**Last Game:** The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (2-3, 30-43) defeated the Mississippi Braves (3-2, 32-43) by a 7-2 score in the fifth game of the six-game series at Trustmark Park on Monday night. Jacksonville right-handed starting pitcher Nick Neidert (7-4) earned the victory, pitching seven innings where he allowed two runs on six hits with one walk and three strikeouts, and he also contributed an RBI double at the plate. Mississippi right-handed starting pitcher Enderson Franco (2-5) took the loss, working five innings where he allowed six runs (three earned) on eight hits with no walks and a season-high 10 strikeouts. The first two innings featured a pair of runs for the Jumbo Shrimp, both coming with two outs. Peter O'Brien gave Jacksonville a 1-0 lead in the first with an RBI single. Then in the bottom of the second, Neidert helped his own cause with an RBI double that scored Rodrigo Vigil from second base to put the lead at 2-0 Jacksonville. Monte Harrison continued the scoring in the top of the third with a home run blast to left field to grow the lead to 3-0 and extend his season-long hitting streak to eight games. After the Shrimp were held off the scoreboard in the fourth, Jacksonville scored three runs in the fifth. After a Brian Miller triple, Isan Diaz hit a fly ball to right that was dropped by Mississippi right fielder Tyler Neslony, and the error scored Miller to make it 4-0. Eric Jagielo added an RBI double to make it 5-0, then with two outs a balk by Franco scored O'Brien from third to put Jacksonville's lead at 6-0. After Neidert's first four innings were scoreless, the Braves struck for a pair of runs in the bottom of the fifth when pinch-hitter Luis Valenzuela hit a two-out two-run double to cut Jacksonville's lead to 6-2. The Jumbo Shrimp got a run back in the top of the sixth, as Harrison had a two-out infield RBI single to grow the lead to 7-2, which would be the final. In the top of the eighth, Neidert at the plate was hit by a fastball directly on his batting helmet and had to leave the game. Jose Pena turned in a scoreless bottom of the eighth, and Kyle Keller delivered a scoreless bottom of the ninth to preserve the 7-2 win.

## NEWS AND NOTES

**Blame it on the Rain:** Tonight's schedule is a bit odd at the Baseball Grounds due to last night's driving rain. Thursday's game that was scoreless in the bottom of the fifth is scheduled to be resumed at 5:05 p.m. Friday, June 29, with gates opening at 4:30 p.m. at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. The game will be completed to a full nine innings, followed by a seven-inning game, which will start no earlier than 7:05 p.m.

**Miller Shining at Double-A:** Marlins No. 10 prospect and 2017 first rounder Brian Miller has enjoyed an easy transition to Double-A so far. He's hit safely in the first six games of the last series against Mississippi, and Tuesday had his second multi-hit game for Jacksonville. Miller was a 2018 Florida State League Midseason All-Star with Jupiter, where in 62 games hit .324 with 29 runs batted in along with 13 doubles, three triples, and 19 stolen bases. At time of promotion ranked first in the Florida State League in hits (83), third in FSL in average (.324), second in at-bats (256), third in stolen bases (19). Miller was selected by the Marlins just last year in the 2017 draft, picked in the first round.

**Harrison Striking:** Monte Harrison carries a season-long nine-game hitting streak into tonight's game. Over his last nine games he is 12-for-35 (.343) with a home run and four runs batted in with three walks and eight runs scored. Harrison has hit safely in each of the six games against Mississippi, and Tuesday extended his streak to nine games with an RBI triple in the first inning. Harrison is in his first year at the Double-A level, and was honored by the Southern League as a Midseason All-Star for his strong first half. Harrison is regarded by MLB.com as Miami's No. 1 prospect for the 2018 season.

**Bring on the Biscuits:** Yeah Bring on the Biscuits. This is the second of three series between the clubs, with Jacksonville winning three of five games in its only trip to Montgomery in early May. The Biscuits will return to the Baseball Grounds from July 23-27. Last season the Jumbo Shrimp struggled against the Biscuits, going 2-8 against Montgomery overall, going 1-4 in series both in Montgomery and in Duval.

**Shrimp Have Prospects:** On the roster, the Jumbo Shrimp have seven players who were listed by *MLB.com* as Top 30 Miami Marlins prospects for the 2018 season: OF Monte Harrison (1), Isan Diaz (7), RHP Nick Neidert (8), OF Brian Miller (10), Merandy Gonzalez (13), Joe Dunand (16) and John Norwood (30).

# TONIGHT'S JUMBO SHRIMP STARTING PITCHER – SECOND GAME

**20 – CODY POTEET, RHP**

**2-8, 5.86 ERA, 14 games and 14 starts**

**2018:** 2-8, 5.86 ERA (46 ER/70.2 IP) in 14 G and 14 GS.  
**CAREER:** 9-26, 3.94 ERA (129 ER/294.2 IP) in 63 G and 60 GS.

