**Last Game:** Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp right-hander Pablo Lopez pitched a season-long seven innings but had his streak of 22 2/3 scoreless innings snapped, as Montgomery left fielder Nick Solak's fourth-inning solo home run led the Biscuits to a 1-0 win in the second game of a five-game series at Montgomery Riverwalk Stadium Sunday afternoon. Montgomery Biscuits right-hander Zach Lee (5-1), a former a major league pitcher with the Los Angeles Dodgers and San Diego Padres, scattered nine hits in his second career shutout. His previous one also came against Jacksonville as a Dodgers minor leaguer with Chattanooga on July 4, 2013, when he went 5 1/3 scoreless innings before rain ended the game early. The Jumbo Shrimp (14-22) had at least one baserunner in eight of nine innings against Lee but left runners in scoring position in three of the first four innings. The first two batters reached in the fourth inning to put runners at first and third bases, but Lee struck out designated hitter Skyler Ewing and got third baseman Brian Schales to ground into an inning-ending double play. The Biscuits (15-22) also turned double plays after leadoff singles in the fifth and sixth innings. Lopez (0-1) began his fifth Southern League start by retiring 11 of the first 12 batters he faced, with Solak's second-inning leadoff single as the only baserunner. Their next meeting came with two outs in the bottom of the fourth inning, and Solak hit a first-pitch solo home run to center field, marking the first run against Lopez in his Double-A career that began this year. Lopez had shut out the Southern League on 10 hits and four walks with 22 strikeouts in his first 22 2/3 innings. Montgomery threatened to grow the lead with a runner at third base in each of the next three innings against Lopez. In the fifth inning, Schales threw out a runner trying to score, and Lopez got the final two outs of the sixth inning with two runners on base. He matched his Marlins career high with seven innings, allowing five hits with no walks and five strikeouts. In the ninth inning, right fielder John Norwood and first baseman Eric Jagielo hit consecutive singles, and left fielder Cade Gotta sacrificed both into scoring position, but Lee struck out Ewing, and Schales' flyout to right field ended the game.

## NEWS AND NOTES

**Merandy is Back:** Tonight's Jumbo Shrimp starting pitcher Merandy Gonzalez has returned to Jacksonville rotation from the Miami Marlins major league bullpen. With the Marlins, Gonzalez pitched in six games, going 2-0 with a 4.85 ERA in his time on the mound. Gonzalez started his season in Jacksonville, going 0-1 with a 4.50 ERA in just two starts before he was called up to the big leagues on April 19.

**Balancing the Schales:** Jumbo Shrimp third baseman Brian Schales is on fire heading into Monday's game. Schales has hit safely and has multi-hit games in the past four games, with the games Thursday through Saturday being multi-hit games, hitting 7-for-15 (.467) in that stretch, driving in a pair of runs. Schales is hitting .294 over his past 10 games, and during the month of May has been one of Jacksonville's top contributors, hitting .268 with four runs batted in, which is tied with Monte Harrison for the most this month.

**Bring on the Biscuits:** The Biscuits fight song is a good way to start the first of three series this season between the Jumbo Shrimp and the Montgomery Biscuits, the Double-A affiliate of the Tampa Bay Rays. This marks Jacksonville's only trip to Montgomery this season, while the Biscuits will return to Jacksonville from June 28 to July 3, and July 23-27. Last season the Jumbo Shrimp struggled against the Biscuits, going 2-8 against Montgomery overall, going 1-4 in series both in Montgomery and at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville.

**April Flowers Bring May Showers:** So far the month of May has not been kind to the Jumbo Shrimp. Through 12 games in May, the Jumbo Shrimp are 2-10, getting swept by the Shuckers in Biloxi and dropping four out of five games in the last series against Tennessee, and so far splitting the first two games in Montgomery. As a team, Jacksonville is hitting .191 this month with five home runs and 22 RBI, and the pitching staff is 2-10 with a 3.36 ERA with one save. May was also a losing month for the Jumbo Shrimp in 2017, going 13-15 and hitting .232 in May 2017.

