What's Happening:

+ The Flying Squirrels dropped the final game of the series to the Altoona Curve, 3-0, last night at People's Natural Gas Field. In the final road game of the season, the Squirrels were held to just two hits and fell victim to 10 strikeouts. With the win, the Altoona Curve clinched a spot in the Western Division playoffs against Akron. The Squirrels enter the game tonight against Reading on an 18-inning scoreless streak having not scored a run since game one of the doubleheader on Saturday night. Richmond has scored runs in just one of their last 23 innings. The Squirrels return home for the final homestand of the season with four games against Reading and four against Harrisburg to close out the 2018 season starting tonight at 6:35 p.m.

Scouting The Fightin' Phils:

+ Reading returns to The Diamond for the third and final time this season for a four game series against The Squirrels. Richmond has had the Fightin' Phils number this season winning 10 of the 14 games between the two, including six of the seven games played at The Diamond. Reading enters the four game series with a 62-68 record and a 4-10 record against The Squirrels. Reading has hit to a team batting average of .254 against Richmond this season and have also pitched to a 4.34 ERA in 118.1 innings. The Double-A Affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies are currently in third place in the Eastern Division but are 11.0 games back from first place New Hampshire and 9.0 games back from second place Trenton.

How Ya Doin' Howard:

+ Squirrels middle infielder Ryan Howard has been one of the most consistent players for the Flying Squirrels this season. Howard leads the team in doubles (32), hits (108), and is second behind Dylan Davis with 50 RBI's. Howard's defense as the everyday shortstop has also been superb with a .950 fielding percentage with 124 putouts this season and has committed 17 errors in 337 total chances. Howard was named an Eastern League Mid-Season All-Star after hitting .283 in the first half with 22 doubles and 35 RBI's. The 23-year-old began the season ranked the #11 prospect in the Giants organization according to *Baseball America*. Howard was drafted by the Giants in the 5th round of the 2016 MLB June draft out of The University of Missouri. 2016 MLB June draft out of The University of Missouri.

Caleb Gindl Named EL Player of the Week

Flying Squirrels outfielder Claeb Gindl was named the Eastern League Player of the Week for the period of August 13-19. Gindl hit .524 with four doubles, six RBI's, and one home run in his last six games. Caleb has hit .311 in the month of August bringing his season batting average up to a team-leading .304. The lefty has 58 hits in 62 games played with 14 doubles, three home runs and 27 RBI's. Gindl was signed by the San Francisco Giants as a free agent on July 16, 2017. The 29-year-old has played 65 games in the big leagues with the Milwaukee Brewers between the 2013-14 season batting .232 with five home runs, seven doubles and 14 RBI's.

Welcome Back Ian Gardeck:

Right-handed pitcher Ian Gardeck made his Double-A debut for the Flying Squirrels Sunday afternoon at the age of 27. Prior to August 2018, the last game that the righty played in was on September 7, 2015 for the San Jose Giants. Over the next two seasons, Gardeck was sidelined with arm injuries and surgeries. Gardeck underwent three surgeries spanning 30 months of rehab time. Gardeck's first live game since 2015 was on July 22nd with the AZL Giants. So far in Double-A, the righty has allowed just two hits over 4.0 innings of relief with four strikeouts.

Mac Attack:

Squirrels reliever Dillon McNamara has been superb out of the bullpen for Richmond this year. After his outing in game two of the doubleheader against Altoona Saturday night, McNamara has not allowed an earned run since July 13th. The righty has a 18.1 inning scoreless streak spanning 11 appearances. McNamara tossed 1.0 scoreless innings to extend his scoreless streak on Saturday night against Altoona allowing just one hit while striking out two. McNamara was selected as an Eastern League Mid-Season All-Star this year and has pitched to a 4-2 record and a 1.27 ERA in 31 appearances and 42.2 innings so far with the Squirrels this year.

Today's Starter: Nolan Riggs

+ Right-hander Nolan Riggs will make his Double-A debut tonight for the Squirrels. Riggs has spent the majority of the season with San Jose (A+) where he has pitched to a 5-5 record and a 4.08 ERA in 41 games and 64.0 innings. Riggs has not made a start since September 5, 2015 while with Salem-Keizer (SS). The 6'9" right-hander has not thrown more than 3.1 innings in 2018. Riggs also made two appearances at Sacramento (AAA) this year where he allowed three earned runs in 5.2 innings of work. The 25-year-old was signed by the San Francisco Giants as an undrafted free agent on August 7, 2014 out of Sam Houston State University.

Today's Starter: Reading's Tyler Viza

+ Right-hander Tyler Viza will make his 10th start for Reading and his second start against Richmond. In his lone start against Richmond on July 29th, the righty tossed 6.0 innings allowing just one earned run on three hits with four strikeouts earning the win. Viza enters the contest with a 2-4 record and a 3.28 ERA. Viza has also made five appearances for Triple-A Lehigh Valley where he allowed five earned runs over 8.1 innings of work. The righty was drafted by the Philadelphia Phillies in the 32nd round of the 2013 MLB June draft out of Desert Vista High School.
