WESTERN SWING CONTINUES IN AKRON: The Portland Sea Dogs are 4-5 during a 12-game western swing, and continues their six-game trip on Friday night against the Akron RubberDucks (Indians affiliate) at Canal Park...The 'Dogs have lost eight straight in Akron since 2015, and last won a series from the Ducks in 2012...Lefty **Daniel McGrath** makes his seventh start of the season...Lefty **Sean Brady** beat Portland on June 10th at Hadlock Field.

HOME RUN DERBY IN ERIE: **Michael Chavis** and **Bobby Dalbec** each homered twice, as the Sea Dogs held on for a 10-9 win in the series finale at Erie...Portland ledd 10-2 but Erie rallied for seven two-out runs during innings 7-8...In the ninth, **Jordan Weems** walked two with two outs but retired **Kody Eaves** to end the game...**Jordan Betts** added a solo-homer to start a five-run sixth inning against reliever **Joe Navilhon**.

STARTERS IN A GROOVE: Since July 17th, Portland's starters have allowed 32 earned runs over their last 132.2 innings pitched (2.17 ERA)...**Dedgar Jimenez** earned the win last night, working six innings on three hit, two runs and seven strikeouts.

HE LOVED ERIE: Chavis went 9-for-14 in the Erie series and enters tonight's game with a season best .286 average...Last night was Chavis' first multi-homer game in Double, he hit a career-high three homers with Salem on April 19, 2017.

MORE ON BOBBY: Dalbec has two multi-homer games for his four home runs with Portland...Overall, Dalbec is hitting .262 (96-for-366) with 30 HR, 91 RBI, 27 2B, 2 2B and 63 BB between High-A Salem and Portland...Last night, he joined Lexington's **Seuly Matias** (31 HR) as the only two minor leaguers with 30 homers.

THE ENTIRE LINEUP PRODUCED: Portland received a hit from all nine starters, including a three-hit game from **Tate Matheny**...Matheny's RBI triple in the sixth inning proved to be the game-winning RBI.

AGAINST THE OPPONENT: Portland is 5-12-7 All-Time in season series against Akron, going 41-52 in 19 season series in Ohio...The Sea Dogs dropped two of three to the RubberDucks at Hadlock Field on June 8-10.

WHEN WAS THE LAST: Portland's five homers last night was a season-high, and their most since hitting five last July 20th vs. Hartford at Hadlock Field...On August 2nd (also a Thursday), the 'Dogs hit four homers against Erie in Maine.

TWO MORE HITS: Johnny Bladel went 2-for-5 with an RBI single from the lead-off spot on Thursday night...Bladel has two multi-hit games this month and hitting .316 (6-for-19), RBI in August.

ACTION FROM AUSTIN: Austin Rei is hitting .314 (22-for-70) with 2 HR, 9 RBI, 3B and 4 2B in 21 games since July 1st...Rei went 1-for-4 with a run scored last night - he hit Portland's first triple of the season on April 17th vs. Hartford.

WELCOME BACK: Jake Cosart fanned three over 1.2 scoreless in the roadtrip opener in his return to Portland on Thursday night...Cosart has a multi-strikeout game in eight of 12 appearances with the Sea Dogs.

Promoted to Portland on 7/23 and threw 5.0+ innings in each of his 8 starts with the club...Named the Red Sox' Minor League Starting Pitcher of the Month for August/September after going 3-0 with a 2.72 ERA (11 ER/36.1 IP) for the Sea Dogs in 6 August starts...Following the season, appeared in 10 games (3 GS) for Magallanes in the Venezuelan Winter League (19.1 IP).
