### SNAPPER SNIPPETS

**FLAIR FOR THE DRAMATIC:** The Chiefs walk-off homer last night was the 6th time the Snappers have been walked-off this season & the 2nd time at Dozer Park. On the flip side, the Snappers have won 6 games at Pohlman Field in walk-off fashion & won 13 ballgames in their final at-bat of the night. The comebacks have also been a theme during the Second Half. The Snappers trailed 2-0 & won on Saturday, fell behind 4-0 on Sunday to win, & were down 6-0 before taking an 8-6 lead on Tuesday.

**CLOSE GAMES:** A 2-run defeat on Tuesday dropped Beloit down to 2-10 in games decided by exactly 2 runs. The Snappers have already played the most one-run games in the Midwest League (27) & are a combined 23-25 in games decided by 3 runs or less.

**HELPFUL TO GET A HANDFUL:** When the Snappers offense reached the 5-run plateau in the scoring column, they are 26-6 this season after Tuesday's 10-8 loss. Yesterday's game in Peoria was the 15th time this year that both the Snappers & their opponent have scored 5 runs in a game & Beloit is 9-6 under those conditions.

**MORE HITS FOR MARINEZ:** Eric Marinez continues to deliver the hits this month as he rides his season-best 9-game hitting streak. The infielder leads the Snappers with a .33 batting average in June & previously had 5 straight multi-hit game between June 18-25.

**PERSICO'S PLAY:** All-Star outfielder Luke Persico returned to the Snappers lineup on Sunday after missing 6 games & the All-Star Game to a minor injury. He drove home a pair on Tuesday to give him 5 RBI in his last 2 games & the first Snapper to reach 40 RBIs. Persico also recorded 2 outfield assists in Tuesday's game, the 4th outfielder to record a pair in the same game this year (Mike Martin-May 4, Cole Gruber-May 3, JaVon Shelby-May 2, all vs. Dayton). Persico's 8 assists from the outfield are the 3rd-best total in the Midwest League as 3 players lead with 10.

**SHELBY TURNING THE CORNER:** Outfielder JaVon Shelby had been struggling at the end of the First Half with multiple strikeouts in 14 of his last 17 games of the first portion of the season. Starting the Second Half, he has delivered a hit in 5 of 6 games along with 3 doubles.

**TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER:** Matt Milburn will look to build off a career-best outing in his last start on Friday at Clinton. Milburn fanned a team-high 12 LumberKings, one of 3 total 10+ strikeout performances of the season by a Snappers pitcher. He has recorded at least 6 strikeouts in all 4 of his June outings to total 31 whiffs to just 5 walks this month while logging an ERA of 3.91.

**FACING THE CHIEFS:** Seven of 9 games between Beloit & Peoria have been decided in the final at-bat of the game. The Snappers will play their next 7 road games at Dozer Park with 4 games to begin the work week & 3 more next week over the 4th of July. Beloit's offense sputtered during their last visit to Peoria with just 4 runs over the first 3 games & lost a 7-6 contest in game 4. Peoria currently employs 4 of the Cardinals top-30 prospects. Those players include pitchers Jordan Hicks (#18) & Ronnie Williams (#24) along with outfielders Dylan Carlson (#16) & Nick Plummer (#22).
