**TODAY'S GAME:** The Quakes wrap up their five-game road trip as they take on the Inland Empire 66ers (Los Angeles Angels affiliate) in the fifth and final game of the series on Tuesday night. This series caps the first of two straight five-game sets, with Rancho opening a five-gamer at home against Lake Elsinore on Wednesday.

**VS INLAND EMPIRE:** This is the 16th of 30 total meetings between the two clubs in 2019. The Quakes took three of four just last weekend at LoanMart Field. Now, with four straight wins in the current series, Rancho has posted an 11-4 mark over the Sixers in the first 15 games. Dating back to the 2018 season, the Quakes hold a dominating record of 33-11 versus Inland Empire.

**QUAKES GONNA QUAKE:** The Quakes won their fourth straight game on Monday night, posting a 7-5 win over the Inland Empire 66ers at San Manuel Stadium. Donovan Casey and Jeren Kendall each had two hits and the bullpen gave up just two runs over the final 4.1 innings to preserve the victory, Rancho's fourth straight. Melvin Jimenez (1-0) surrendered a two-run homer, but earned the win in relief, while Inland Empire starter Travis Herrin (1-2) gave up six runs over 3.2 innings to get hit with the loss.

**ROAD WARRIORS:** The Quakes won their fourth straight game on the road last night, improving to an incredible 24-10 away from LoanMart Field in 2019. Last year, the Quakes won a franchise-record 42 games on the road, finishing at 42-28. With 36 road games remaining in 2019, the Quakes would need to go just 18-18 to match last year's franchise record of 42 wins.

**SOME WINDEX FOR THOSE STREAKS:** Last night's win was Rancho's fourth straight, giving them their third four-game winning streak to match their longest streak of the year. Rancho has only swept one series this year, a three-gamer at Lake Elsinore back in April. At no point have the Quakes won five straight this year. Last season, they set a rather daunting franchise record with 15 consecutive wins in the second half of what was a record breaking, championship season.

**YOU HEAR ME KNOCKIN':** Rancho eliminated Lancaster on Sunday and the Quakes can eliminate Lake Elsinore tonight with a win over the 66ers. The Storm must do their part to stay alive, as they have to win their game against Lancaster, or the Quakes will be crowned South Division First Half Champs before their game even ends with Inland Empire. Should the Quakes lose and the Storm win tonight, Rancho would need to beat the Storm just one time over the next five days at LoanMart Field, as they open a five-game set against Lake Elsinore on Wednesday. Should the unthinkable happen and the Quakes lose all five to the Storm, the two teams would finish the half in a tie, which means their first match-up in the second half (June 24th at LE) would be for all the marbles.

**QUAKES DIG THE LONG BALL:** With another home run on Monday, the Quakes have blasted 14 homers in nine games in the month of June. Additionally, Jeren Kendall's solo-shot on Monday extended Rancho's homer streak to nine straight games.

**BUDDING STARS IN RANCHO:** On Friday, the California League announced All-Stars for the North and South Division, with seven Rancho Cucamonga Quakes voted to the mid-season squad. Starting will be Jeter Downs (SS) and Devin Mann (3B), while Connor Wong (C), Donovan Casey (OF), Logan Salow (RP) and Wills Montgomerie (RP) are expected to come off the bench. Edwin Uceta, who was recently promoted to AA Tulsa, was named to the team, but will not play due to the promotion. The 2019 All-Star Game will be held at San Manuel Stadium in San Bernardino on Tuesday, June 18th. Tickets are available at IE66ers.com.

**ROSTER MOVES:** Lefty Wes Helsabeck was activated from the Temporary Inactive List today. He takes the spot of LHP Austin Hamilton, who was moved to the Extended Spring Training in Arizona.

**GERARDO CARRILLO:** Gerardo Carrillo makes his 12th appearance, 11th start and fourth overall start vs Inland Empire. In his last start overall, allowed six runs (five earned) on five hits with six walks over just 2.2 innings in a loss to Lancaster on June 6th. In three starts vs IE, is 0-1, but with a 2.70 ERA over 13.1 innings, allowing six runs (four earned) on 11 hits, but with ten strikeouts and 11 walks. Went 2-1 with a 1.65 ERA in nine starts for Great Lakes in 2018. Signed by the Dodgers in 2016 out of Mexico.

**AARON HERNANDEZ:** Aaron Hernandez makes his ninth appearance and seventh start of the year, his third start against Rancho. In his last outing overall, allowed two runs on five hits over 3.2 innings in a no-decision vs Lake Elsinore on June 6th. In two outings against Rancho, has scattered two hits over seven scoreless innings, striking out ten batters. Drafted out of Texas A&M Corpus Christi in the third round of the 2018 draft, but didn't pitch professionally until 2019.

**BEATY BACK WITH RC:** On Sunday, Dodgers INF Matt Beaty was assigned to the Rancho roster as part of a Major League Rehab Assignment. On the shelf with a left hip flexor strain, Beaty drove in the tying run on Sunday and also scored the go-ahead run. He was in Anaheim last night with the Dodgers, but is back with Rancho today, starting at first base and batting second. All Dodgers' rehabbers are sponsored by San Manuel Casino.
