### Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Michael Peoples** to the mound tonight, trying to stave off a five game losing streak. Louisville will counter with RHP **Rookie Davis**. The Clippers are 14-16 (.467) against right handers this year. Davis has pitched against the Clippers twice in his career, going 0-1 with a 13.00ERA (9.0IP, 19H, 13R, 13ER, 3BB, 5K).

### vs. the Bats

Columbus went 11-12 against Louisville last year, despite outscoring them 123-111. This season the Clippers have dropped six of 11, while the Bats hold a 54-50 run advantage. Individually, **Giovanny Urshela** has hit .301 with 7HR and 28RBI against Louisville in 42G (163AB) and **Yandy Diaz** has hit .395 with 4HR and 24RBI in 21G (86AB).

### Waiting for a Walk-Off

Through 40 games, Columbus is the only team in the IL that has yet to experience a walk-off, either as a victor or on the losing side. However, the Clippers are tied for 5th in the IL with four last at bat wins, thanks to four extra inning road wins this season. On the year, the deciding run has been scored before the 5th inning in 26 of 40 games (before the 3rd inning 16 times).

### The Clippers We Know

After starting the season by losing 18 of the first 19 games in which they trailed (last team in IL to secure a comeback victory), each of the last six wins for Columbus have been in comeback fashion (have not led post to post since 5/2 at Louisville). From 2014-16, the Clippers averaged more than 34 comeback victories a season (most in the IL, Norfolk averaged 32).

### RISP Aversion

Yesterday, the Clippers went 0x5 with runners in scoring position (eighth time going hitless; only 15AB in such situations over the last four games). On the season, they have had more than two hits only 10 times in 40 games, going 10-0 in those games, while averaging 6.7 runs (7-23, 2.8 runs per game when collecting two hits or fewer; had two or fewer over 12 straight from 4/18-4/30).

### Jackson Rehab

The Clippers received **Austin Jackson** on rehab today (out since 5/2 with a hyperextended left big toe). Jackson had hit .273/.368/.485 with 1HR and 2RBI in 12 games (33AB) with Cleveland prior to the injury. He last played in the IL in 2013 with Toledo (rehab stint from 6/10-6/13), with his only regular action coming in 2009 as a member of the SWB Yankees (hit .300 in 132 games).

### Still Rolling

**Yandy Diaz** was only 1x3 yesterday, but his average still checks in at .357 (20x56; hit in 14 of 16 games on the year). Dating to the start of the 2016 season, no IL batter with at least 350PA has come close to his batting average of .329 (Louisville's **Hernan Iribarren** is 2nd at .319). His .409OBP in that time also outpaces those hitters by a wide margin (Louisville's **Jesse Winker** is 2nd at .392).

### Here We Go Again

After starting the season with 13BB in his first 107PA (12%), **Giovanny Urshela** has gone 42PA without a walk (241PA without a walk from 6/11-8/15/16). Even though he has hit .286 (12x42) over the 11 games since that walk, his OBP has dropped 22 points to .349 (still a career high). Despite the current dropoff in walks, he is still on pace for 46, a number that would shatter his career best (36 in 2014).

### Trending Opposite

Since 5/7, **Richie Shaffer** has picked up 12RBI in 11 games, as he is batting .308 (12x39) with 3HR. He has walked just six times in that stretch (17BB in previous 24 games). In that same time period, **Chris Colabello** has had just 1RBI, batting .182 (8x44) in 12 games. However, he has 11BB (5BB in previous 24 games), ultimately raising his OBP 10 points (average has dropped 27 points).

### Making More Contact

The Clippers whiffed only 30 times in the five game series with Indianapolis and didn't have at least 10K in any single game (last time with at least five straight games of fewer than 10K, six from 4/26-5/1). However, they still lead the league with 382K (17 more than 2nd place, Gwinnett) and are on pace for a franchise worst 1,356 (1,200 in 2013). **Nellie Rodriguez** has struck out in 24 straight games.

### This Date in Clipper History

5/19/1984

Columbus pounded out 25 hits, then a franchise record, while scoring 20 runs in a win vs. Pawtucket. **Mike Patterson** led the way with 5RBI while **Mike Pagliarulo** and **Rex Hudler** each knocked in four. Every starter collected at least one hit and one run in the 20-5 victory, Columbus' 10th win their last 11 games. The current record for runs (26) and hits (30) were both set on 5/3/97 at Norfolk.

### Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first eight years since the move downtown, Huntington Park has ranked among the top two in the International League in homers per game, totaling 2.11 per contest (1,212HR, 574 games). Last year, HP averaged just under a pair per game, but still managed to overtake Charlotte to claim the top spot for the first time since BB&T Ballpark was opened. In addition, the Clippers held opponents to 69HR in 2016 (2nd straight year under 70HR), however, the opposition has still hit more longballs over the life of the park (634 to 620).

