafted by the Indians in the 8th Round of 2015 out of Cal State Fullerton...Tore his UCL shortly before the draft, requiring him to miss his first season of pro ball...At CSF became the 4th Titan all-time to throw a no-hitter, doing so against Cal State Northridge in 2014 (3-0 win, 12 K)...Pitched for Team USA in the summer of 2014, compiling a 2-1 record and a 1.35 ERA...In high school was named an All-American by MaxPreps and Baseball America...Was drafted by the Indians in the 26th Round in 2012 but did not sign... As a senior in 2012 at Bonita HS in California, he finished the year with a 12-1 record, 0.72 ERA and 101 strikeouts in 88 innings pitched while also batting .391
