SNAPPER SNIPPETS

LEADS LOST: Beloit lost a 2-0 lead on Thursday, the 7th game since June 6 that the Snappers have led in a game & lost. Beloit took a 6-5 in the 9th at Burlington on June 6 before the Bees plated 2 to win in the bottom half. Beloit has lost 12 of their last 15 games.

STRIKEOUT SURPLUS: Snappers pitching reached double digits in strikeouts for the 32nd time this season after 11 on Thursday. The Snappers now sit 4th in the Midwest League in strikeouts & are on pace to surpass the franchise record of 1186 strikeouts in a single season. Beloit only struck out 856 batters a year ago, the fewest in club history.

CLOSE GAMES: Beloit played in a league-high 26 one-run games in the First Half & won 15 of those games, also the most in the league under those circumstances. The Snappers were just 1-9 in games separated by 2 runs & 4-4 in games decided by 3 runs. Beloit has played a total of 44 games decided by 3 runs or fewer in 2017.

TAKE 5: The Snappers are 23-5 when they reach 5 runs offensively. Both the Snappers & their opponent have reached that total in 13 games with Beloit holding an 8-5 mark when that happens. Beloit has only scored 5 runs 2 times over their last 11 games & has lost both contests. On a side note, Beloit has a 12-1 record when they hit more than one homer.

MERCEDES M-CLASS: Snappers slugger **Miguel Mercedes** has now hit in a career-best 10 consecutive games. He leads the team with a .333 batting average in June. Despite the good average, Mercedes has not homered over his last 58 at-bats going back to June 2 at Wisconsin.

BIG NIGHTS BY MARINEZ: For the third time this year, **Eric Marinez** put together a 3-hit night & his 2nd 3-for-3 performance. All 3 of his games with 3 hits have come in the month of June & his .315 average this month trails only Mercedes on the team.

GOOD SIGNS FROM MONDOU: A 2-hit night by **Nate Mondou** on Thursday was the 19th multi-hit game of the year for the All-Star infielder. Mondou had gone 15 straight games with 1 or 0 hits during an extended 5-for-48 slump before the Midwest League All-Star Break. Mondou saw his batting average slip 50-points over the last 15 games of the First Half.

FACING THE LUMBERKINGS: The Snappers have lost their last 13 games in Clinton, Iowa with their last victory coming on June 10, 2016. Beloit won a total of 2 games in Clinton last season while losing their first 7 at the home of the LumberKings this year. Clinton currently carry 6 of the Mariners Top-30 prospects with pitchers **Brandon Miller** (#17) & **Nick Wells** (#25) in addition to hitters **Joe Rizzo** (#7), **Bryson Brigman** (#14), & **Luis Rengifo** (#30).