**2018 vs. MTG:** 0-0, 6.75 ERA (4 ER/5.1 IP) in 3 G and 3 GS.  
**CAREER vs. MTG:** Same.

**LAST START:** Poteet suffered his second straight loss in his outing on Thursday June 21 at Mississippi to begin the second half against the Braves. Poteet worked three innings, allowing a season-high 10 runs on nine hits with three walks and three strikeouts, as Mississippi had a 10 run bottom of the third to fuel an 11-2 win to start the series.

**GENERALS LOSS:** Poteet suffered a loss in his start on Wednesday June 13 against the Jackson Generals at the Baseball Grounds. After a one hour, 48-minute rain delay, Poteet worked six innings where he allowed five runs (four earned) on seven hits with two walks and five strikeouts as Jacksonville lost 11-3.

**SHUCKERS START:** Poteet had a no decision in his start against the Biloxi Shuckers on Friday June 8 at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Poteet turned in five scoreless innings, allowing four hits with three walks and six strikeouts. Poteet left the game with Jacksonville leading 3-0, only to see the Shuckers come back and win 5-3.

**FIRST BISCUITS START:** Poteet had a no decision in his start on Tuesday May 15 against the Montgomery Biscuits at Riverwalk Stadium. Poteet worked five and a third innings where he allowed four runs (all earned) on seven hits with three walks and a strikeout. Poteet left the game in the sixth inning with Jacksonville trailing 4-1, only to see the Shrimp tie the game with three runs in the seventh, and win the game 5-4 thanks to an eighth inning home run by Cade Gotta.

**PROSPECT BUZZ:** Poteet had been regarded as Baseball America's No. 14 Marlins prospect entering the 2017 season, but fell out of the Top 30 rankings in the Marlins farm system for the 2018 season. Poteet had been Miami's No. 19 prospect entering 2016.

**#20 CODY POTEET RHP | 6-1, 180 lbs | Born: San Diego, Calif. Age: 23**

Selected by the Miami Marlins in the fourth round of the 2015 draft out of UCLA.

**2017 Highlights:** Poteet had success in 2017 with the High-A Jupiter Hammerheads. With Jupiter Poteet was a 2017 League Midseason All-Star and Marlins Organizational All-Star. Poteet with the Hammerheads was 2-3 with a 2.53 ERA in seven starts in the first half of the season, eventually going 3-7 with a 4.16 ERA in his 14 starts. Poteet was selected by the Marlins in the fourth round of the 2015 draft out of UCLA. In home games at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium, Poteet was 2-4 with a 3.30 ERA in eight appearances and six starts, while on the road Poteet was 1-3 with a 5.20 ERA in his eight starts away from Jupiter.

**2016 Highlights:** Poteet spent all of 2016 with the Single-A Greensboro Grasshoppers. With Greensboro he was 3-7 with a 4.16 ERA in 16 appearances and 14 starts. He was 3-5 with a 2.43 ERA in 13 starts in the first half of the year, while going 1-4 with a 3.48 ERA in 11 starts in the second half of the season.

**2015 Highlights:** After he was selected by the Marlins in the fourth round of the draft out of UCLA, Poteet spent time at rookie level Batavia in the New York-Penn League. With the Muckdogs he was 0-1 with a 2.13 ERA in five appearances and four starts.

**College:** Poteet was part of a strong pitching staff at UCLA that included Yankees first rounder James Kaprielian and closer David Berg, a second round pick by the Cubs in 2015. In 2015 Poteet was 7-1 with a 2.45 ERA in 27 appearances and 13 starts as he transitioned to being a mid-week starter for the Bruins. Honorable Mention Pac-12 All-Academic selection in 2015. Sunday starter in 2014, going 3-5 with a 4.46 ERA in 17 appearances and 15 starts. In 2013 as a freshman was a midweek starter, going 4-6 with a 4.84 ERA in 29 appearances and 11 starts. In summer of 2014 pitched in the Cape Cod League for the Yarmouth-Dennis Red Sox, going 4-0 with a 3.09 ERA in seven starts. In summer of 2013 pitched in the West Coast League for the Walla Walla Sweets, going 3-2 with a 3.78 ERA with 27 strikeouts in 38 innings pitched.

**Personal:** Three-year varsity baseball letterwinner at Christian High School (El Cajon, Calif.) under head coach Michael Mitchell...selected in the 27th round of the 2012 MLB Draft by the Washington Nationals. Batted .509 with 55 hits, 13 doubles, 20 stolen bases, 23 RBI and 45 runs as a junior in 2011, pitching 17.2 innings that season...broke school records with 55 hits and a .509 batting average in 2011...did not play for Christian in 2012, instead competing for club team ABD Bulldogs ... went 10-1 with a 2.10 ERA and 112 strikeouts in 66.2 innings pitched for the Bulldogs in 2012.
