Tonight's Game... The San Jose Giants begin a five-game series against the Visalia Rawhide this evening at Recreation Park. Logan Webb (1-2, 2.11 ERA) is slated to make the start on the mound for the Giants tonight. San Jose is 7-7 against Visalia this season. This evening is the first of 15 meetings between the Giants and Rawhide in the second half.

Rare Five-Game Series... The current match-up in Visalia marks San Jose's first five-game regular season series since 2007 (at Modesto). Following the current five-game set, the Giants will host Rancho Cucamonga in a five-game series at Municipal Stadium beginning on Wednesday, July 4.

June Swoon... San Jose's 8-16 record in June is tied for the worst mark in the California League this month (Modesto). The Giants' 4.66 team ERA in June is also second-to-last in the league (Inland Empire 4.73). San Jose's lone series victory this month came when they took two out of three games at Modesto from June 8-10. A win tonight would give the Giants back-to-back victories for only the second time this month. San Jose hasn't won three straight games since May 9-11.

Rec Park Series Win Drought... The Giants haven't won a series at Visalia's Recreation Park since the opening weekend of the 2013 season (won three of four games April 4-7, 2013). Since that series victory, San Jose is 18-44 (.290) at Rec Park during the regular season with 12 series losses and four series splits. The Giants dropped two of three games to the Rawhide from April 16-18 in their only previous visit to Visalia this season. San Jose will play three series' at Recreation Park in the second half (June 29-July 3, July 31-August 2, August 21-23).

Tough Schedule... San Jose's first 29 games of the second half (June 21-July 20) will be played against the only three teams in the California League currently with winning overall records (Rancho Cucamonga 12 games, Visalia 9 games, Stockton 8 games). The Giants are 3-5 in the second half having dropped three of four games at Rancho Cucamonga to open the half before splitting four games with visiting Stockton.

League Leaderboard... Several Giants hitters rank among the California League leaders. Jalen Miller is second in hits (87), second in runs scored (47) and tied for sixth in doubles (19). Gio Brusa is tied for sixth in the league in home runs (11) and sixth in slugging (.496). Wander Franco is tied for second in doubles (24) and fifth in hits (84) while Johneshwy Fargas is tied for fourth in stolen bases (21).

Heath Quinn... Since returning from the disabled list on June 10 (hamstring), Heath Quinn is batting .391 (18-for-46) with four home runs in 12 games played. Quinn has hit safely in 18 out of his last 20 games and is batting .338 overall this season (40 games) – a 110-point improvement from his .228 mark with the San Jose Giants last year (75 games). Quinn has also homered in back-to-back games. San Jose has not had a player homer in three straight games this season.

Road Woes... The Giants enter tonight's contest having lost 11 out of their last 15 road games. San Jose is 17-22 on the road this season – the second-lowest road winning percentage in the league (Modesto 16-23).

Score First... San Jose is 26-13 (.667) when they score first in a game compared to 11-28 (.282) when their opponent scores first.

* Named a midseason California League All-Star.

* Scheduled to make his 15th start and 16th overall appearance of the season in this evening's game ... Has pitched 47 innings this year and allowed just 11 earned runs (2.11 ERA) ... Has yet to pitch more than four innings in an outing ... Has pitched past the third inning only four times in 14 starts.

* Has not allowed an earned run in 10 out of his 14 starts.

* Most recent start came on June 24 at Rancho Cucamonga ... Tossed a season-high tying four innings with no runs and two hits allowed ... Walked one and struck out a career-high seven ... Threw 53 pitches ... Previous season-high in strikeouts was four.

* Had a stretch of five consecutive starts spanning 17 innings from May 13 to June 3 with no runs allowed ... Is the longest scoreless inning streak by a Giants pitcher this season.

* Will be making his third start and fourth appearance against Visalia ... Has pitched 11 innings against the Rawhide this season with only five hits and two unearned runs allowed (5 BB, 9 SO) ... Has limited Visalia hitters to a .143 batting average ... Most recent start versus the Rawhide came on May 29 at Municipal Stadium (4 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 3 SO).

* Has thrown 17 innings at home this season and allowed just seven hits and one unearned run (five starts).

* Owns a .226 opponents batting average (.224 vs. right, .229 vs. left) ... Has limited the opposition to a .095 batting average with runners in scoring position and two outs (2-for-21) ... Has given up just one home run in 47 innings.

* Prior to this season, hadn't made a start since May 31, 2016 (with Class-A Augusta).

* Spent the entire 2017 season pitching out of the bullpen for Salem-Keizer (Short-Season) ... Made 15 relief appearances for the Volcanoes and was 2-0 with a 2.89 ERA ... Struck out 31 and walked seven over 28 innings ... Made his 2017 season debut on June 15 – over 12 months since his last game action.

* Pitched for Augusta (A) in 2016 before undergoing season-ending Tommy John surgery on his right elbow in June ... Was 2-3 with a 6.21 ERA in nine starts for the GreenJackets ... Worked as a starting pitcher for Salem-Keizer in 2015 (14 GS, 3-6, 4.92 ERA) ... Began his professional career with the AZL Giants (Rookie) in 2014.

* Drafted by the SF Giants out of Rocklin High School (Rocklin, CA) ... Posted a 0.49 ERA over 57 2/3 innings as a senior in 2014 to earn Sierra Foothill League MVP honors ... Was also a quarterback on the football team in three varsity seasons.

* Had committed to play college baseball at Cal Poly prior to signing with the Giants.
