TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves begin the final homestand of the 2019 regular season on Thursday night at Trustmark Park with game one of a five-game series against the Chattanooga Lookouts (CIN). The M-Braves are coming off a 2-3 road trip to Biloxi.

M All-time the M-Braves are 82-87 vs. Chattanooga and 40-41 in games played at Trustmark Park. Tonight is the 6th of 10 meetings between the cross-division foes. The M-Braves went 4-1 against the Lookouts, April 15-19, at AT&T Field.

LAST TIME OUT: The M-Braves closed out their series at Biloxi on Tuesday night in a doubleheader split at MGM Park. The Braves dropped the first contest, 3-1, but bounced back with a 9-5 win in the nightcap. The M-Braves totaled four home runs over the twin bill. 3B **Riley Unroe** led the offense by going 3-for-7 with a double and homer in each game, driving in four runs. **Connor Lien** homered in the second game, as did **Ryan Casteel**, adding a three-run homer and finishing 2-for-4.

POSTSEASON AWARDS: The M-Braves placed a club record three players on the Southern League Postseason All-Star team with **Drew Waters** and **Cristian Pache** being named to the outfield and **LHP Tucker Davidson** being the top left-handed pitcher. Waters was named the league's Most Valuable Player after leading in several offensive categories including batting average (.319), hits (134), extra-base hits (49), total bases (202), and OPS (.847). Waters is the first M-Brave to claim the award and first for the franchise since **Ryan Klesko** and **Javy Lopez** won league MVP in 1991-92 for the Greenville Braves. Waters was the youngest, at 20, to win MVP since Montgomery's **Delmon Young** claimed the honor in 2006. All three players were promoted to Triple-A Gwinnett on Aug. 5.

CASTEEL JOINS 20 HOME RUN CLUB: 28-year-old 1B **Ryan Casteel** leads the club and ranks T-2nd in the league with 21 home runs and has three multi-homer games this season. His three-homer game on July 3 was the first in M-Braves history. Casteel has already moved into 7th place on the M-Braves all-time home run list and with his home run on Aug. 24 at Biloxi, became just the second M-Brave to record 20 homers in a season, joining **Ernesto Mejia** (26) who did it in 2011. Casteel is also the only Southern League player with 20 home runs and 20 doubles.

M Casteel ranks among the league leaders in HR (21, T-2nd), RBI (71, 2nd), slugging (.489, 3rd), OPS (.831, 5th), XBH (43, T-5th) and TB (192, T-4th).

THE GOOD AND BAD OF IT: Despite a total overhaul of the pitching staff and 9-17 record this month, M-Braves hurlers rank 3rd in the Southern League in August with a 3.19 ERA. The M-Braves at the plate are last in the league this month with a .208 batting average and averaging just 2.5 runs per game. Overall this season, M-Braves pitchers are tied for the league lead with a 3.23 ERA.

BULLPEN BEASTS: The M-Braves bullpen has covered 101.2 innings over 26 games in August and posted a 2.74 ERA (31 ER), with 88 strikeouts compared to 44 walks. M-Braves starters have logged 118.1 innings this month and posted a 3.23 ERA, including seven quality starts.

1,000 MISSISSIPPI BRAVES WINNERS: Last Friday's 3-2 win over Biloxi was the 1,000th all-time win for the Mississippi Braves since 2005. All-time, the M-Braves are 1,000-1,060.

ROSTER TURNOVER: Only 12 of the 24 players currently on the active roster were active on Aug. 4. OF **Cristian Pache**, OF **Drew Waters**, RHP **Ian Anderson**, LHP **Tucker Davidson**, RHP **Ben Rowen**, LHP **Tyler Matzek**, LHP **Phil Pfeifer** and C **Jonathan Morales** have been promoted to Triple-A Gwinnett. LHP **Kyle Muller**, INF **C.J. Alexander** and INF **Daniel Lockhart** have been placed on the Injured List and INF **Luis Valenzuela** was released and RHP **Brandon White** was transferred to High-A Florida. Also, LHP **Joey Wentz** was traded to Detroit on July 31.

