**Giants Continue Series Against Stockton Tonight...** The San Jose Giants play the second game of their four-game series against the Stockton Ports this evening at Municipal Stadium. San Jose suffered a 4-1 defeat to the Ports yesterday in their home opener. The loss was only the Giants' second in their last six games overall.

**At Muni...** Yesterday's setback marked the first time since 2011 that San Jose lost their home opener (4/14/11, 3-2 loss to Visalia). San Jose won six straight home openers from 2012 to 2017.

**Pitching Shines Early...** The Giants enter tonight's contest second in the California League with a 2.48 ERA through the first eight games of the season. San Jose has two shutouts already this year. The Giants starting rotation boasts a combined 1.99 ERA (7 ER/31.2 IP).

**Cycle x2...** Wednesday was an historic night for the San Jose Giants as both Gio Brusa and Jalen Miller hit for the cycle in an 18-6 victory at Lancaster. Brusa (4-for-6, 2B, 3B, HR, 6 RBI) completed his cycle with a triple in the top of the eighth. Miller (5-for-7, 2B, 3B, HR, 4 RBI, SB), who tied a Giants single-game team record with five hits, tripled in the ninth inning for San Jose's second cycle of the night. The duo became the fourth and fifth players in the 31-year history of the San Jose Giants to hit for the cycle. Prior to Wednesday, the last SJ Giant to hit for the cycle was Thomas Neal on April 28, 2009 at Lancaster.

**w/RISP...** The Giants were 12-for-26 with runners in scoring position during Wednesday's blowout win over Lancaster, but have gone just 11-for-68 (.162 AVG) w/RISP in their other seven games this year.

**North Division Rivals...** Last night was the Giants' first of 28 meetings this season against Stockton. San Jose will also play 30 games versus Modesto and 29 games against Visalia this year.

**Samardzija Rehab Start Tomorrow...** San Francisco Giants pitcher Jeff Samardzija is scheduled to make a rehab start for the San Jose Giants in tomorrow night's game at Municipal Stadium. Samardzija is returning from a pectoral strain suffered during spring training last month. The right-hander was 9-15 with a 4.42 ERA in 32 starts for the San Francisco Giants last season. He struck out 205 batters over 207 2/3 innings. Samardzija has pitched 11 seasons in the major leagues with the Cubs (2008-14), A's (2014), White Sox (2015) and Giants (2016-18) and owns a career 68-87 record and 4.10 ERA over 318 games (195 starts).

**Top Prospects...** *MLB.com* currently ranks three players on San Jose's roster among the top 30 prospects in the SF Giants organization: #6 Sandro Fabian (OF), #12 Heath Quinn (OF) and #19 Melvin Adon (RHP).

**San Francisco Affiliation...** This year marks San Jose's 31st season as an affiliate of the San Francisco Giants. Since their inception in 1988, the San Jose Giants have won six league championships (1998, 2001, 2005, 2007, 2009, 2010), 11 North Division titles and qualified for the playoffs 22 times (in 30 seasons). San Jose has reached the playoffs in 12 out of the last 14 seasons.

**Homegrown Giants...** There are 13 former San Jose Giants on San Francisco's current 25-man roster: Tyler Beede, Brandon Belt, Ty Blach, Brandon Crawford, Derek Law, Reyes Moronta, Josh Osich, Joe Panik, Buster Posey, Pablo Sandoval, Chris Stratton, Hunter Strickland and Kelby Tomlinson.

\* Pitched for Augusta (A) and Salem-Keizer (Short-Season) in 2016 ... Combined for a 1-6 record and a 4.70 ERA in 17 starts between the two teams (67 IP, 60 H, 65 BB, 68 SO) ... Pitched past the fifth inning only once in his 17 starts.

\* Began the 2016 season in the Augusta starting rotation ... Was 0-0 with a 4.60 ERA in four starts for the GreenJackets ... Joined Salem-Keizer at the beginning of their season in mid-June ... Was 1-6 with a 4.73 ERA in 13 starts for the Volcanoes.

\* Pitched for the AZL Giants and Salem-Keizer during his debut professional season in 2015.

\* Attended Chipola Junior College (Marianna, FL).

\* Posted a 5-2 record and a 2.37 ERA over nine starts during his only season at Chipola in 2015 ... Struck out 44 and walked 13 in 30 innings.

\* Originally a 21st round draft pick of the Houston Astros in 2014 out of high school, but did not sign ... Was rated the #66 player in the 2014 draft by *MLB.com* ... Was slated to attend LSU, but opted to remain eligible for the 2015 draft instead by enrolling at Chipola.

\* Attended Parkview High School ... Had a 0.58 ERA with 86 strikeouts in 60 2/3 innings as a senior in 2014 ... Helped Parkview to the 2012 high school national championship as a sophomore.

