**Last Game:** Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp right-hander Nick Neidert held the Birmingham Barons to one run in seven innings to earn his team-high sixth win, and center fielder Monte Harrison drove in a season-high four runs with a pair of two-out, two-run singles in a 9-2 win in the second game of a five-game series at Regions Field Monday night. The Jumbo Shrimp (23-32) took the lead in the top of the second inning against Orange Park native and Birmingham right-hander Dane Dunning (3-2). Right fielder John Norwood hit a leadoff double to left field, went to third base on first baseman Eric Jagielo's flyout and scored on Dunning's wild pitch. The Barons (26-30) tied the game in the bottom of the inning against Neidert (5-3). Designated hitter Seby Zavala hit a leadoff single to center field and went to second base on a groundout. Right fielder Jameson Fisher put down a bunt single, and second baseman Bryant Flete brought in Zavala on an RBI fielder's choice. Neidert yielded three hits and four walks with eight strikeouts in seven innings, before right-hander Jose Pena allowed one run in the final two innings. Jacksonville broke the 1-1 tie in the top of the fourth inning. Second baseman Isan Diaz hit a leadoff single and stole second base. Jagielo hit a one-out RBI double to left-center field and scored when third baseman Brian Schales hit a two-out single to right field. In the fifth inning, Dunning walked left fielder Cade Gotta, who stole second base, went to third base on Harrison's groundout and scored on Isan Diaz's RBI single to right field for a 4-1 Jacksonville lead. Dunning allowed four earned runs on five hits and two walks with eight strikeouts in five innings, but the Barons bullpen allowed five unearned runs against the Barons bullpen. In the sixth inning against left-hander Colton Turner, two walks and an error set preceded Harrison's two-run single to center field. In the eighth inning, a walk, error and wild pitch set the stage for Harrison's two-run single to right field, and Isan Diaz's RBI double to left field – his third hit – to make it 9-1.

## NEWS AND NOTES

**I See You, Isan:** Jacksonville second baseman Isan Diaz has loved this trip to Birmingham. Diaz has posted back-to-back three hit performances for the Jumbo Shrimp, and is 6-for-last-8 in the series. Yesterday he sparked Jacksonville to a 2-1 win, scoring the two runs of the game after he hit doubles in the sixth and eighth innings. Diaz has risen his batting average to .220, and is hitting .324 (11-for-34) over his last ten games for the Jumbo Shrimp with a home run and four runs batted in. Diaz is regarded as Miami's No. 7 prospect according to MLB.com.

**Give the Ball to Mahoney:** Today marks a spot start for Jumbo Shrimp starter Kolton Mahoney, but it's alright, he's shined in this spot for Jacksonville so far this season. This marks Mahoney's fifth start of the season, and he has only allowed one earned run in 18 innings of work in his starts, good for a 0.50 ERA as a starter in 2018. Mahoney is coming off a sparkling month of May, where he was 2-1 with a 0.95 ERA in five appearances and two starts. Mahoney turned in four scoreless innings of work, scattering three hits with no walks and six strikeouts in his last start on Friday June 1 against the Pensacola Blue Wahoos after a three-hour and 47-minute rain delay, in what turned out to be the only game played that night between Jacksonville and Pensacola due to the late start.

**Roster Moves:** Right-handed starting pitcher Pablo Lopez has been transferred from Jacksonville to Triple-A New Orleans. Lopez was 1-2 with a 0.62 ERA (3 ER in 42.1 innings) in his eight starts for the Jumbo Shrimp, with 51 strikeouts compared to only eight walks. In a corresponding move, infielder Luis Pintor has been transferred from Marlins extended spring training to Jacksonville. Pintor in two previous stints for the Jumbo Shrimp hit .083 (1-for-12) with a run batted in.

**Among the Leaders:** The Jumbo Shrimp can be found all over Southern League stat packs among lead leaders. Monte Harrison leads the league in runs scored (40), leads the league in strikeouts (90), is second in the league in games played (56), fifth in at-bats (212), and Cade Gotta is tied for second in stolen bases (12). The pitching staff also leads the league in ERA, at 3.51. Marcus Crescentini is second in the league in games finished (18), Nick Neidert is fifth in the league in strikeouts (68), and Max Duval is second in home runs allowed (11).

**It's Nice to Have You in Birmingham:** This is the first of two series between the Shrimp and Birmingham Barons, and this series marks Jacksonville's only trip to Regions Field in 2018. The Barons will make one appearance at the Baseball Grounds from August 19-23, so there will only be two series between the clubs this year as opposed to three last season. A year ago, the Shrimp lost their series in Birmingham, going 2-3 at Regions Field. The Jumbo Shrimp made up for it at the Baseball Grounds last August, going 9-1 against the Barons in Jacksonville, including a rare six-game sweep from August 21-25.

