Last Game: Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp right fielder Peter O'Brien hit a game-tying, three-run home run to begin the team's season-best seven-run fifth inning that lifted the visitors to an 8-4 win Wednesday and third straight victory over the Birmingham Barons in the fourth game of a five-game series at Regions Field. The Barons (26-32) built a 3-0 lead through four innings against Jacksonville right-hander Kolton Mahoney, who allowed eight hits and one walk with three strikeouts. In the first inning, center fielder Ryan Brett hit a leadoff triple, and catcher Zack Collins hit a sacrifice fly. In the third inning, Brett hit a leadoff single, went to third base on a single by left fielder Eloy Jimenez and scored on designated hitter Seby Zavala's sacrifice fly. Jimenez hit a fourth-inning RBI single, on the inning-ending play that Jacksonville left fielder Cade Gotta threw out Barons first baseman Keon Barnum at home plate. Barons left-hander Jordan Guerrero faced the minimum through the first four innings, but Jumbo Shrimp designated hitter John Norwood led off the fifth inning with a double down the third-base line. All-Star first baseman Eric Jagielo walked, and O'Brien hit the first pitch from Guerrero into the left field bullpen for his first Southern League hit since 2014 as a member of the Mobile BayBears, then the Arizona Diamondbacks Double-A affiliate. Third baseman Brian Schales singled to right field, All-Star catcher Rodrigo Vigil doubled to left field, and shortstop Mason Davis hit a go-ahead single to right field to chase Guerrero. Gotta greeted left-hander Brian Clark with an RBI single to center field, and second baseman Isan Diaz added a two-run single to left field for a 7-3 lead. Guerrero allowed six earned runs on six hits and one walk with two strikeouts without recording an out in the fifth inning. Clark allowed one run and lasted two innings. In the seventh inning against right-hander Jose Ruiz, Gotta doubled and scored on Norwood's RBI fielder's choice. Jacksonville left-hander Miguel Del Pozo (1-0) made his season debut in the fifth inning, allowing an unearned run. Right-handers Kyle Keller and Zech Lemond each pitched two scoreless innings to secure the series-clinching victory.

NEWS AND NOTES

I See You, Isan: Jacksonville second baseman Isan Diaz has loved this trip to Birmingham. Diaz has posted back-to-back three hit performances for the Jumbo Shrimp on Monday and Tuesday, and continued his hitting streak yesterday with a 1-for-3 performance with two runs batted in. Tuesday he sparked Jacksonville to a 2-1 win, scoring the two runs of the game after he hit doubles in the sixth and eighth innings. Diaz has risen his batting average to .222, and is hitting .324 (12-for-37) over his last ten games for the Jumbo Shrimp with a home run and six runs batted in. Diaz is regarded as Miami's No. 7 prospect according to MLB.com.

Six Shrimp All-Stars: The Southern League announced that six Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp players have been named to the league's South Division All-Star roster for the 2018 Southern League All-Star Game on Tuesday, June 19, at Regions Field in Birmingham, Alabama. Right-handed pitchers Nick Neidert and Pablo Lopez, left-handed pitcher Jose Quijada, catcher Rodrigo Vigil, designated hitter Eric Jagielo, and outfielder Monte Harrison will represent Jacksonville as South Division All-Stars.

Winning Streak: The Jumbo Shrimp carry a three-game winning streak into today's game, which is tied for the longest that the Shrimp have enjoyed this season. This is the first time that the Jumbo Shrimp have won three in a row on the road, and this trip to Birmingham is one of three series wins that the Shrimp have had on the road this season, compared to four series losses.

Goodbye Birmingham, See You Later Barons: Today's final game of the series marks Jacksonville's only trip to Regions Field in 2018. The Barons will make one appearance at the Baseball Grounds from August 19-23, so there will only be two series between the clubs this year as opposed to three last season. A year ago, the Shrimp lost their series in Birmingham, going 2-3 at Regions Field. The Jumbo Shrimp made up for it at the Baseball Grounds last August, going 9-1 against the Barons in Jacksonville, including a rare six-game sweep from August 21-25 that proved key to Jacksonville winning the Second Half South Division title.

Shrimp Have Prospects: On the roster, the Jumbo Shrimp have five players who were listed by *MLB.com* as Top 30 Miami Marlins prospects for the 2018 season: OF Monte Harrison (1), Isan Diaz (7), RHP Nick Neidert (8), RHP Pablo Lopez (21), and John Norwood (30).

LAST START: Dugger had a no decision in his start on Friday May 25 against the Mississippi Braves at Trustmark Park. Dugger pitched five and two-third innings, allowing five runs (all earned) on nine hits with three walks and four strikeouts. He left the game with Jacksonville trailing 5-4, only to see the Jumbo Shrimp fall 8-6 in 10 innings. Dugger did pitch last Saturday against the Blue Wahoos at the Baseball Grounds in Game One of a doubleheader that was ultimately cancelled due to rain, he was one out away from the game being official.

