**Last Game:** The Pensacola Blue Wahoos overcame a 3-1 deficit and broke a 3-3 tie with a three-run eighth inning in a 6-4 win over the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp in front of 1,600 at the first Publix Corks and Forks Wednesday at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Jacksonville right-hander Pablo Lopez allowed two earned runs in a six-inning start, raising his ERA to 0.62, the best in the Southern League. Pensacola (21-31) took the lead with right-handed pitcher Keury Mella's first career home run leading off the third inning. In the bottom of the inning, Jacksonville (21-31) answered with a two-out solo home run by second baseman Isan Diaz to the right-center field bleachers. The Jumbo Shrimp took the lead in the bottom of the fourth inning. Mella walked the first two batters, catcher Sharif Othman put down a sacrifice bunt, and shortstop Luis Pintor hit a go-ahead single to left field. Lopez put down a bunt that scored another run, but Mella retired the next two batters to end the inning. He lasted five innings, allowing three earned runs on two hits and a season-high seven walks with six strikeouts. Mella and four relievers combined to retire 17 of the final 18 Jumbo Shrimp batters, with first baseman Eric Jagielo's eighth-inning homer the only other Jacksonville run. Left-hander Kevin Canelon (1-0) earned a win with a scoreless inning, and right-hander Alex Powers earned his fourth save. Lopez allowed a fifth-inning leadoff home run by Pensacola center fielder C.J. McElroy to left field. After allowing a single, Lopez retired the final six batters he faced, scattering six hits and one walk with nine strikeouts. Jacksonville left-hander Jeff Kinley began the seventh inning with a 3-2 lead. Pinch hitter Alberti Chavez singled to left field, went to second base on McElroy's sacrifice and scored the tying run on a two-out error by third baseman Brian Schales. In the pivotal eighth inning against right-hander Kyle Keller (1-2), Pensacola shortstop Luis Gonzalez singled. Left fielder Daniel Sweet singled to left field, and left fielder Cade Gotta's errant throw allowed Gonzalez to score the go-ahead run and sent Sweet to third base. Third baseman Taylor Sparks' bunt scored another run, as did Keller's two-out wild pitch.

## NEWS AND NOTES

**Roster Moves:** Catcher Skyler Ewing has been transferred from Jacksonville to Marlins extended spring training. Ewing played in 24 games for the Jumbo Shrimp, hitting .159 with two home runs and two runs batted in. In a corresponding move, infielder Peter O'Brien has been acquired by the Marlins in a trade from the Los Angeles Dodgers and assigned to Jacksonville. O'Brien was playing at the Double-A level for the Dodgers with the Tulsa Drillers of the Texas League, and there he was hitting .150 with seven home runs and 22 RBI in 31 games played. O'Brien, 27, is a native of Hialeah, Florida, played in parts of two seasons in the major leagues with the Arizona Diamondbacks in 2015 and 2016, and is a career .176 hitter with six home runs and 12 RBI in 36 major league games.

**Graves Pitches Today:** Today Miami Marlins right-handed pitcher Brett Graves will pitch in relief for the Jumbo Shrimp in Game One of Jacksonville's doubleheader. Graves made one start with the Jumbo Shrimp last Sunday at Mississippi, pitching four innings where he allowed five runs on seven hits with two walks and three strikeouts. Graves made two rehab starts with the Hammerheads, going 0-1 with a 6.43 ERA in his seven innings of work. Graves started the season on Miami's 60-day disabled list due to a left oblique strain. Graves pitched in three games for the Marlins during spring training before his injury. Graves was selected by the Marlins from the Oakland Athletics in the Major League phase of the 2017 Rule 5 draft. Graves has pitched above the Double-A level in his career, and he was originally selected by the A's in the third round of the 2014 draft from the University of Missouri.

**Jagiello RBI Machine:** Jacksonville first baseman Eric Jagielo has been an RBI machine over the past ten games. In that time, he has driven in 14 runs for the Jumbo Shrimp, which leads the Southern League and is second in the Double-A level for RBI during the May 19-30 timespan. Jagielo now leads the Jumbo Shrimp with 34 RBI this season, which is tied for third most in the Southern League and just four RBI behind Montgomery's Brandon Loww for the league lead (38). Prior to yesterday Jagielo had three multi-RBI games in a row for Jacksonville, and five of his last seven games are multi-RBI contests. He drove in one of Jacksonville's four runs last night with a solo home run in the eighth inning, and he has homered in back-to-back games against his former club the Blue Wahoos.

**Florida's AA Baseball Rivalry is BACK:** This is the second series this season between the Jumbo Shrimp and their in-state rivals, the Pensacola Blue Wahoos. This is the final trip for the Blue Wahoos to Jacksonville in 2018, and earlier this season Jacksonville enjoyed a dominant homestand by winning four of five games against Pensacola from April 26-30. The Jumbo Shrimp will make two trips to Pensacola in the second half, facing the Blue Wahoos from July 18-22, and August 14-18 at Blue Wahoos Stadium. Last year the Jumbo Shrimp went 7-13 against the Wahoos, yet split the 10 meetings 5-5 at the Baseball Grounds. Pensacola won the first half South Division title, while Jacksonville took the second half South Division crown, and the clubs met in the Southern League playoffs, Wahoos swept.

**Shrimp Have Prospects:** On the roster, the Jumbo Shrimp have five players who were listed by *MLB.com* as Top 30 Miami Marlins prospects for the 2018 season: OF Monte Harrison (1), Isan Diaz (7), RHP Nick Neidert (8), RHP Pablo Lopez (21), and John Norwood (30).