\* Pitched for the 18-and-under U.S. National Baseball Team in 2013 ... Won a gold medal in Taiwan.

### #21 Jeff Arnold (.250, 0 HR, 2 RBI, 0 SB)

Current Hit Streak: 1 game

- \* Catcher is in his ninth professional season ... Selected in the 16th round of the 2010 draft.
- \* Spent the majority of the 2017 season with Richmond (AA) ... Batted .184 with six home runs and 22 RBI's in 61 games.
- \* Also played nine games for Sacramento (AAA) last year (.176 AVG, 1 HR, 2 RBI).
- \* Prior experience in San Jose includes 12 games in 2012, 97 games in 2013 and 21 games in 2015.
- \* Was a California League All-Star in 2013 ... Hit .251 with career-high totals of 26 doubles, 13 home runs and 61 RBI.
- \* Attended the University of Louisville ... Was a Johnny Bench Award semifinalist as a senior in 2010.

### #26 Gio Brusa (.296, 2 HR, 7 RBI, 0 SB)

Current Hit Streak: 0

- \* First baseman is in his third professional season ... Selected in the 6th round of the 2016 draft.
- \* Spent the 2017 season with San Jose ... Hit .237 with 17 home runs and 55 RBI's in 113 games.
- \* Tied for the team lead in home runs last year ... Was also second on the club in doubles and fifth in RBI's.
- \* Was an outfielder in his first two seasons before transitioning to first base this year.
- \* Earned Northwest League All-Star honors with Salem-Keizer (Short-Season) in 2016.
- \* Led the Northwest League with 10 home runs in '16 ... Hit .264 with 42 RBI's in 53 games ... Won All-Star home run derby.
- \* Attended the University of the Pacific ... Finished career second in school history in doubles, fourth in HR and fifth in RBI's.

### #43 Frandy De La Rosa (.259, 2 HR, 3 RBI, 0 SB)

- \* Infielder is in his sixth professional season and second year in the San Francisco organization.
- \* Previously played in the Cubs (2013-15) and Rangers (2016-17) organizations ... Has been traded twice.
- \* Was traded from the Rangers to the Giants in exchange for minor league pitcher Clayton Blackburn on 4/16/17.
- \* Spent the majority of the 2017 season with Augusta (A) ... Hit .231 with five home runs and 19 RBI's in 56 games.
- \* Has seen action at all four infield positions throughout his career ... Originally signed by the Cubs in 2012.

### #54 Sandro Fabian (.286, 1 HR, 3 RBI, 0 SB)

Current Hit Streak: 2 games

- \* Outfielder is in his fourth professional season ... Signed as an international free agent in 2014.
- \* Currently ranked the #6 prospect in the San Francisco organization by *MLB.com*. Rated the #9 prospect by *Baseball America*.
- \* Is the youngest player on San Jose's roster (20).
- \* Spent the 2017 season with Augusta (A) ... Batted .277 with 11 home runs and 61 RBI's in 122 games.
- \* Led the GreenJackets in hits (133), doubles (30) and RBI's ... Was also second on the club in home runs.
- \* Ranked third in the South Atlantic League with 15 outfield assists last year.
- \* Hit .340 for the AZL Giants (Rookie) in 2016 (42 games).

### #49 Johneshwy Fargas (.125, 0 HR, 0 RBI, 0 SB)

Current Hit Streak: 1 game

- \* Outfielder is in his sixth professional season ... Selected in the 11th round of the 2013 draft.
- \* Played for both San Jose and Augusta (A) in 2017 ... Hit .194 with two home runs and 11 RBI's in 31 games with S.J.
- \* Finished last season with Augusta ... Batted .205 with one home run, 10 RBI's and 10 stolen bases in 37 games.
- \* Has led the SF Giants minor league system in stolen bases twice (59 SB in 2015, 41 SB in 2016).
- \* Also played 36 games for San Jose during the 2016 season ... Hit .172 with no home runs and nine RBI's.
- \* Was a South Atlantic League All-Star in 2015 while playing for Augusta (.278 AVG, 2 HR, 35 RBI, 59 SB).
- \* Was drafted by the SF Giants out of the Puerto Rico Academy.

### #12 Wander Franco (.161, 0 HR, 2 RBI, 1 SB)

Current Hit Streak: 0

- \* Infielder is in his seventh professional season and first year in the San Francisco organization.
- \* Spent the first six years of his pro career (2012-17) in the Kansas City Royals farm system.
- \* Was acquired by the SF Giants in the minor league phase of the Rule 5 draft last December.
- \* Spent the last two seasons playing for the Wilmington Blue Rocks (High-A) of the Carolina League.
- \* Batted .279 with four home runs and 46 RBI's in 129 games last year (.220 AVG, 5 HR, 47 RBI in 2016).
- \* Originally signed with the Royals in 2011 out of the Dominican Republic.
