Giants Conclude Series Against Visalia... The San Jose Giants conclude their four-game series against the Visalia Rawhide this afternoon at Municipal Stadium. The Giants have won two out of the first three games in the series claiming victories of 13-6 on Monday and 4-1 yesterday. The Rawhide posted a 2-1 win on Tuesday. Conner Menez (2-0, 0.45 ERA) is slated to start on the mound for San Jose today. This afternoon is the seventh of 29 meetings this year between the Giants and Rawhide (season series tied 3-3).

Home Cooking... The Giants are 10-4 at Municipal Stadium this season – the best home record in the California League. Five of the ten wins for San Jose have come in walk-off fashion. The Giants trailed entering the bottom of the ninth inning in four out of their five eventual walk-off wins. San Jose has yet to lose a series at home this season. The Giants won only 10 home games the entire first half last year (10-25 record).

On The Mound... The Giants enter today's contest with a league-best 3.13 team ERA. San Jose is also tops in the league in shutouts (4 – tied) and fewest home runs allowed (9). Giants starting pitchers own a 3.10 ERA while San Jose relievers possess a combined 3.16 ERA.

Hitting Streaks... Matt Winn and Johneshwy Fargas are currently riding nine-game hitting streaks. Winn is batting at a .333 clip (11-for-33) during his hit streak with three doubles, two triples and one home run. Fargas boasts a .469 batting average (15-for-32) during his hit streak with two doubles and two home runs. Winn and Fargas own the longest hit streaks of the season for the Giants.

Close Calls... San Jose has played 10 one-run games this season (out of 27 total games). The Giants are 6-4 in those one-run contests. San Jose is also a perfect 4-0 in extra-inning games this year.

On Deck... The Giants next embark on a six-game road trip to Lancaster (three games) and Modesto (three games). San Jose returns to Municipal Stadium on Friday, May 11 for a seven-game homestand versus the same two teams.

Winning April... The Giants' 15-10 record in April was their best opening month of the season since the club went 18-7 during April of 2013. San Jose finished with a sub-.500 April record in four straight years from 2014-17.

Cycle x2... April 11 was an historic night for the San Jose Giants as both Gio Brusa and Jalen Miller hit for the cycle in an 18-6 victory at Lancaster. Brusa (4-for-6, 2B, 3B, HR, 6 RBI) completed his cycle with a triple in the top of the eighth. Miller (5-for-7, 2B, 3B, HR, 4 RBI, SB), who tied a Giants single-game team record with five hits, tripled in the ninth inning for San Jose's second cycle of the night. The duo became the fourth and fifth players in the 31-year history of the San Jose Giants to hit for the cycle. Prior to Brusa and Miller, the last SJ Giant to hit for the cycle was Thomas Neal on April 28, 2009 at Lancaster.

Homegrown Giants... There are 11 former San Jose Giants currently on San Francisco's active 25-man roster: Brandon Belt, Ty Blach, Brandon Crawford, Reyes Moronta, Buster Posey, Pablo Sandoval, D.J. Snelten, Chris Stratton, Hunter Strickland, Andrew Suarez and Kelby Tomlinson. Three former SJ Giants – Snelten, Suarez and Tyler Beede – have made their major league debuts with SF this season.

- * Is in his third professional season ... Selected by the San Francisco Giants in the 14th round of the 2016 draft.
- * Today marks his fifth start of the season with the Giants ... Has pitched 20 innings and allowed only one run (0.45 ERA) ... Has surrendered just 12 hits, walked six and struck out 27 ... Owns a .171 opponents batting average.
- * Last two starts have come against Modesto ... Tossed five scoreless innings in his most recent outing on April 28 at John Thurman Field ... Allowed five hits, walked one and struck out five ... Received a no-decision (left game with 2-0 lead, Giants eventually lost 9-4) ... Picked-up the win against the Nuts on April 22 at Municipal Stadium after pitching five innings with one run surrendered.
- * Has pitched five innings in each of his first four starts with the Giants ... Has struck out at least seven in three out of four starts.
- * Has limited left-handed hitters to a .120 batting average (right-handed hitters at .200).
- * Made a spot-start for Sacramento (AAA) on April 12 against Reno ... Pitched four innings and allowed four runs (all earned) ... Suffered the loss.
- * Spent the entire 2017 season in the San Jose starting rotation ... Was 7-7 with a 4.41 ERA in 23 games (22 starts) ... Was named to the midseason California League All-Star team.
- * Led last year's Giants staff in wins, starts, innings pitched (114 1/3) and was second in strikeouts (99) ... Won San Jose's Pitcher of the Year award.
- * Allowed two earned runs or fewer in 12 out of his 22 starts last season ... Month-by-month ERA's: April (2.78), May (3.62), June (3.99), July (7.56) and August (8.03).
- * Struck out a career-high 10 batters over six innings on April 27, 2017 at Rancho Cucamonga.
- * Also pitched for San Jose in 2016 ... Was 2-0 with a 4.94 ERA in six games (five starts) ... Was the first player from the 2016 San Francisco Giants draft class to reach the Class-A Advanced level.
- * Attended The Master's University (NAIA school in Santa Clarita, CA).
- * Had a 2.47 ERA in 102 innings during his final season at The Master's in 2016 ... Pitched in the 2016 NAIA World Series in Lewiston, Idaho.
- * Was rated the top prospect in the Alaska Baseball League (collegiate summer league) in 2015.
- * Attended San Benito High School in Hollister, CA (one hour south of San Jose) ... Pitched at Municipal Stadium while in high school during the Central Coast Section playoffs.