**Shrimp Have Prospects:** On the roster, the Jumbo Shrimp have five players who were listed by *MLB.com* as Top 30 Miami Marlins prospects for the 2018 season: OF Monte Harrison (1), Isan Diaz (7), RHP Nick Neidert (8), RHP Pablo Lopez (21), and John Norwood (30). Four of these five prospects were acquired by the Marlins in trades within the past 12 months.

**BACK WITH THE JUMBO SHRIMP:** Tonight's Jumbo Shrimp starting pitcher Merandy Gonzalez has returned to Jacksonville rotation from the Miami Marlins major league bullpen. With the Marlins, Gonzalez pitched in six games, going 2-0 with a 4.85 ERA in his time on the mound. Gonzalez started his season in Jacksonville, going 0-1 with a 4.50 ERA in just two starts before he was called up to the big leagues on April 19.

**MARLINS TIME:** With the Marlins, Gonzalez pitched in six games, going 2-0 with a 4.85 ERA in his time on the mound, striking out seven batters in his 13 innings of work. He made his major league debut on April 19 at Milwaukee, working a scoreless two innings where he allowed two hits to the Brewers in a 12-3 loss. He earned his first major league win on April 25 at Los Angeles against the Dodgers, working three innings where he allowed three runs on five hits with a walk and no strikeouts, as he worked the fifth through the eighth inning in a game Miami won 8-6. He earned a win his next time out on April 30 in Miami against the Phillies, working two scoreless innings where he allowed a hit in the fifth and sixth as the Marlins won 8-4. He also had a scoreless two innings at Cincinnati on May 4, and then his last big league outing he gave up three runs on eight hits in three innings of work in a 13-4 loss to the Chicago Cubs at Wrigley Field.

**BAYBEARS START:** Gonzalez suffered a loss in his start on Saturday April 14 in front of 10,254 fans at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville against the Mobile BayBears. Gonzalez worked five plus innings where he allowed five runs on five hits with three walks and four strikeouts, with two homers allowed, as the BayBears won 13-3.

**GENERALS START:** Gonzalez had a no decision in his start and Double-A debut on Sunday April 8 against the Jackson Generals at The Ballpark at Jackson. Gonzalez worked five scoreless inning, allowing two infield singles with a walk and a strikeout. He left with the game scoreless, and the game was scoreless until the bottom of the ninth when Jackson's Matt Jones won the game with a walk-off RBI single to give the Generals a 1-0 win, clinching a series victory.

**PROSPECT:** Gonzalez, a member of the Marlins 40-man roster, enters 2018 as the Marlins No. 15 prospect according to Baseball America and No. 16 prospect according to MLB.com.

## #38 MERANDY GONZALEZ RHP | 6-0, 216 lbs | Born: Oct. 9, 1995 in Cotui, Dominican Republic. 22 years old.

Acquired by the Miami Marlins in a trade with the New York Mets with OF Ricardo Cespedes in exchange for RHP AJ Ramos on July 28, 2017.

**2017 Highlights:** Combined to go 13-3 with one save and a 1.66 ERA between three teams and two organizations in 2017. Established career bests in ERA, appearances (22), starts (20), innings pitched (130.1), and strikeouts (103). Began season with Single-A Columbia Fireflies in the South Atlantic League where he was teammates with Tim Tebow, and went 8-1 with a 1.55 ERA in his 11 starts. Over first four starts of season, tossed 28.1 scoreless innings, allowing just 15 hits and three walks while striking out 23. Went 4-0 with 0.00 ERA (28.1/0) in four April starts, earning South Atlantic League Player of the Month honors. Struck out 23 while holding opponents to a .160 average. Named South Atlantic League Midseason All-Star after going 8-1 with 1.55 ERA (69.2/12) in 11 starts before break. Promoted to High-A St. Lucie on June 22 and with the St. Lucie Mets was 4-2 with a 2.23 ERA in six starts. Following trade to Marlins organization, went 1-0 with a 1.11 ERA in five appearances and three starts for the High-A Jupiter Hammerheads.

**2016 Highlights:** Made 14 starts for Single-A Short-Season Brooklyn, going 6-3 with a 2.87 ERA.
