Last Game: Birmingham Barons first baseman Keon Barnum and left fielder Nick Basto hit consecutive second-inning home runs to build a 3-0 lead on the way to a 5-2 win to snap the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp's three-game winning streak in the finale of a five-game series at Regions Field Thursday night. The Barons (27-32) took the lead in the second inning against Jacksonville right-hander Robert Dugger (0-1). Center fielder Ryan Brett hit a one-out single to left field, before Barnum homered to right field, and Basto homered to left field. All-Star center fielder Monte Harrison put the Jumbo Shrimp (25-33) on the board with a third-inning, one-out home run to left field off Birmingham right-hander Connor Walsh, cutting the deficit to 3-1. Walsh completed three innings, allowing an earned run on four hits and one walk with six strikeouts. Right-hander Jake Johansen (1-1) followed Walsh with shutout fourth and fifth innings, and right-hander Cameron Seitzer pitched a scoreless sixth inning. With the Barons leading, 3-1, in the bottom of the third inning against Dugger, Barons All-Star catcher Seby Zavala hit a one-out single, went to third base on third baseman Trey Michalczewski's double to right field and scored on Brett's infield RBI single. In the bottom of the fourth inning, Barons All-Star shortstop Danny Mendick singled to right field, and second baseman Bryant Flete hit an RBI triple to right field to make it 5-1. After that, Dugger only allowed one more hit, and he completed six innings, allowing five earned runs on 11 hits and one walk with a season-high eight strikeouts. Left-hander Ben Holmes pitched scoreless seventh and eighth innings for the Jumbo Shrimp in his Southern League debut. Jacksonville's second run came on first baseman Peter O'Brien's eighth-inning solo home run to left field off Barons right-hander Brandon Brennan. All-Star right-hander Ian Hamilton pitched a scoreless ninth inning for his 10th save.

NEWS AND NOTES

I See You, Isan: Jacksonville second baseman Isan Diaz loved his trip to Birmingham. Diaz hit safely in the last four games of the series against the Barons, going 9-for-15 (.600) with four runs batted in during those games with three runs scored. Tuesday he sparked Jacksonville to a 2-1 win, scoring the two runs of the game after he hit doubles in the sixth and eighth innings. Diaz has risen his batting average to .229, and is hitting .333 (12-for-36) over his last ten games for the Jumbo Shrimp with a home run and six runs batted in. Diaz is regarded as Miami's No. 7 prospect according to MLB.com.

Six Shrimp All-Stars: The Southern League announced that six Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp players have been named to the league's South Division All-Star roster for the 2018 Southern League All-Star Game on Tuesday, June 19, at Regions Field in Birmingham, Alabama. Right-handed pitchers Nick Neidert and Pablo Lopez, left-handed pitcher Jose Quijada, catcher Rodrigo Vigil, designated hitter Eric Jagielo, and outfielder Monte Harrison will represent Jacksonville as South Division All-Stars.

The Shuckers are Here: Tonight's game begins the second of four series this season between Jacksonville and Biloxi. Earlier this season, the Jumbo Shrimp were swept by the Shuckers in early May at MGM Park in Biloxi. The next two meetings will be in Jacksonville from June 8-12 and in the second half from July 12-16. The Jumbo Shrimp will not make a return trip to Biloxi until August 6-12. Last season the Jumbo Shrimp and Shuckers played five series, with Jacksonville going 9-15 in those games. That included a 6-9 record in Biloxi, and the Shrimp were 3-6 against the Shuckers in Jacksonville. The Jumbo Shrimp did win their last series here in late August, including a key doubleheader sweep on August 30 that shrunk Jacksonville's magic number to clinch the second half South Division title from five to one, and the Shrimp clinched a playoff berth the next day with a win at home against the Blue Wahoos.

Shrimp Have Prospects: On the roster, the Jumbo Shrimp have five players who were listed by *MLB.com* as Top 30 Miami Marlins prospects for the 2018 season: OF Monte Harrison (1), Isan Diaz (7), RHP Nick Neidert (8), RHP Pablo Lopez (21), and John Norwood (30).

LAST START: Poteet suffered his third straight loss in his start on Sunday June 8 against the Birmingham Barons at Regions Field. Poteet worked six innings where he allowed five runs (two earned) on eight hits with a walk and six strikeouts as the Shrimp lost 8-1.