### Pitchers Adjusting

Last season saw Huntington Park average 8.92 runs per game, a figure that challenged the record low (8.29 runs per game, 2015). Last year also marked the fourth straight season under 10 runs per game (led IL in each of four seasons from 2009-12, averaging over 10 a game each year). The pitching staff boasted a 4.08ERA at home (record is 3.49, set in 2015), a number that was fairly larger than on the road (3.21). Since the Clippers began play in downtown Columbus, the home ERA has never been better than the road ERA, with 2014's margin of 0.20 being the closest.

### Bombs Away

The Clippers ranked 3rd in the International League in homer differential last year, coming in at +24 (Rochester led at +42). The 129HR hit by Columbus tied Rochester for most in the IL, while the 105 allowed are 9th fewest. The homers translated into wins, as the Clippers posted a .636 winning percentage when going yard (56-32) and a .464 mark when kept in the park (26-30). This season, they are 11-16 (.407) when homering and 6-7 (.462) when they don't.

### Ain't Over 'Til It's Over

Since the start of the 2014 season, no team has had more come from behind victories than the 110 posted by Columbus (32 last season) and no team has produced a better winning percentage when trailing than the .343 of the Clippers (no other IL team has won more than a third of games in which they have trailed over that time period; Scranton/WB ranks 2nd at .326). Columbus finished with the 2nd highest winning percentage in such games in 2014 (.356), led the circuit in 2015 (.365) and ranked 3rd last year (.340, 32-62). They lost their first 11 such games this year, before finally securing a comeback win on 4/26 vs. Lehigh Valley.

### A New ERA

Over the last six seasons, the Clippers have turned in a sub-4.00ERA five times, as last year's squad had a 3.65ERA (zero seasons with an ERA under 4.00 from 1993-2010). The 2015 team ERA of 3.33 was the best since 1990 and the first ERA under 3.50 since 1992 (2016's ERA was 2nd best in the last 25 seasons). Furthermore, last year's staff reached 1,000K for the seventh time in the last eight years (only one 1,000K season through the first 32 years of the franchise, zero through the first 24).

### IL Shutout Survivor

The Clippers were the second to last team to get shutout this season (Durham is still going), when they were blanked at Buffalo on 4/22 (16th game of 2017, 53 games since previous shutout, on 4/28/16 at Norfolk). When it comes to posting shutouts, only Lehigh Valley (7) and Pawtucket (5) have done it more often than Columbus this year (4) and only two teams have yet to record one (Charlotte and Louisville).

### Golden Age for Defense

In the first five years of the affiliation with Cleveland (2009-13), the Clippers never finished in the top half of the IL in defense. Starting in 2014, the Clippers have been one of the better teams in the league, finishing 6th that year, 1st in 2015 (set franchise records for fielding, .98421, and fewest errors, 84) and 3rd last season (.98396, 86E; both numbers are 2nd best in franchise history). They are 2nd in the league in 2017, currently posting a .985 fielding percentage to go with 21E (on pace for 75E on the season).

### Closer By Committee

In 2016, the Clippers had seven pitchers record at least two saves (3rd most in the IL, Scranton/WB had nine), while 12 different guys had at least one. Only five times did the same pitcher record consecutive saves (**Austin Adams** three times, **Shawn Armstrong** once and **Ben Heller** once) and at no point did the same pitcher pick up the save at least three times in a row for Columbus. This year, **Shawn Armstrong**, **Joseph Colon**, **Jeff Johnson** and **Josh Martin** have saves, with only Armstrong doing it consecutively.

### International Accolades

**Mike Clevinger** was named Pitcher of the Week for 4/10-4/16, picking up a pair of wins while not allowing a run (13.0IP, 7H, 3BB, 17K). He was the first weekly award winner for the Clippers in the 2017 season, following a 2016 season that saw three Clippers (**Yandy Diaz**, **Adam Plutko** and **Giovanny Urshela**, twice) honored a total of four times. The Clippers did not place any players on the postseason All-Star team last year, but Diaz was selected as the IL Rookie of the Year (sixth in franchise history), becoming the first Clipper to be so honored since **Kurt Bierek** in 1999. As for the 2016 midseason All-Stars, all three (**Shawn Armstrong**, **Clevinger** and **Erik Gonzalez**) have returned to Columbus this year.

### Manager Profile

**Chris Tremie** returns to the Columbus dugout in 2017, his fifth campaign as skipper of the Clippers (first to start five consecutive seasons as manager). Last season resulted in the fourth playoff appearance of his career and his fifth winning season in the past six. This season marks Tremie's 12th year as a manager (all within the Cleveland organization), as he holds a career record of 725-694 (.511). With Columbus, Tremie sits 3rd on the all-time wins list, posting a record of 332-284 (.539).
