Last Game: Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp right fielder John Norwood and third baseman Brian Anderson hit back-to-back home runs in a five-run first inning, enough to keep their team ahead for the rest of a 5-3 win over the Chattanooga Lookouts in front of 8,249 – with those named Chuck, Charles and Taylor entering free on Chuck Taylor Night – at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville Thursday night. Jacksonville (4-3) opened the bottom of the first inning against Lookouts starter and former Jacksonville left-hander Matt Tracy (0-1) with second baseman Yefri Perez reaching safely on a throwing error by Chattanooga shortstop Engel Vielma. Norwood promptly hit his first home run of the year to the berm in front of the left-field scoreboard for a 2-0 Jumbo Shrimp lead. Anderson followed with his first homer of the season toward the Budweiser Tiki Terrace down the left-field line. With two outs, the Jumbo Shrimp hit four straight singles – by Jumbo Shrimp shortstop Alex Yarbrough, first baseman Taylor Ard, catcher Austin Nola and center fielder Jeremias Pineda. Nola's drove in a run, and Pineda's infield single ball was thrown past third base by third baseman Dan Gamache to score the inning's fifth run. Facing the affiliate of his former organization, the Minnesota Twins, Jumbo Shrimp left-hander Matt Tomshaw (1-1) kept the visitors scoreless until two outs in the fifth inning, when a passed ball by catcher Austin Nola scored center fielder Tanner English, who had doubled with one out in the inning. Tomshaw completed five innings with four strikeouts. Jumbo Shrimp relievers combined to keep the score 5-1 until the ninth inning, when Lookouts first baseman Jonathan Rodriguez and catcher Dan Rohlfing hit back-to-back home runs to right field against right-hander Tayron Guerrero. After walks to the next two batters, right-hander Hunter Adkins entered to retire the final three batters for his first save.

NEWS AND NOTES

Garcia to Miami Marlins: Left-handed relief pitcher Jarlin Garcia has been recalled to the major league Miami Marlins. Garcia this season has made three relief outings for the Jumbo Shrimp, with no wins or losses and a 0.00 ERA in his three innings of work. This is the second big league call-up for Garcia, who was recalled by the Marlins on May 15 last season from Jacksonville. Garcia did not pitch for the Marlins in the big leagues despite being on their active roster for five days, so he is still awaiting his big league debut.

Big Crowds Welcome Jumbo Shrimp to Jacksonville: Through the first two games of the season, Jacksonville fans are making it well known that they support the Jumbo Shrimp. Thursday's crowd saw 8,249 fans make it to the Baseball Grounds for Thirsty Thursday, and through the first two games there have been 18,726 fans have made it to the ballpark. Jacksonville leads the Southern League by averaging 9,363 fans, 2,016 more fans than the next closest club in the league, Birmingham. The inaugural Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp home opener played to a sellout crowd of 10,477 – the largest Opening Day crowd at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville since the stadium's record-setting opening in 2003. Wednesday's crowd was also the largest crowd at a Southern League game at the ballpark since July 3, 2012. The stadium record of 12,943 was set at the venue's first-ever game on April 11, 2003.

Ard-Wolf Homer Company: Our friends at Aardwolf Brewing Company on Hendricks Avenue may soon want to name a beverage after Jumbo Shrimp first baseman Taylor Ard. He delivered a major jolt to the sellout crowd of 10,477 fans at the Baseball Grounds with his grand slam home run in the bottom of the third to give Jacksonville a 7-0 lead. The blast was the first Double-A home run for Ard, who led High-A Jupiter with 14 homers last season playing for Randy Ready. Ard is now tied for the league lead with eight runs batted in, even with Jackson's Dawel Lugo. Ard also sports the longest hitting streak for the Jumbo Shrimp, having hit safely in the first seven games of the season. His seven-game hitting streak is one of only three streaks that long in the Southern League.

Bencomo Faces Lookouts: Tonight's starting pitcher for the Jumbo Shrimp, right-hander Omar Bencomo, will face some familiar faces as he goes up against his former club, the Chattanooga Lookouts. Bencomo began the 2017 season in the Southern League with the Chattanooga Lookouts, the Double-A affiliate of the Minnesota Twins. Bencomo went 4-6 with a 3.86 ERA in 19 appearances and seven starts. That included time against Jacksonville last year, where he earned a save with two scoreless innings on June 7, and a win in a start on August 8 where he pitched five scoreless innings at the Baseball Grounds. Bencomo signed with the Marlins as a minor league free agent in the offseason, and won his first start last Saturday at Mississippi where he worked five scoreless innings.

Shrimp Have Prospects: On the Opening Day roster, the Jumbo Shrimp have seven players that are considered among the Top 30 Marlins prospects for this season according to both Baseball America and MLB.com. Top 30 Marlins Prospects include: third baseman Brian Anderson (No. 3 MLB, No. 4 BA), left-handed pitcher Jarlin Garcia (No. 4 MLB, No. 6 BA), left-handed pitcher Dillon Peters (No. 5 MLB, No. 5 BA), left fielder Austin Dean (No. 13 MLB, No. 8 BA), right-handed pitcher Tayron Guerrero (No. 19 MLB, No. 16 BA), outfielder John Norwood (No. 27 MLB, No. 29 BA), and infielder Yefri Perez (No. 30 both MLB & BA). Additionally, Baseball America regards Anderson as being the "Best Hitter for Average, Best Strike-Zone Discipline, Best Defensive Infielder, Best Infield Arm," in the organization, while Garcia has the "Best Changeup," Perez is the "Fastest Baserunner," and Peters has the "Best Control."

That included time against Jacksonville last year, where he earned a save with two scoreless innings on June 7, and a win in a start on August 8 where he pitched five scoreless innings at the Baseball Grounds.
