Saturday Recap: Pantoja's home run lifts RubberDucks past

SeaWolves (Akron 3, Erie 2): RubberDucks second baseman **Alexis Pantoja** hit a go-ahead home run to left field leading off the top of the ninth inning to lift his team to a 3-2 win over the SeaWolves at UPMC Park on Saturday night. It was Pantoja's second home run of the season and first since a solo home run June 1 in Game 1 of a doubleheader in Erie, which was also Akron's last win against the SeaWolves until Saturday night. Akron's only other two ninth-inning home runs this season have come in Erie (**Alex Call** on May 31 and **Trenton Brooks** on Friday, which both were the only single runs in losses). **Jake Paulson** (11-7) won for the second straight appearance and improved to 5-0 in his last six games (three starts, three relief outings), and his 11 wins are tied for second in the league. Akron improved to 11-25 in one-run games and snapped an eight-game losing streak to Erie (longest against any opponent this season) and set up the RubberDucks' fifth straight series rubber match on Sunday. They won the first two (vs. Binghamton, at New Hampshire) and lost the last two (at Portland, vs. Trenton). Overall, they are 5-6 in rubber matches this season (3-4 on the road and 0-2 in Erie).

Since the All-Star break: Since the Eastern League All-Star break, Akron is 15-20, but a few RubberDucks have posted number among the league leaders since the break. **Trenton Brooks** has a league-leading 22 extra-base hits, 15 doubles (second in the league), 69 total bases (third), a .556 slugging percentage (third) and .899 OPS (fourth). **Nolan Jones**, called up to Double-A for the first time during the break, has 20 walks (tied for second) and 26 runs (tied for second). **Connor Marabell** has 37 hits (tied for ninth) and a .306 average (ninth). **Ernie Clement** has eight stolen bases (tied for sixth). **Jake Paulson** has five wins (tied for the lead), and **Dalbert Siri** has six saves (tied for sixth) in 13 appearances (tied for fifth).

Gonzalez warms up to the EL: Outfielder **Oscar Gonzalez**, who was promoted to Akron on Aug. 1, has hit safely in eight of his last 10 games, including a six-game hitting streak Aug. 6-13 (8-for-22, three doubles, a home run, five runs and five RBI) after going hitless in his first three Eastern League games (0-for-10). The Carolina League All-Star left Lynchburg with a league-best .319 average, 123 hits and 175 total bases. He had eight home runs, 61 RBI (fourth), 33 extra-base hits (sixth), .455 SLG (fifth) and .797 OPS (second).

Clement's strong return: Since returning from the Injured List May 9, shortstop **Ernie Clement** has 91 hits (tied for sixth in the Eastern League), although before Saturday, for the first time in that 81-game stretch, he was hitless in three straight games and five of six. Since May 9, he is 91-for-324 (.281, seventh in EL). That includes 26 multi-hit games, 11 doubles, three triples, a home run (at Erie in his first game back), 40 runs, 21 RBI, 21 walks, a .329 OBP, and separate 13- and 14-game hitting streaks. He was on the IL with a right adductor strain April 16-May 8. In six games prior to going on the IL, the Indians No. 18 (*Baseball America*)/No. 26 (MLB.com) prospect was 3-for-25 (.120).

Ducks visit SeaWolves: After 26 straight games against the Eastern Division following their most recent trip to Erie July 15-17, the RubberDucks are playing the fifth of six scheduled series this season with the SeaWolves, with seven games at Canal Park (including the last four of the season) and 12 at UPMC Park (Akron's closest trip – 125 miles – and most frequent road opponent). Last season, Akron went 11-8 against Erie, including 7-3 at UPMC Park. Erie finished fifth in the Western Division, at 63-77, last season. Since 2005, Akron is 156-161 against Erie, which has won the first four series, and 11 of the first 14 meetings this season (eight of 11 in Erie). Picking up the pace: The RubberDucks have won 13 of their last 23 games and three of their last six series. In that span, they have scored 95 runs (4.13/game) and allowed 72 (3.13/game), for a +23 differential.

Jones arrives in Double-A: Third baseman **Nolan Jones**, ranked by MLB.com as the Indians' No. 1 prospect (July 2019) and No. 2 by *Baseball America* (entering 2019), made his Double-A debut on July 11, becoming the highest-ranked Indians prospect to appear for Akron this season. A 2019 Carolina League Mid-Season All-Star with Class-A Advanced Lynchburg, Jones led the league in walks (65), on-base percentage (.435) and OPS (.860) at the time of his promotion to Akron. He also led Lynchburg with 48 runs. He played 77 games and hit .286 with seven home runs, 41 RBI, and a .456 slugging percentage. He also played in the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Progressive Field on July 7, starting at third base and grounding out to the pitcher in his only at bat.

