Last Game: The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (20-27) defeated the Mississippi Braves (20-27) by an 8-1 score in the first game of the five-game series that had been suspended due to rain on Wednesday and completed on Thursday evening, and then earned a 3-0 win in a seven-inning game that followed a one hour and 37-minute rain delay. Jacksonville had led 2-0 going to the top of the third before rain suspended the first game of the series on Wednesday. It was resumed starting at 5 p.m. central today and played to its full nine innings, with Jacksonville winning 8-1. Jumbo Shrimp right-handed relief pitcher Kolton Mahoney (3-3) earned the win with the first five innings of relief work, while Mississippi right-handed starter Kyle Wright (2-5) took the loss, allowing the two runs on Wednesday. Mahoney helped his own cause in the top of the fourth inning with an RBI groundout scoring Rodrigo Vigil to put Jacksonville ahead 3-0. Marlins No. 1 prospect Monte Harrison grew the lead with a 445-foot home run to deep left field in the top of the fifth to give Jacksonville a 4-0 after his team-leading sixth homer of the season. The M-Braves plated a run against Mahoney in the bottom of the sixth to put the score at 4-1. Jacksonville more than answered in the top of the seventh, as Eric Jagielo drove with the bases loaded delivered a bases-clearing 3 run double to put the lead at 7-1. The next batter John Norwood brought him home with an RBI double of his own that put the lead at 8-1, which would be the final score. After Mahoney's five innings, the Shrimp bullpen saw scoreless innings by Zech Lemond in the eighth and Jose Pena in the ninth to close out the game in a Jacksonville seven-run victory, the largest winning margin on the road for the Jumbo Shrimp this season. In between games the Jumbo Shrimp and Braves had to wait out a one-hour and 37-minute rain delay, but were finally able to play ball starting at 8:59 p.m. local time, with Jacksonville winning the seven-inning game 3-0. Jacksonville right-handed pitcher Pablo Lopez (1-2) earned his first Double-A victory by pitching six scoreless innings, allowing just five hits with no walks and five strikeouts, as he lowered his ERA to 0.24 (1 ER/37.2 IP). Mississippi right-handed starter Touki Toussaint (2-4) took the loss, going six innings where he allowed two runs on six hits with no walks and 10 strikeouts. Jacksonville left-handed reliever Jose Quijada earned his fourth save of the year by getting the final out in the bottom of the seventh. After the first three innings in the pitcher's duel, Jacksonville broke through in the top of the fourth thanks to an RBI single by Sharif Othman to go in front 1-0. Two innings later in the sixth Brian Schales added an RBI single to make it 2-0 off Toussaint. The Jumbo Shrimp then added an RBI double by Kyle Barrett in the top of the seventh off Braves relief pitcher Jacob Webb to lead 3-0, which would be the final score. After Lopez was dominant in his six innings, Marcus Crescentini took over for the bottom of the seventh. Despite two strikeouts, he walked three batters to load the bases. Quijada came in and in a lefty-lefty matchup struck out Luis Valenzuela looking to end the game in a 3-0 Jacksonville win.

NEWS AND NOTES

Gotta Southern League Player of the Week: Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp outfielder Cade Gotta has been named the Southern League Player of the Week for May 14-20, announced by the league office on Monday morning. Gotta over the past week hit .423 (11-for-26) with eight extra-base hits, five runs batted in, four doubles, three triples (in three consecutive games from May 14-16), a home run, three walks, and seven runs scored. Over the past week, Gotta led the league in extra-base hits (8), total bases (24), triples (3), slugging percentage (.923), on-base plus slugging percentage (1.406), and was tied for the league lead in doubles (4). Gotta enjoyed a dominant series against his former club the Montgomery Biscuits from May 12-16, where he had hits in every game and hit .474 (9-for-19) with a home run, two runs batted in, and three consecutive games with triples.

Nine Innings Would Be Nice: Essentially the last eight games for the Jumbo Shrimp have not been nine inning baseball games. The only game of the BayBears series that was a nine-inning contest was on Thursday May 17 when the Jumbo Shrimp won 7-3, then Friday brought a doubleheader of two seven-inning games. The Jumbo Shrimp and BayBears remained tied through the ninth on Saturday, with Mobile eventually winning 6-5 in 12 innings. Then Monday brought another doubleheader, with the Shrimp and BayBears earning a doubleheader split. Wednesday's game was spread over two days with the suspended game finished last night, and then the seven inning game that followed the one hour 37 minute rain delay.

Going to Braves Country: This is the first of four series this season and the only one in the first half of the year between the Jumbo Shrimp and the Mississippi Braves. Jacksonville will make a return trip to Trustmark Park to begin the second half from June 21-26, and the Braves will visit Jacksonville from August 8-12 as well as the final series of the year from August 30 to September 3. Last season the Jumbo Shrimp posted a winning 12-8 record against the Braves, going 5-5 in 10 games at Trustmark Park, then going 7-3 against the Braves in Jacksonville.

