**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The Hillcats were held to a season-low three hits on Saturday night in a 4-1 loss to Down East. Lynchburg picked up an early lead in the fourth inning, when **Jonathan Laureano** worked a bases loaded walk. But, the Woodies came back with a four-run fifth inning to go ahead for good. Down East was helped out by a pair of fifth inning errors by **Nolan Jones**. Juan Hillman started for the Hillcats and allowed four unearned runs over six innings. Anderson Tejada finished 3-for-3 for Down East.

**CARTER CRUSHING IT:** Jodd Carter is having a fantastic series for Lynchburg. After getting back-to-back days off leading up the series, Carter has reached base in 11 of 13 plate appearances in this series. He has gone 6-for-8 with two doubles, a home run and five walks.

**STRIKE THREE, YOU'RE OUT!:** The Hillcats pitching staff has racked up the most strikeouts of any team in the Carolina League through 10 games, punching out 111 batters (11.1 strikeouts per game). On the flip side, Down East hitters have struck out the most in the league, fanning 106 times this year. Through the first three games of this series, Hillcats pitching has struck out 33 Wood Ducks, including a series-high 14 on Friday night.

**GOOD AFTERNOON:** Today marks the first day game for the Hillcats in the 2019 season. Last year, Lynchburg enjoyed a ton of success during day games, sporting a 17-8 record, including an 11-4 record in daylight on the road.

**STRONG STARTERS:** Through nine games, Lynchburg's starting rotation has been the focal point of the team. Starters have posted a 1.81 ERA, allowing just 11 earned runs in 52.1 innings of work. They have combined to strike out 59 batters, and have surrendered just 40 hits.

**WALK THIS WAY:** The Hillcats offense has been tops in the Carolina League in plate discipline this season. Through nine games, no Carolina League team has more walks than Lynchburg (51). **Tyler Friis** leads the Hillcats with nine walks over his eight contests this season, including four consecutive games with two walks over that span.

**TOP-30 IN THE HILL CITY:** Lynchburg enters the season with a trio of top-30 prospects according to *Baseball America*. Third baseman **Nolan Jones**, the second overall prospect in the system, returns to Lynchburg after playing in 30 games for the Hillcats in 2018. Starting pitcher **Jean Carlos Mejia**, listed at No. 17, appeared in one game for Lynchburg last year after spending the majority of the season with Lake County. Outfielder **Oscar Gonzalez** rounds out the group, as the No. 22 overall prospect. He spent all of 2018 with the Lake County Captains, where he ranked fifth in the Midwest League in hits with 135.

**VETERAN AT THE HELM:** The Hillcats are led this season by veteran MiLB skipper Jim Pankovits, who managed Mahoning Valley, Cleveland's Short-Season affiliate last year. Pankovits is just 3 games shy of 2,600 games as a manager in his career, which includes stops in the Boston Red Sox, Seattle Mariners, and Houston Astros organizations.

Pankovits is in his second year managing in the Indians organization after leading the Mahoning Valley Scrappers in 2018. Pankovits has 16 years of managerial experience under his belt with the Red Sox, Astros, Mariners, and Indians organizations. 2019 marks Pankovits' second stint in the Carolina League after he led the Salem Red Sox from 2006-2008. The Pennington Gap, Virginia native enjoyed a Major League career with the Astros and Red Sox as an infielder that spanned six seasons from 1984-1990.

Torres enters his first season with the Hillcats after serving as the pitching coach for Lake County in 2018. The former left-handed pitcher was selected with the 10th overall draft pick in 2000 by the Anaheim Angels and played in the minor leagues for 13 seasons, eventually reaching Triple-A. The 36-year-old Torres is a native of the Bronx, NY.

Narron comes to Lynchburg by way of Triple-A Columbus where he served in the same capacity for the Clippers in 2018. Narron is entering his third season in the Indians organization and brings Major League coaching experience to the Hillcats' staff after serving as the Milwaukee Brewers hitting coach from 2012-2014. With the Brewers, he instructed stars such as Ryan Braun, Jean Segura, Aramis Ramirez, and Carlos Gomez.

2019 will mark Mergenthaler's first season coaching stateside after serving as the hitting coach for Cleveland's Dominican Summer League co-op for two seasons. Mergenthaler is no stranger to the Commonwealth, having starred at Richmond in his college days.

Legan is entering his first season with the Hillcats and fifth in the Indians organization. Legan held the same position with the Captains in 2018.

Drafted by the Indians in the 8th Round of 2015 out of Cal State Fullerton...Tore his UCL shortly before the draft, requiring him to miss his first season of pro ball...At CSF became the 4th Titan all-time to throw a no-hitter, doing so against Cal State Northridge in 2014 (3-0 win, 12 K)...Pitched for Team USA in the summer of 2014, compiling a 2-1 record and a 1.35 ERA...In high school was named an All-American by MaxPreps and Baseball America...Was drafted by the Indians in the 26th Round in 2012 but did not sign... As a senior in 2012 at Bonita HS in California, he finished the year with a 12-1 record, 0.72 ERA and 101 strikeouts in 88 innings pitched while also batting .391
