JACKSONVILLE BLANKED IN SEASON OPENER

The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp were shut out 5-0 by the Jackson Generals in Thursday's 2019 season opener at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Ben DeLuzio notched an RBI double in the second inning to break open the scoring. Daulton Varsho registered an RBI double in the third, and later in the frame, Marcus Wilson ripped a two-run two-bagger to make it 4-0. A Pavin Smith sacrifice fly in the eighth inning widened the margin to 5-0. The Jumbo Shrimp mustered just one hit in the effort.

NOTHING BUT TROUBLE

Jacksonville is hoping that their 5-0 defeat to Jackson in their 2019 season opener on Thursday is not a continuation of an issue from last season. The Jumbo Shrimp had the Southern League's worst record in shutouts in 2018, finishing just 4-16 (.200). The club's 16 blankings were the most in the circuit since Jackson suffered 21 shutouts in 2015 and represent Jacksonville's second-most during the club's Miami Marlins era, which dates back through the start of the 2019 season (20, 2013).

HELLO, IT'S ME

Seventeen of the 25 members of Jacksonville's Opening Day roster have spent time with the club in past seasons. The majority of those returnees are pitchers, which include right-handers **Dustin Beggs**, **Rob Dugger**, **Brett Graves**, **Kyle Keller**, **Cody Poteet** and **Jordan Yamamoto**, as well as southpaws **Jeff Kinley**, **Dylan Lee** and **McKenzie Mills**. Catcher **Rodrigo Vigil**, infielders **Bryson Brigman**, **Joe Dunand**, **J.C. Millan**, **John Silviano** and **Justin Twine** and outfielders **Brian Miller** and **Anfernee Seymour** have also sported Jumbo Shrimp uniforms prior to the 2019 season.

SIXPENCE NONE THE RICHER

Twenty percent of the Miami Marlins' Top 30 prospects according to MLB.com will start the season in Jacksonville. Right-handed pitchers **Jorge Guzman** (No. 9), **Jordan Yamamoto** (No. 17) and **Robert Dugger** (No. 22) help lead a talented rotation, with the Dugger earning an Opening Day nod at the Baseball Grounds. Miami's No. 14 prospect, outfielder **Brian Miller**, teams up with talented infielders **Joe Dunand** (No. 23) and **Bryson Brigman** (No. 24) to highlight the Jumbo Shrimp's collection of position players.

APRIL SHOWERS

Jacksonville has not had a winning record in the month of April since the 2013 season, when the club went 14-10 en route to a 73-63 (.547) campaign. Over the last five Aprils, Jacksonville is 54-63 (.462) in the schedule's opening month. In comparison, from the beginning of the Marlins era on the First Coast, which dates to the start of the 2009 season, through 2013, Jacksonville suffered through just one losing month of April. Over those five years, they were 65-50 (.561) in the campaign's lid-lifting month.

WORLD'S BEST BOSS

Kevin Randel will manage the Jumbo Shrimp during the 2019 season, marking his third different stint in Jacksonville. The Marlins' 13th-round pick in 2002, Randel played seven seasons in the club's minor league system, batting .253/.371/.426 with 12 home runs and 49 RBIs in 123 games in 2009 with Jacksonville. He later returned to the First Coast to serve as Jacksonville's hitting coach from 2012-14. The 2019 season is Randel's fifth as a skipper in Miami's organization, with the Wilmington, N.C. native having served as the pilot of then-Low-A Greensboro in 2015-16 and High-A Jupiter throughout 2017-18. Randel is 253-296 (.461) so far in his managerial career.

ASSISTANTS TO THE REGIONAL MANAGERS

The Jumbo Shrimp will boast an expansive field staff in 2019. In addition to manager **Kevin Randel**, Jacksonville's coaching staff includes pitching coach **Bruce Walton**, hitting coach **Sean Berry**, defensive coach **Jose Ceballos** and bullpen coach **Esmerling De La Rosa**. Athletic trainer **Alan Rail** and strength, conditioning coach **Brady Fitzgerald** and video/advance manager **Bryan Rogers** round the Jumbo Shrimp's field staff.

SHRIMP SCOPES

Jacksonville's pitching staff registered 12 strikeouts in Thursday's season opener. The Shrimp had just 18 games throughout the 2018 campaign with more whiffs... The first three home sets at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville this year are against Northern Division clubs... The three-through-six hitters in the Jumbo Shrimp order reached base in five of their 15 plate appearances on Thursday. All other Jacksonville hitters combined to go 0-for-17.

ABOUT JORGE

-Guzman grew up with one brother and four sisters and was raised by his mother in Las Matas de Santa Cruz in the Dominican Republic, a municipality with a population of 18,786. Las Matas de Santa Cruz has produced just two major leaguers to date: shortstop Frank Tavaraz and switch-hitting pitcher Lendy Castillo.

-In about 2010, Guzman was messing around in between baseball games at a park near his hometown of Las Matas de Santa Cruz. Standing shirtless and barefoot in the outfield, he began flinging oranges at high speeds towards home plate. That caught the attention of one of his youth coaches, who turned Guzman from an outfielder into a pitcher that day.

-Guzman originally signed with Houston as a non-drafted free agent on June 15, 2014. However, the Astros traded Guzman along with right-hander Albert Abreu on November 17, 2016 for catcher Brian McCann. Exactly 13 months later, Guzman was packaged with second baseman Starlin Castro and shortstop Jose Devers to Miami in exchange for outfielder Giancarlo Stanton.

-At the start of Spring Training in 2019, the Marlins held a cooking competition for a group of top minor leaguers. Guzman, outfielder Connor Scott and shortstop Osiris Johnson teamed up to create a chicken and broccoli stir fry to win the contest.

-Ranked as the ninth-best prospect in the Marlins' organization by MLB.com, Guzman yielded only an infield single among three batters faced in last year's MLB Futures Game at Nationals Park in Washington, D.C.

-Among 102 pitchers with at least 80 innings pitched in the Florida State League, Guzman placed 28th in strikeout percentage (23.5 percent). However, his 24.9 percent line drive rate was the fourth-highest in the circuit

-Guzman posted a 2.44 ERA in 10 first-half starts (48.0 IP, 38 H, 30 BB, 47 K). However, that number swelled to 5.63 in 11 starts in the second half (48.0 IP, 46 H, 34 BB, 54 K).

-Guzman registered reverse platoon splits in 2018. In 220 plate appearances, left-handed batters notched a .651 OPS. Over 210 plate appearances against right-handed hitters, Guzman recorded a .798 OPS-against.

2017 SEASON

-Guzman ranked second in the New York-Penn League in strikeout rate (33.5 percent), third in xFIP (2.09) sixth in FIP (2.47) and ninth in ERA (2.30). He also registered best swinging-strike rate (16.7 percent) and the 12th-highest ground ball rate (53.3 percent).

2016 SEASON

-Guzman began the season with Rookie-level Greenville, but was demoted to the GCL Astros just 12 days into the campaign. He earned a promotion back to the Appalachian League on August 6. Opponents batted just .196 against him between the two levels.

2015 SEASON

-Guzman appeared with DSL Astros Blue, DSL Astros Orange and the GCL Astros throughout his first professional season.
