- * The Spikes got 2-out RBI singles in both the bottom of 10th to tie game 4-4 and 11th inning for the 5-4 walkoff victory vs Vermont
- * **Greg Deichmann** was 2-for-4 with 2 runs, a sac fly in 3rd inning, 2-out solo homer in 7th to tie game 3-3 before leadoff single in 10th and scored on 2-out **Payton Squier** RBI single for a 4-3 lead
- * Starter **Jesus Luzardo** retired 6 of first 7 batters he faced over first 2 innings before allowing 3 runs (2 ER) on 4 hits in 3rd in VT debut
- * **Brian Howard** retired 8 of 10 batters faced in 3 scoreless innings
- * **Kevin Merrell** was 2-for-5 with 1 run, while **Logan Farrar** 2-for-5

2017 DRAFTEES:

- The Lake Monsters now have 19 players that were selected in 2017 draft last month
- * **Overall the 9 2017 draft pitchers combined 2.21 ERA (142.1 IP, 104 H, 39 R, 35 ER, 55 BB, 164 SO)**
- * Offensively, 10 draft position players hitting combined .253 (223x883), 38 doubles, 12 homers, 110 RBI

POWER OUTAGE:

- Greg Deichmann's** solo homer on Friday at State College was just the **Lake Monsters 4th home run in the last 19 games** after hitting 9 homers in the previous 10 games.
- * Vermont pitchers have allowed a league-high 32 home runs **including 19 in the last 25 games**

EXTRAS: Vermont is 2-6 in extra-inning games, including 0-4 in road games (all 4 losses last 12 Lake Monster away games)

- * Last 3 Vermont road games have been walkoff losses and in last 2 road games, Vermont was strike away from win before game tied

- * 9 of Vermont's last 16 losses overall have been by just 1 run