**Shrimp Have Prospects:** On the roster, the Jumbo Shrimp have five players who were listed by *MLB.com* as Top 30 Miami Marlins prospects for the 2018 season: OF Monte Harrison (1), Isan Diaz (7), RHP Nick Neidert (8), RHP Pablo Lopez (21), and John Norwood (30).

# TONIGHT'S JUMBO SHRIMP STARTING PITCHER

**21 – KOLTON MAHONEY, RHP**

**3-3, 1.19 ERA, 12 games and 4 starts**

**2018:** 3-3, 1.19 ERA (5 ER/37.2 IP) in 12 G and 4 GS.  
**CAREER:** 16-16, 2.83 ERA (80 ER/254.1 IP) in 64 G and 34 GS.

**LAST START:** Mahoney had a no decision in his start on Friday June 1 against the Pensacola Blue Wahoos in Game One of a scheduled doubleheader at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville. After a three-hour, 47-minute rain delay, Mahoney turned in four scoreless innings of work, scattering three hits with no walks and six strikeouts. Brett Graves on his rehab assignment from the Marlins worked the next three innings as they combined for the 4-0 shutout win in what turned out to be the only game played that night due to the late start.

**CALL ON ME:** This marks Mahoney's fifth start of the season, and he has only allowed one earned run in 18 innings of work in his starts, good for a 0.50 ERA as a starter in 2018. His work out of Jacksonville's bullpen has also been excellent, going 3-2 with a 1.83 ERA with one save.

**STARTING IN 2018:** He started Game Two of Jacksonville's first doubleheader on Wednesday April 18 at Chattanooga, working four scoreless innings where he allowed five hits with no walks and three strikeouts as Jacksonville lost 3-2. Mahoney made his second spot start on Wednesday May 9 in Jacksonville against the Tennessee Smokies, filling in for Elieser Hernandez who left his major league rehab assignment early to join the Marlins in Miami. Mahoney proceeded to work five innings allowing one run (unearned) on four hits with no walks and a strikeout as Jacksonville lost 3-2 in 10 innings. In his start in Game Two of Jacksonville's doubleheader with Mobile on Friday May 18, working five innings where he allowed two runs (one earned) on six hits with a walk and a strikeout as Jacksonville lost 3-1. Then he worked four scoreless innings last time out on June 1 against Pensacola.

**STARTING EXPERIENCE:** Mahoney is a prime candidate for the rotation and this spot start, with 31 career starts under his belt. Last year pitching for Single-A Greensboro, he went 4-5 with a 4.76 ERA as a starter in 13 starts for the Grasshoppers.

**#21 KOLTON MAHONEY RHP | 6-1, 195 lbs | Born: Ogden, Utah. Age: 25**

Signed by the Miami Marlins as a minor league free agent on May 30, 2017

**2017 Highlights:** Mahoney started the 2017 season still a member of the New York Yankees organization. After going 1-2 with a 1.85 ERA in 11 games, collecting one save, and striking out 26 batters in 24 and a third innings with Single-A Charleston, he was released by the Yankees on May 27. The Marlins signed him three days later on May 30, and he finished the season with Single-A Greensboro, also in the South Atlantic League. With the Grasshoppers, Mahoney went 5-5 with a 4.08 ERA in 18 games pitched and 13 starts, striking out 74 batters in 79 and a third innings of work.

**2016 Highlights:** With the New York-Penn League's Staten Island Yankees, Mahoney went 4-4 with a 2.92 ERA in 12 appearances and eight starts.

**2015 Highlights:** Selected by the New York Yankees in the 16<sup>th</sup> round of the 2015 draft out of Brigham Young University. With the New York-Penn League's Staten Island Yankees, Mahoney went 3-2 with a 2.29 ERA in 12 appearances and 10 starts, with 50 strikeouts in 55 innings of work.

**College:** Prior to being drafted in 2015, he went 4-8 in 13 starts this season for the Cougars, striking out 91 and earning a 5.27 ERA in 85 1/3 innings pitched. In summer 2014, pitched for Orleans (Massachusetts) Firebirds in the Cape Cod League. He finished his stint there with six starts, a 3-2 record, one save, a team-high 47 strikeouts and a 1.97 ERA in regular-season play. Three times, he had double-digit strikeouts for Orleans, including 13 in a playoff victory. After his junior season with BYU, Mahoney was selected by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 23<sup>rd</sup> round in 2014 but did not sign.

**Personal:** Served a mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints to Santa Rosa, Calif. Also was selected by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 23<sup>rd</sup> round of 2014 draft. Started for Northridge High ... honorable mention all-state in 2010 ... played in the 5A all-star game ... selected to Deseret News All-Area team ... recorded 77 strikeouts in nine starts ... threw a no hitter in 2009 against Clearfield.