THE SHUTOUT KING: Today's starter RHP **Nolan Kingham** leads Minor League Baseball with three complete game shutouts this season and is T-5th in Minor League Baseball in innings pitched, logging 156.1 between Low-A Rome, High-A Florida and Mississippi.

THE FIRST 2019 DRAFT PICK IN DOUBLE-A: On Aug. 16, SS **Braden Shewmake** was promoted to Mississippi from Low-A Rome. Atlanta's second first-round pick (21st overall) in this past June's MLB draft. Shewmake is the first 2019 draft pick to reach Double-A for any club. In 51 games, the Texas A&M product was batting .318 (64-for-201) with 18 doubles, two triples, three home runs, 39 RBI, 11 stolen bases and .389 OBP over 51 games. Atlanta's first selection was Baylor catcher **Shea Langeliers** at ninth overall. He is currently playing for Low-A Rome.

ANOTHER 25 SB SEASON FOR DIDDER: Aruba native INF/OF **Ray-Patrick Diddler** has stolen 26 bases for a fourth-straight season and is 19-for-21 in SB opportunities in 55 games during the second-half of the season with a .371 OBP, seven doubles, home run, eight RBI and 25 walks. He now ranks 5th in the league with 26 stolen bases and 2nd in HBP (15). He has been HBP 114 times in his career and 102 times since the 2015 season.

THREE MILLION FANS: The M-Braves celebrated the 3 millionth fan for Braves baseball at Trustmark Park on Aug. 14. Clinton, MS native **Matt Baker** (and son **Wyatt** attending his first game) was the 3 millionth fan and was given a prize pack that included 2020 M-Braves Season Tickets and 2020 Atlanta Braves tickets.

HISTORY MADE ON JUNE 28: **Ian Anderson** and **Jeremy Walker**'s combined nine-inning no-hitter on Friday, June 28 vs. Jackson was the third no-hitter in team history. The last was a combined no-hitter from **Julio Teheran** and **Tyrelle Harris** on Aug. 2, 2010 vs. Mobile. The first, and only individual no-hitter came from the late **Tommy Hanson** on June 25, 2008, vs. Birmingham. Anderson's 14 strikeouts over 7.0 innings in the game matched Hanson's single-game team record set in the same game.

MADE IN MISSISSIPPI: OF **Travis Demeritte** made his MLB debut for the Detroit Tigers on August 2 at Texas becoming with 146th M-Braves alum to move to make their Major League debut. LHP **Jeremy Walker** 7/26/19, RHP **Huascar Ynoa** (6/16/19), OF **Austin Riley** (5/15/19), C **Alex Jackson** (4/7/19) and RHP **Jacob Webb** (4/16/19) have all made MLB debuts this season.

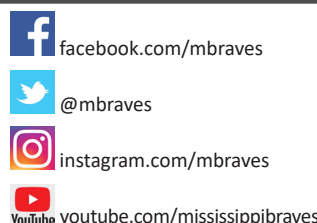

• Connor Johnstone makes his 28th appearance and seventh start for the M-Braves this season. This is Johnstone's fifth-straight start after joining the rotation on Aug. 7. He made two previous spot starts on April 18 at Chattanooga and June 27 vs. Jackson.

• **vs. Chattanooga:** Johnstone made his first M-Braves appearance this season on April 18 at Chattanooga, taking a no-decision in a 5-3 loss to the Lookouts at AT&T Field. He allowed one run on four hits over 4.1 innings with one walk and two strikeouts.

• The right-hander logged his first quality start and came away with a no-decision on Friday night in the 3-2 win over Biloxi at MGM Park. Over 6.0 innings, he allowed two runs on six hits with one walk and five strikeouts .
