### SNAPPER SNIPPETS

**HOME SWEET HOME:** Beloit started the homestand Thursday with a 4-1 victory over Clinton & they have now won 10 of their last 12 home games at Pohlman Field. The Snappers avoided a 6th straight loss by holding the LumberKings to a lone unearned run after allowing 40 runs during their 5-game skid.

**HE AIN'T JOSHIN':** Josh Vidales had a perfect night at the plate on Thursday by going 3-for-3 with a walk. To sweeten the deal, he drove in the go-ahead run on a bases-loaded single. Vidales got on-base in his first 20 games with Beloit & has the 3rd-most walks in the league since he joined the Snappers on July 12.

**LOPEZ GOES LONG:** Jesus Lopez smacked his 4th professional home run on Thursday night where he hit his first pro homer last May.

**MARTIN MILESTONE:** Mike Martin leads the league with 14 stolen bases since July 4 & is one shy of 20 with Beloit. His 22 total SBs lead the A's organization.

**GETTING DEFENSIVE:** Beloit's defense has made a habit out of making extra outs. They lead the Midwest League in double plays (114) & outfield assists (44) while sitting 2nd in runners caught stealing (55). Luke Persico leads the league with 14 outfield assists while Collin Theroux has gunned down 35 baserunners from behind the plate, the most in the league.

**NOWLIN LATER:** Kyle Nowlin moved into 2nd in the Midwest League in walks with a pair of free passes on Thursday. He worked multiple walks in the same game for the 7th time this year. The Snappers RBI leader has also driven in 23 RBI in his last 26 games & sits 1 short of 60 RBIs.

**PERSICO CROSSING THE PLATE:** Luke Persico scored his 14th run in his last 14 games on Thursday. His 55 total runs scored this year are tied for 12th in the Midwest League.

**CLOSE GAMES:** The Snappers have played a total of 71 games decided by 3 runs or fewer & Beloit has a record of 35-36 in those contests. Additionally, Beloit's 39 one-run games are 2nd-most in the league.

**HELPFUL TO GET A HANDFUL:** The Snappers are 39-10 this year when they reach 5 runs & 13-10 in ballgames that both teams reach 5 runs.

**TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER:** Matt Milburn went 9 straight starts without allowing more than 3 runs from June 15-July 31 before he was roughed up at Quad Cities his last time out. Milburn dominated the LumberKings with 12 strikeouts in 7 IP while he allowed just 3 hits back on June 23. He currently sits 3rd in the league in strikeouts.

**FACING THE LUMBERKINGS:** The Snappers & LumberKings series this season has been a streaky one dominated by the home squad. Beloit kicked that trend to begin the 2nd half by taking 3 of 4 in Clinton at the end of June. The LumberKings carry 3 of the Mariners top-30 prospects with INF Joe Rizzo (#15), RHP Seth Elledge (#22), & INF Bryson Brigrman (#27).
