Last Game: Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp left-hander Matt Tomshaw tied season highs with seven innings and seven strikeouts to tie for the Southern League lead with his career-high 13th win in a 6-3 victory over the Pensacola Blue Wahoos in front of 5,744 at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville on NAPA AutoCare Family Fireworks Friday. For the playoff-bound Jumbo Shrimp (39-28 second half, 69-68 overall), Tomshaw (13-6) retired the first four batters before Blue Wahoos right fielder Aristides Aquino hit a second-inning, one-out single, and center fielder Jonathan Reynoso grounded into a fielder's choice. Catcher Chad Tromp singled to put runners at first and second bases with two outs. On a wild pitch, both runners advanced, and catcher Cam Maron's errant throw to second base scored Reynoso. Tomshaw proceeded to retire 11 batters in a row and 16 of the final 18 he faced, allowing an unearned run on three hits and one walk. The Blue Wahoos (31-36, 71-66) kept the 1-0 lead until the third inning, when Jumbo Shrimp left fielder Austin Dean hit a one-out, game-tying solo home run – his fourth of the season – over the left-field ribbon board against right-hander Jose Lopez (7-2). With two outs, Lopez walked first baseman Dustin Geiger and catcher Cam Maron, and right fielder Taylor Ard grounded an RBI single that deflected off diving second baseman Shed Long into center field. Lopez allowed two earned runs on four hits and four walks with six strikeouts in four innings. Pensacola left-hander Brennan Bernardino worked a scoreless fifth inning, but second baseman Alex Yarbrough hit a leadoff single in the sixth inning. Tomshaw sacrificed Yarbrough to second base with two outs, and center fielder Kyle Barrett hit an RBI single to center field, extending the lead to 3-1. In the seventh inning, Blue Wahoos right-hander Carlos Gonzalez hit Dean with a pitch. Third baseman KC Serna singled to right field, and Geiger launched a three-run home run – his fifth of the season – just inside the Nimnicht Fair Pole to the Budweiser Tiki Terrace to make it 6-1. Pensacola tallied an eighth-inning run off left-hander Jeff Kinley on Long's RBI single. Right-hander Andy Beltre finished the inning, stranding the bases loaded. Right-hander Ryan Beckman finished pinch-hitter Josh VanMeter's sacrifice fly in the ninth inning before finishing the Jumbo Shrimp's fourth straight win.

NEWS AND NOTES

Playoff Bound JUMBO SHRIMP: The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp are going to the Southern League playoffs! Thursday night's 5-2 win over the Blue Wahoos clinched a second half South Division championship. The Jumbo Shrimp will face the Blue Wahoos in the South Division Championship Series, which will begin next Wednesday night at Pensacola. The winner of that series would face either Chattanooga or Montgomery in the BC Southern League Championship Series. This is the first playoff berth for the Jumbo Shrimp since 2014 when the club clinched a second half South Division title, en route to the 2014 Southern League championship. In the nine years of the Miami Marlins affiliation, the Jumbo Shrimp have now gone to the playoffs four times, with the first three trips ending in a championship for Jacksonville.

Bour Joins Shrimp on Rehab Assignment: Miami Marlins first baseman Justin Bour has joined the Jumbo Shrimp on a major league rehab assignment. Bour is recovering from a right oblique strain, and has been on Miami's disabled list since July 25. Bour has played in 87 games for the Marlins this season, hitting .289 with 21 home runs and 63 runs batted in. This is Bour's fourth season playing in the majors with the Marlins, and he is a career .272 major league hitter with 60 home runs and 198, and he made his debut with Miami in 2014 after playing at Triple-A New Orleans.

Lee Watch: 312: Braxton Lee continues to lead the Southern League in hitting with his .312 batting average. Lee is also the Southern League hit king with 145 this season, second in runs scored with 81, is third in the league with a .398 on-base percentage, and is fifth in the league with 20 stolen bases. Lee was honored as a Southern League Midseason All-Star for his work with the Montgomery Biscuits in the first half of the season, and he joined the Jumbo Shrimp on June 27 after being traded from the Tampa Bay Rays to the Marlins in exchange for Adeiny Hechavarria. Lee was named a 2017 Southern League Postseason All-Star on Tuesday, as well as a participant in the 2017 Arizona Fall League.