Shrimp Have Prospects: On the roster, the Jumbo Shrimp have five players who were listed by *MLB.com* as Top 30 Miami Marlins prospects for the 2018 season: OF Monte Harrison (1), Isan Diaz (7), RHP Nick Neidert (8), RHP Pablo Lopez (21), and John Norwood (30). Four of these five prospects were acquired by the Marlins in trades within the past 12 months.

LAST START: Dugger had a no decision in his Double-A debut on Saturday May 19 against the Mobile BayBears at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. Dugger turned in four and a third innings where he allowed three runs (one earned) on four hits with five walks and two strikeouts. He left the game with Jacksonville trailing 3-0, only to see the Shrimp rally to a 3-3 score before Mobile won the 12-inning game 6-5.

2018 WITH JUPITER: Dugger started the 2018 season in the High-A Jupiter Hammerheads starting rotation. With Jupiter, Dugger was 3-1 with a 2.40 ERA in seven starts, striking out 34 batters compared to seven walks in 41 and a third innings of work. In April, Dugger was 2-1 with a 3.14 ERA in his five starts. In May, Dugger was 1-0 with a 0.71 ERA in his two outings. At the time of his promotion to Jacksonville on May 18, Dugger was seventh in the league with a 2.40 ERA, and had the fifth-lowest walk per nine inning ratio at 1.52 among starting pitchers.

ACQUIRED BY THE MARLINS: Dugger was acquired by the Marlins from the Seattle Mariners along with right-handed pitcher and Jacksonville rotation mate Nick Neidert, infielder Chris Torres and future considerations in exchange for infielder/outfielder Dee Gordon on December 7, 2017. Dugger was originally selected by the Mariners in 18th round of the 2016 draft out of Texas Tech.

PROSPECT: While Dugger is not regarded as a Top 30 Marlins prospect according to MLB.com, he does appear in Baseball America's Top 30 Marlins prospect rankings entering 2018, checking in as Miami's No. 23 prospect.

From Mariners with RHP Nick Neidert, INF Chris Torres and future considerations in exchange for IF/OF Dee Gordon on Dec. 7, 2017.

2018 Highlights: In Dugger started the 2018 season in the High-A Jupiter Hammerheads starting rotation. With Jupiter, Dugger was 3-1 with a 2.40 ERA in seven starts, striking out 34 batters compared to seven walks in 41 and a third innings of work. In April, Dugger was 2-1 with a 3.14 ERA in his five starts. In May, Dugger was 1-0 with a 0.71 ERA in his two outings. At the time of his promotion to Jacksonville on May 18, Dugger was seventh in the league with a 2.40 ERA, and had the fifth-lowest walk per nine inning ratio at 1.52 among starting pitchers.

2017 Highlights: Split the season between Single-A Clinton in the Midwest League and High-A Modesto in the California League. With the Clinton Lumberkings, Dugger was 4-1 with a 2.00 ERA in 22 appearances and nine starts. As a starter, went 3-0 with a 1.18 ERA in nine starts after starting the season in the bullpen. With Clinton, he was honored as a 2017 Midwest League Midseason All-Star. Finished the season with the Modesto Nuts, going 2-5 with a 3.94 ERA in nine starts.

2016 Highlights: After he was selected by the Mariners in the 18th round of the 2016 draft out of Texas Tech, Dugger spent time at three different levels of the Mariners system. He started with the AZL Mariners where he made four appearances in relief, with no wins or losses and a 1.04 ERA. In late July he was sent to Triple-A Tacoma, where he worked two games in relief, with no wins or losses and a 6.75 ERA. He finished the season with the Everett AquaSox in the Short Season Class A Northwest League, where he was 2-1 with a 5.47 ERA in six starts.

College: Spent the 2016 season at Texas Tech, where he was 6-1 with a 2.67 ERA in 30 relief appearances with three saves. Struck out 54 batters in 60 and two-third innings of work. Dugger spent the 2015 and 2014 seasons at Cisco Junior College. In 2015, finished 3-2 overall with a 4.37 ERA ... struck out 55 hitters while issuing just 18 walks over 70.0 complete innings. In 2014 he was one of Cisco's top starting pitchers ... appeared in 12 games, finishing 5-5 overall with a 5.40 ERA ... led the team with 63.1 innings pitched ... tossed three complete games which ranked second on the team.

Personal: Helped lead Tomball High School to the Texas Class 4A state title as a senior ... played under head coach Doug Rush ... Tomball closed the 2013 season with an impressive 35-4 overall record ... marked the first state championship for any team sport in Tomball history ... team also finished the year ranked among the top 10 programs in the country ... was a first team All-District honoree as a senior ... first team All-State selection by the Texas Sports Writers Association ... also honored on the All-Houston area team and the All-State Tournament team ... recognized for work in the classroom as an academic All-State honoree ... member of the school's National Honors Society. Son of Ronnie and Anna Dugger ... has a younger brother, Cody ... mother is a teacher and University of Arizona graduate ... father works for Centerpoint Energy ... kinesiology major with a minor in nutrition ... hopes to one day become a physical therapist or nutritionist.
