A late two-run single by shortstop Eduardo Torrealba broke a 2-2 tie and backed a strong start from Roansy Contreras to lead the RiverDogs to an 8-3 win over the Columbia Fireflies Saturday night in front of 5,625 at Joe Riley Park.

Torrealba's single wasn't hit hard, but it did the job. Mitchell Robinson led off the inning with his fifth walk of the season, but the rally looked like it would end just as quickly as it started when Eduardo Navas followed with a routine ground ball to Ronny Mauricio at shortstop. Mauricio's throw to Shervyen Newton was wide, allowing Robinson to advance to third base and Navas to second. Torrealba came through a ground ball back up the middle and through a drawn-in Fireflies (19-30) infield to give Charleston (26-23) a 4-2 lead off Columbia reliever Bryce Hutchinson (2-2, 2.65).

DOGGIE BITES

- Slim Margins:** Despite dropping 9 of their last 16, the RiverDogs have maintained their first-place position in the SAL Southern Division, having lost several tight ballgames in that span. Of the RiverDogs' nine losses over that span, five have been decided by one run, in extra innings, or both. After ranking among the bottom four in the league in runs scored (3.4 per game) over the first 20 games of the season, the RiverDogs have scored 161 runs over their last 29 games (2nd in the SAL in that span, 5.6/gm) with 129 allowed over that stretch. Charleston also **leads the league** in total hits (275) and doubles (68), and is second in the SAL in total bases (437), hitting (.269), RBI (145), SLG (.427), and OPS (.769) since the hot streak started on April 25. The club's staff ERA is also 3.50 in that span, ranking third in the league behind Delmarva and Kannapolis.
- You Again?:** The RiverDogs welcome the Columbia Fireflies back to The Joe for the third time this season last night, taking the opener of the four game set 8-3. The RiverDogs have had the Fireflies' number throughout the first 12 meetings, as Charleston has prevailed in 9 of those 12 contests, outscoring its in-state rivals by an aggregate score of 57-30. Charleston is without a few of their hitters who have enjoyed the most success against the Fireflies this year, as Wilkerman Garcia (.417 AVG, 1.148 OPS in 6 games vs COL), Eric Wagaman (.321 AVG, .887 OPS in 9 games) and Josh Breaux (.250 AVG in 7 games) are all on the 7-Day IL. On the active roster, OFs Canaan Smith (.296/.387/.593, .980 OPS, 5 XBH in 8 G, 27 AB) and Josh Stowers (.346/.471/.500, .971 OPS, 4 2B in 8 G, 26 AB) have the most impressive résumés against Columbia in 2019.
- Locked In:** Charleston center fielder Brandon Lockridge earned a couple of knocks last night to bounce back from a rare 0-for-4 in the finale in Asheville. Lockridge tagged his sixth home run of the season on Wednesday; five have been to lead off innings, which is the most in the SAL this year. The recent power stroke has been a continuing trend for the Troy University product; Lockridge notched just one homer in 26 games in his pro debut last season and never had more than 6 in a single-season in three years at Troy. The Pensacola native is hitting .337 (33-98) since May 1, which ranks sixth among qualifying hitters in the league in that stretch. His 24 XBH are tied for the tied for the third-most in the league. After hitting just .169 (13-for-77) over his first 19 games of the season, Lockridge has hit .310 (36-for-116) in 26 games since.
- Land of Canaan:** Add Charleston outfielder Canaan Smith to the list of sizzling-hot RiverDogs hitters, as he owns a .358 (34-95) average in his last 23 games all in May, good for 4th in the SAL in that span. During the hot streak, Smith has 13 extra base hits, 17 runs scored, 51 total bases and is slugging .537 with an OPS of .967. During his torrid stretch, he hit for the cycle in the 13-5 win on May 12 at Hickory, the first for the RiverDogs since July 6, 1997 when catcher Matt Quatraro accomplished the feat at Joe Riley Park, also against the Crawdads. He has enjoyed three separate hitting streaks of eight or more games this year, including a team-high 13 in a row from from 4/25-5/10 and a more recent stretch when he had hit safely in nine straight games from May 14-23.
- Swing and Miss Stuff:** Charleston's dominant staff enters play third in the South Atlantic League with 495 strikeouts (10.1 K/9). After striking out a career-high 10 in back-to-back starts, Alexander Vizcaino leads the dominant staff with 58 whiffs on the season.
- Pinstriped Prospects:** The RiverDogs will again tap into a deep farm system in the New York Yankees. Losing some of their organizational talent due to promotions and trades in the last year, the Yankees' farm system fell from the second-best system in the game to 20th on the *Baseball America* rankings heading into 2019. Despite this, the Bronx Bombers are stocked with intriguing talent at the lower levels of the farm system, including five of the Yanks' pre-season Top-30 prospects currently on the RiverDogs roster (MLB.com/BA): RHP Roansy Contreras (10/7), RHP Luis Medina (14/11), RHP Luis Gil (13/25), C Josh Breaux (15/30), OF Josh Stowers (25/--) and RHP Tanner Myatt (29/--).