# TONIGHT'S JUMBO SHRIMP STARTING PITCHER

**21 – KOLTON MAHONEY, RHP**

**3-3, 1.34 ERA, 11 games and 3 starts**

**2018:** 3-3, 1.34 ERA (5 ER/33.2 IP) in 11 G and 3 GS.  
**CAREER:** 16-16, 2.83 ERA (80 ER/254.1 IP) in 64 G and 34 GS.

**2018 vs. PNS:** 0-0, 6.00 ERA (2 ER/3.0 IP) in 1 G and 0 GS.

**TONIGHT-SPOT START:** Tonight right-handed pitcher Kolton Mahoney will make a start in Game One of Jacksonville's doubleheader against Mobile. This marks Mahoney's fourth start of the season, and he has only allowed one earned run in 14 innings of work in his starts. He started Game Two of Jacksonville's first doubleheader on Wednesday April 18 at Chattanooga, working four scoreless innings where he allowed five hits with no walks and three strikeouts as Jacksonville lost 3-2. Mahoney made his second spot start on Wednesday May 9 in Jacksonville against the Tennessee Smokies, filling in for Elieser Hernandez who left his major league rehab assignment early to join the Marlins in Miami. Mahoney proceeded to work five innings allowing one run (unearned) on four hits with no walks and a strikeout as Jacksonville lost 3-2 in 10 innings. In his last start on in Game Two of Jacksonville's doubleheader with Mobile on Friday May 18, working five innings where he allowed two runs (one earned) on six hits with a walk and a strikeout as Jacksonville lost 3-1.

**STARTING EXPERIENCE:** Mahoney is a prime candidate for the rotation and this spot start, with 31 career starts under his belt. Last year pitching for Single-A Greensboro, he went 4-5 with a 4.76 ERA as a starter in 13 starts for the Grasshoppers.

**2017 IN REVIEW:** Mahoney started the 2017 season still a member of the New York Yankees organization. After going 1-2 with a 1.85 ERA in 11 games, collecting one save, and striking out 26 batters in 24 and a third innings with Single-A Charleston, he was released by the Yankees on May 27. The Marlins signed him three days later on May 30, and he finished the season with Single-A Greensboro, also in the South Atlantic League. With the Grasshoppers, Mahoney went 5-5 with a 4.08 ERA in 18 games pitched and 13 starts, striking out 74 batters in 79 and a third innings of work.

Signed by the Miami Marlins as a minor league free agent on May 30, 2017

**2017 Highlights:** Mahoney started the 2017 season still a member of the New York Yankees organization. After going 1-2 with a 1.85 ERA in 11 games, collecting one save, and striking out 26 batters in 24 and a third innings with Single-A Charleston, he was released by the Yankees on May 27. The Marlins signed him three days later on May 30, and he finished the season with Single-A Greensboro, also in the South Atlantic League. With the Grasshoppers, Mahoney went 5-5 with a 4.08 ERA in 18 games pitched and 13 starts, striking out 74 batters in 79 and a third innings of work.

**2016 Highlights:** With the New York-Penn League's Staten Island Yankees, Mahoney went 4-4 with a 2.92 ERA in 12 appearances and eight starts.

**2015 Highlights:** Selected by the New York Yankees in the 16<sup>th</sup> round of the 2015 draft out of Brigham Young University. With the New York-Penn League's Staten Island Yankees, Mahoney went 3-2 with a 2.29 ERA in 12 appearances and 10 starts, with 50 strikeouts in 55 innings of work.

**College:** Prior to being drafted in 2015, he went 4-8 in 13 starts this season for the Cougars, striking out 91 and earning a 5.27 ERA in 85 1/3 innings pitched. He first had a no decision in three innings of work where he allowed a run on two hits with no walks and two strikeouts against the Fort Myers Miracle on Thursday May 17. **#27 BRETT GRAVES RHP | 6-1, 170 lbs | Born: January 30, 1993 in St. Charles, Missouri. 25 Years Old.**

From Oakland in Major League Phase of 2017 Rule 5 Draft.

**2017 Highlights:** Graves made just 14 appearances between Single-A Stockton and Double-A Midland due to a lower leg injury. Combined to go 1-1 with a 4.47 ERA. Began season at Stockton with no record and 2.55 ERA in seven appearances and four starts. In his four starts he allowed just two runs (non earned) over 15.1 innings with two walks and 16 strikeouts. Promoted to Midland on May 6, and went 1-1 with a 5.97 ERA in seven appearances and six starts. Placed on the disabled list on June 14 with a lower leg injury and missed remainder of the season.

**2016 Highlights:** Graves spent the entire 2016 season with the High-A Stockton Ports, going 7-10 with a 4.60 ERA in 27 appearances and 25 starts.

**2015 Highlights:** Graves spent the entire 2015 with the Single-A Beloit Snappers in the Midwest League. Named First Team Louisville Slugger All-American and All-Metro Player of the Year in St. Louis after going 9-1 with a 1.95 ERA and 70 strikeouts. He also hit .441 with six home runs and 35 RBI as the Vikings leadoff hitter. Named Missouri Gatorade Player of the Year in 2011 after splitting time on the mound and at short stop for Francis Howell. Three-time All-State selection in baseball from 2009-11. GAC All-Conference (football) in 2009 as he was Francis Howell's starting quarterback and fielded many opportunities to pursue a collegiate football career. Led Francis Howell football to a 2009 conference championship and the team claimed conference, district and sectional titles in 2010. 2011 Scholar Athlete.