BAYBEARS START: Dugger had a no decision in his Double-A debut on Saturday May 19 against the Mobile BayBears at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Dugger turned in four and a third innings where he allowed three runs (one earned) on four hits with five walks and two strikeouts. He left the game with Jacksonville trailing 3-0, only to see the Shrimp rally to a 3-3 score before Mobile won the 12-inning game 6-5.

2018 WITH JUPITER: Dugger started the 2018 season in the High-A Jupiter Hammerheads starting rotation. With Jupiter, Dugger was 3-1 with a 2.40 ERA in seven starts, striking out 34 batters compared to seven walks in 41 and a third innings of work. In April, Dugger was 2-1 with a 3.14 ERA in his five starts. In May, Dugger was 1-0 with a 0.71 ERA in his two outings. At the time of his promotion to Jacksonville on May 18, Dugger was seventh in the league with a 2.40 ERA, and had the fifth-lowest walk per nine inning ratio at 1.52 among starting pitchers.

ACQUIRED BY THE MARLINS: Dugger was acquired by the Marlins from the Seattle Mariners along with right-handed pitcher and Jacksonville rotation mate Nick Neidert, infielder Chris Torres and future considerations in exchange for infielder/outfielder Dee Gordon on December 7, 2017. Dugger was originally selected by the Mariners in 18th round of the 2016 draft out of Texas Tech. While Dugger is not regarded as a Top 30 Marlins prospect according to MLB.com, he does appear in Baseball America's Top 30 Marlins prospect rankings entering 2018, checking in as Miami's No. 23 prospect.

2018 Highlights: In Dugger started the 2018 season in the High-A Jupiter Hammerheads starting rotation. With Jupiter, Dugger was 3-1 with a 2.40 ERA in seven starts, striking out 34 batters compared to seven walks in 41 and a third innings of work. In April, Dugger was 2-1 with a 3.14 ERA in his five starts. In May, Dugger was 1-0 with a 0.71 ERA in his two outings. At the time of his promotion to Jacksonville on May 18, Dugger was seventh in the league with a 2.40 ERA, and had the fifth-lowest walk per nine inning ratio at 1.52 among starting pitchers.

2017 Highlights: Split the season between Single-A Clinton in the Midwest League and High-A Modesto in the California League. With the Clinton Lumberkings, Dugger was 4-1 with a 2.00 ERA in 22 appearances and nine starts. As a starter, went 3-0 with a 1.18 ERA in nine starts after starting the season in the bullpen. With Clinton, he was honored as a 2017 Midwest League Midseason All-Star. Finished the season with the Modesto Nuts, going 2-5 with a 3.94 ERA in nine starts.

2016 Highlights: After he was selected by the Mariners in the 18th round of the 2016 draft out of Texas Tech, Dugger spent time at three different levels of the Mariners system. He started with the AZL Mariners where he made four appearances in relief, with no wins or losses and a 1.04 ERA. In late July he was sent to Triple-A Tacoma, where he worked two games in relief, with no wins or losses and a 6.75 ERA. He finished the season with the Everett AquaSox in the Short Season Class A Northwest League, where he was 2-1 with a 5.47 ERA in six starts.

College: Spent the 2016 season at Texas Tech, where he was 6-1 with a 2.67 ERA in 30 relief appearances with three saves. Struck out 54 batters in 60 and two-third innings of work. Dugger spent the 2015 and 2014 seasons at Cisco Junior College. In 2015, finished 3-2 overall with a 4.37 ERA ... struck out 55 hitters while issuing just 18 walks over 70.0 complete innings. In 2014 he was one of Cisco's top starting pitchers ... appeared in 12 games, finishing 5-5 overall with a 5.40 ERA ... led the team with 63.1 innings pitched ... tossed three complete games which ranked second on the team.

Personal: Helped lead Tomball High School to the Texas Class 4A state title as a senior ... played under head coach Doug Rush ... Tomball closed the 2013 season with an impressive 35-4 overall record ... marked the first state championship for any team sport in Tomball history ... team also finished the year ranked among the top 10 programs in the country ... was a first team All-District honoree as a senior ... first team All-State selection by the Texas Sports Writers Association ... also honored on the All-Houston area team and the All-State Tournament team ... recognized for work in the classroom as an academic All-State honoree ... member of the school's National Honors Society. Son of Ronnie and Anna Dugger ... has a younger brother, Cody ... mother is a teacher and University of Arizona graduate ... father works for Centerpoint Energy ... kinesiology major with a minor in nutrition ... hopes to one day become a physical therapist or nutritionist.