Flying out of the park: The RubberDucks have hit nine home runs over the past eight games after hitting just three in the previous 20 games. In the past 28 games, Akron has 12 home runs while allowing 26. Overall, the RubberDucks have 94 home runs (fourth in the Eastern League) while allowing 87 (sixth most in the EL) for a +7 home run differential. In 65 road games, the RubberDucks have hit a league-leading 60 home runs, while allowing 46, tied for fourth most (+14 differential). Of the RubberDucks' 94 home runs this season, 57 (61 percent) have come in 21 multi-homer games, including 13 in four straight games May 9-13. Akron's six home runs on May 11 in Reading were its most since hitting seven on July 2, 2008, in a 10-6 win at Erie. Akron allowed six home runs to Binghamton on July 20, marking its most allowed since May 29, 2009, when Erie hit six in an 11-8 win over the Aeros. The last season Akron led the Eastern League in home runs was 2005, when the Aeros hit 151, led by **Jonathan Van Every's** 27 (tied for second in the league).

LAST OUTING (Sunday, Aug. 11, at Portland, L in 3-2 loss): Scott pitched at least five innings for a 10th straight start since joining Akron. In the second inning, he allowed Luke Tendler's one-out single and stolen base, but his errant pickoff throw into center field scored Tendler for a 1-0 Portland lead. Marcus Wilson hit a fourth-inning leadoff homer. With a 2-2 tie in the sixth inning, Jarren Duran reached on a ground ball to third base, stole second base and scored on C.J. Chatham's RBI double. Right-handers Henry Martinez (2.2 IP) and Dalbert Siri (1.0 IP) pitched scoreless relief, but Portland won, 3-2.

Season Highlights

- Pitched 19.1 consecutive scoreless innings June 20-July 5, including three straight starts. Akron's longest this season is 21.2 innings (Zach Plesac).
- Began the season with Lynchburg (A-Adv), making 12 starts. Ranked third in the Carolina League with 74 strikeouts at the time of his promotion.

- Began his professional career on June 18 and made four relief appearances for the AZL Indians (rookie).
- Promoted on July 2 to Mahoning Valley (SS-A) and made five relief appearances for the Scrappers.
- Promoted on Aug. 2 to Lake County (A) and made five relief appearances for the Captains.

2019 RUBBERDUCKS FIELD STAFF

#24 Rouglas Odor, Manager (First Season) – Odor, 51, is the 18th manager in club history. He follows Tony Mansolino, who was promoted to Triple-A Columbus after guiding Akron to a 78-62 record and finish as runner-up in the 2018 Eastern League Championship Series against the New Hampshire Fisher Cats. Last season, Odor managed the Class-A Advanced Lynchburg Hillcats to their fourth consecutive postseason. After posting the Carolina League's worst first-half record of 29-38, the Hillcats rebounded to go 42-28 in the second half, claiming the Northern Division title. They fell to Potomac in the semifinals, three games to two. Odor has a 361-363 (.499) career managing record in 11 seasons.

When Odor was the RubberDucks hitting coach in 2014, he became the first person to wear the uniforms of the Canton-Akron Indians, Akron Aeros, and Akron RubberDucks. He played 197 games for Canton-Akron during the 1991, 1993-94 seasons, and he was the hitting coach for the Aeros' 2012 Eastern League Championship squad.

The 2019 season is Odor's 32nd in the Cleveland organization as a player or coach (19th as a coach). The former shortstop was a 32nd-round draft pick by the Indians in 1988 and played in the minor leagues for the Indians from 1988-94 and for the Milwaukee Brewers organization in 1995. Last season was Odor's first as a manager since 2008. He managed San Felipe in the Venezuelan Summer League for two seasons in 1999-2000, the Burlington Indians for four seasons from 2001-04, the Mahoning Valley Scrappers for two seasons in 2005-06, and the Gulf Coast League Indians for two seasons in 2007-08. Since then, Odor has moved up the ranks as a hitting coach, starting with Class-A Kinston in 2009-10, Akron in 2011-12 and 2014, the High-A Carolina Mudcats in 2013, and Triple-A Columbus in 2015-17.

The Maracaibo, Venezuela, native resides in Winter Haven, Florida, with his wife, Milagros. He has three sons and is the uncle of Texas Rangers infielder Rougheed Odor.

#27 Tony Arnold, Pitching Coach (10th Season, not consecutive) — Arnold, 60, rejoins the RubberDucks for his fifth time in Akron after spending last season with Lynchburg. In 2018, the Hillcats pitching staff finished fifth in the Carolina League with a 3.76 ERA, ranked second with 1,190 strikeouts and the 12 team shutouts ranked fourth. Arnold last was with the RubberDucks in 2016-17, helping lead the 2016 team to an Eastern League championship. He previously served in the same capacity in Akron from 1996-99, 2008, and 2011-12. Arnold's 2012 Akron Aeros staff crafted a franchise-record 3.03 ERA and went on to claim the EL championship. In 2016, Arnold became the second man to wear the uniforms of the Canton-Akron Indians, Akron Aeros and Akron RubberDucks, joining Rouglas Odor in that exclusive group.

In 2015, Arnold began as the pitching coach at Lynchburg and finished at Triple-A Columbus, helping the Clippers to the International League title. A former All-American at the University of Texas, Arnold pitched in the major leagues with the Baltimore Orioles in 1986 and 1987.