Norwood SL Player of the Week: Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp right fielder John Norwood has been named the Southern League Player of the Week for August 21-27, announced by the league office Monday morning. Norwood hit safely in seven of the eight games over the week for the Jumbo Shrimp, hitting .462 (12-for-26) with a home run, six runs batted in, 10 runs scored, with five walks and a .548 on-base percentage.

LAST START: Richards suffered the loss in his start on Monday August 28 against the Biloxi Shuckers at MGM Park. Richards turned in five innings where he allowed five runs (two earned) on six hits with a walk and four strikeouts as Jacksonville fell 7-1.

BARONS WIN: Richards earned a win in his start on Wednesday August 23 against Birmingham. Richards worked six and a third scoreless innings where he allowed just four hits, walked two batters, and struck out five as Jacksonville won 5-0.

BAYBEARS START: Richards had a loss in his start on Friday August 18 at Mobile. He worked just two-thirds of the first inning as he allowed five runs on five hits with two walks and two strikeouts as Jacksonville lost 10-4.

JUNE MARLINS MINOR LEAGUE PITCHER OF THE MONTH: Richards earned the Pitcher of the Month honors after a June that saw him make five starts going 4-0 with a 1.66 ERA with four starts with High-A Jupiter and one with Double-A Jacksonville. Richards pitched in 27 and a third innings in June, holding opp. to a .161 batting average while striking out 29 batters and walking only six.

2017 FLORIDA STATE LEAGUE ALL-STAR: Richards spent the first half of the season pitching for High-A Jupiter, where he was 7-4 with a 2.17 ERA in 13 appearances 11 starts. Signed by the Marlins as a minor league free agent on July 7, 2016.

2017 Highlights: Richards spent the first half of the season pitching for High-A Jupiter, where he was 7-4 with a 2.17 ERA in 13 appearances 11 starts. Richards was named a 2017 Florida State League Midseason All-Star, representing the South Division team on June 17 in Lakeland. Richards did not pitch in the game for the South Division, as the North Division won 5-2. At the time of his promotion on June 21, Richards ranks fourth in the Florida State League with a 2.17 ERA Richards also is tied for second in the league with his seven wins, tied for second in strikeouts with 81, leads the league in WHIP at 0.93, and has the third-lowest batting average against at .204. He also has the fourth-highest strikeout per nine inning ratio at 10.11, and the third-lowest walk per nine inning ratio at 1.51.

2016 Highlights: Richards started the 2016 season in the independent Frontier League, pitching for the Gateway Grizzlies, where he was 3-3 with a 3.21 ERA. After he was signed by the Marlins on July 7, Richards first was 0-0 with a 1.69 ERA in his three appearances and one start for rookie level Batavia. With Single-A Greensboro, Richards went 2-3 with a 3.50 ERA in his eight starts for the Grasshoppers.

2015 Highlights: Richards spent his first season in professional baseball with the Gateway Grizzlies in the independent Frontier League. There he was 6-6 with a 3.36 ERA in his 14 starts for Gateway.

College: Richards left Drury as one of the program's best pitchers in their modern era. He ranks second at Drury in career strikeouts with 230 and his 2.96 career earned run average is the second lowest mark in team history. He posted a 24-12 record as a collegiate pitcher, was a three-time All-Great Lakes Valley Conference performer and was twice named to the All-Region team. In his senior season in 2015, he went 5-3 with a 3.61 ERA and recorded 72 strikeouts against just 19 walks in 72.1 innings.

Personal: Earned All-Area First Team honors, NCA All-Star Baseball Team honors and was once Co-MVP and once MVP for Mater Dei Catholic High School. . . Named Mater Dei's most valuable pitcher also with a 9-1 record helping Mater Dei Catholic to a 21-3 record. . . Was on Mater Dei team that set a school record for most wins in a season. . . Was named to the All-PNC St. Louis All-Star Team, a group of the St. Louis areas best players and played at Busch Stadium. . . Was a US Army Reserve National Scholar Athlete and a member of the Honor Roll.
