SNAPPER SNIPPETS

STATE OF THE SNAPPERS: The Snappers are coming off a 4-game homestand where they took 3 of 4 vs. Wisconsin. Last night they clubbed the Timber Rattlers 15-2, the most runs scored by a Snappers team since May 12, 2013 when they lost 23-16 to Cedar Rapids.

TRENDS TO WATCH: Beloit has scored 5 runs or more in 21 games this season & are 18-3 when they hit that plateau. The Snappers have also won their last 16 games in which they have hit at least 1 home run & are 9-1 when they hit multiple dingers in the same game.

.500 DAYS OF SUMMER: The Snappers have danced between even & 2 games below the .500 mark for just over a month. Last night's win gave Beloit the same amount of wins & losses for the 10th time this season.

IT'S BEEN AWHILE: Luke Persico's 4-hit performance on Thursday was highlighted by a pair of doubles & 5 RBI. Persico's 5 RBI game is the first by a Snappers hitter since Argenis Raga did so on September 3, 2015. Additionally, Luis Barrera hit the first leadoff homer of year Thursday night. His lead-off blast is the first of it's kind for Beloit since he did so on August 16, 2016 at Burlington.

TWO FOR THE PRICE OF ONE: Beloit has turned 55 double plays on defense in 2017 with at least one in 8 of their last 9 games. That total is 8 more than 2nd-place Lansing with 47. The only team in Minor League Baseball with more double plays than the Snappers are the Athletics Double-A affiliate in Midland with 59 twin killers this season.

JUST GET ON BASE: With a walk & a single in yesterday's game, JaVon Shelby now matches Eric Martinez with an 18-game on-base streak. Nate Mondou has the team's longest on-base stretch this season at 20 games & the Midwest League's longest active streak is 21 games by Fernando Tatis Jr.

SAVING THE 'PEN: Seth Martinez earned the Snappers 10th save of the year by the 9th different pitcher by working 3 innings of scoreless relief on Thursday. 7 of Beloit's 10 saves on the year have been delivered through multiple innings of work. 4 of those 7 multi-inning saves saw pitchers work 3 or more innings.

TODAY'S PITCHERS: Beloit will use the tandem of Jesus Zambrano & Mitchell Jordan to open the series with Quad Cities. Zambrano's only start of the season was cut short due to a suspended game vs. Kane County that he only got one out before heavy rains halted play. Zambrano worked one game in relief at Quad Cities last season & gave up 2 runs in 2.0 IP. Jordan has shouldered losing decisions in his last 3 outings despite pitching well on May 9 & May 20 by allowing just 1 run in each showing.

FACING THE RIVER BANDITS: The Snappers will visit Quad Cities for a crucial series to jostle for position in the Western Division. Beloit was 2-5 in Davenport in 2016. The River Bandits carry 6 of the Astros top-30 prospects according to MLB.com with pitchers Forrest Whitley (#3) & Cionel Perez (#15) along with position players Daz Cameron (#6), Ronnie Dawson (#17), Stephen Wrenn (#24), & Yordan Alvarez (#26).