BRAVES LOSS: Poteet suffered his second straight loss in his start on Saturday May 26 against the Mississippi Braves at Trustmark Park. Poteet worked two and two-thirds innings, allowing a season-high seven runs (all earned) on eight hits with a walk and six strikeouts as Jacksonville trailed 7-0 when he left, and lost 8-4.

BAYBEARS LOSS: Poteet suffered a loss pitching his first career complete game in Game One of Jacksonville's doubleheader on Monday May 21 against the Mobile BayBears at the Baseball Grounds. Poteet worked all seven innings, allowing a run on six hits with two walks and five strikeouts. The run he allowed came in the first on a Zach Houchins RBI double, and next six innings were scoreless, and Jacksonville lost 1-0.

FIRST SHUCKERS START: Poteet suffered his second loss of the season despite turning in a quality start on Saturday May 5 against the Biloxi Shuckers at MGM Park. Poteet turned in six innings where he allowed one run on four hits with four walks and six strikeouts, as Jacksonville lost 1-0.

PROSPECT BUZZ: Poteet had been regarded as Baseball America's No. 14 Marlins prospect entering the 2017 season, but fell out of the Top 30 rankings in the Marlins farm system for the 2018 season. Poteet had been Miami's No. 19 prospect entering 2016.

#20 CODY POTEET RHP | 6-1, 180 lbs | Born: San Diego, Calif. Age: 23

Selected by the Miami Marlins in the fourth round of the 2015 draft out of UCLA.

2017 Highlights: Poteet had success in 2017 with the High-A Jupiter Hammerheads. With Jupiter Poteet was a 2017 League Midseason All-Star and Marlins Organizational All-Star. Poteet with the Hammerheads was 2-3 with a 2.53 ERA in seven starts in the first half of the season, eventually going 3-7 with a 4.16 ERA in his 14 starts. Poteet was selected by the Marlins in the fourth round of the 2015 draft out of UCLA. In home games at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium, Poteet was 2-4 with a 3.30 ERA in eight appearances and six starts, while on the road Poteet was 1-3 with a 5.20 ERA in his eight starts away from Jupiter.

2016 Highlights: Poteet spent all of 2016 with the Single-A Greensboro Grasshoppers. With Greensboro he was 3-7 with a 4.16 ERA in 16 appearances and 14 starts. He was 3-5 with a 2.43 ERA in 13 starts in the first half of the year, while going 1-4 with a 3.48 ERA in 11 starts in the second half of the season.

2015 Highlights: After he was selected by the Marlins in the fourth round of the draft out of UCLA, Poteet spent time at rookie level Batavia in the New York-Penn League. With the Muckdogs he was 0-1 with a 2.13 ERA in five appearances and four starts.

College: Poteet was part of a strong pitching staff at UCLA that included Yankees first rounder James Kaprielian and closer David Berg, a second round pick by the Cubs in 2015. In 2015 Poteet was 7-1 with a 2.45 ERA in 27 appearances and 13 starts as he transitioned to being a mid-week starter for the Bruins. Honorable Mention Pac-12 All-Academic selection in 2015. Sunday starter in 2014, going 3-5 with a 4.46 ERA in 17 appearances and 15 starts. In 2013 as a freshman was a midweek starter, going 4-6 with a 4.84 ERA in 29 appearances and 11 starts. In summer of 2014 pitched in the Cape Cod League for the Yarmouth-Dennis Red Sox, going 4-0 with a 3.09 ERA in seven starts. In summer of 2013 pitched in the West Coast League for the Walla Walla Sweets, going 3-2 with a 3.78 ERA with 27 strikeouts in 38 innings pitched.

Personal: Three-year varsity baseball letterwinner at Christian High School (El Cajon, Calif.) under head coach Michael Mitchell...selected in the 27th round of the 2012 MLB Draft by the Washington Nationals. Batted .509 with 55 hits, 13 doubles, 20 stolen bases, 23 RBI and 45 runs as a junior in 2011, pitching 17.2 innings that season...broke school records with 55 hits and a .509 batting average in 2011...did not play for Christian in 2012, instead competing for club team ABD Bulldogs ... went 10-1 with a 2.10 ERA and 112 strikeouts in 66.2 innings pitched for the Bulldogs in 2012.
