BACK IN ACTION: Tonight, the Hooks begin a stretch of 20 games in 20 days with the first of four against Frisco. Corpus Christi sealed its fourth consecutive series victory with a 10-9 triumph over Northwest Arkansas Tuesday night at Whataburger Field. The back-and fourth affair featured six lead changes, with the clubs combining for 26 hits. The Naturals got to Kyle Smith and Jacob Dorris for seven runs in the first four innings. Ruben Sosa's two-run double in the third and Samir Duenez's three-run home run in the fourth were key swings for the Naturals. Tyler Thornton blanked Northwest Arkansas from the fourth through the eighth, allowing just one hit. Mauricio Ramos belted a two-run home run against him in the ninth. Sosa's double put the tying run in scoring position but Thornton was able to retire the next three hitters to seal the victory.

Drew Ferguson, J.D. Davis and Alejandro Garcia each recorded multi-hit performances for the Hooks. Ferguson went 3-for-5 with a pair of doubles, one run and an RBI. Davis belted a pivotal three-run homer in the third and added a two-bagger in the fifth. Later in the frame, Trent Woodward finished an 11-pitch at-bat by sending an RBI single through the right side. A two-out RBI single by Antonio Nunez gave the Hooks their third and final advantage of the night. Ferguson, Davis and Ramon Laureano open play this evening riding seven-game hit streaks.

ROSTER UPDATE: The Astros made a number of moves affecting Corpus Christi's roster this afternoon. LHP Sean Stutzman and RHP Ryan Thompson have been promoted to Triple-A Fresno. RHP Andrew Thome joins Corpus Christi from Advanced-A Buies Creek, and OF Bobby Boyd has been activated from the disabled list. Thompson posted a 4.15 ERA in 4 appearances for the Hooks, striking out 8 against 2 walks in 8.2 IP. He retired 10 of the first 11 men he faced Monday before surrendering a bases-loaded triple to Logan Moon in the 13th inning.

Stutzman joined Corpus Christi from extended spring training late last week. He fired 3 innings of 1-run ball Monday against the Naturals, and struck out 5 of the 7 men he faced in his Double-A debut April 13 against the Travelers. This marks the first Triple-A stint for both Stutzman and Thompson.

Thome took the loss Tuesday at Myrtle Beach, surrendering 6 runs (4 ER) on 4 hits (1 HR) in an inning of work. The 24-year-old sinkerballer had spun 5.1 scoreless innings over 3 outings to begin his season with Buies Creek. Thome posted a 3.11 ERA with Quad Cities and Lancaster last year, going 9 for 11 in save chances. In April, he made 7 appearances while holding a 1.10 ERA over 16.1 innings. Thome debuted with Lancaster on May 27 vs. High Desert, firing 2 scoreless innings of relief. He did not allow a run through 7.1 innings (3 appearances) to begin his time with the JetHawks. Thome was tabbed Lancaster Pitcher of the Month for August (13 1/3 IP, 1.35 ERA, 2 SV), and held a post All-Star break ERA of 2.43.

Boyd began the year in extended, recovering from a leg injury. The 24-year-old from Silver Spring, MD, hit .274 with 82 runs, 16 doubles, 10 triples, 9 home runs and 59 RBIs in 105 games between Lancaster and Corpus Christi last season. Boyd ranked 3rd in the Astros system in stolen bases, swiping 37 bags in 48 attempts (77% success rate). A California League Midseason All-Star, he batted .328 with 44 runs, 11 doubles, 3 triples, 5 homers, 27 RBIs and 27 stolen bases (6 CS) in 48 first-half contests. Boyd reached base at a .379 clip, and strung together an 11-game hit streak April 8-24. He belted a grand slam May 26 vs. Stockton as part of a season-best 4-hit and a career-high 9-RBI night. He had plated 8 runs in the 29 games leading up to this performance. The contest, which Lancaster won 29-11, was later dubbed MiLB.com's 2016 Game of the Year.

Named Lancaster's Player of the Month for June after batting .310 with a .389 on-base average. Boyd reached in all 20 of his June assignments. At the time of his Cal League departure, he ranked among circuit leaders in steals (T-3rd) and runs (5th). Promoted to the Texas League in mid-August, and recorded a 9-game hit streak to begin Hooks tenure. Went 4-for-13 (.308) with 3 runs, 1 double, 1 homer and 4 RBIs in the Texas League South Division Series vs. Midland. For the season, manned all 3 outfield positions (34 GM in LF, 26 GM in RF & 20 GM in CF), registering 10 assists and 5 errors in 178 total chances.

QUITE OFFENSIVE: Corpus Christi has scored 27 runs on 41 hits in the last 3 games. Since being shutout by Arkansas last Thursday, the Hooks are hitting .316 with 12 doubles, 6 home runs, 33 RBIs and a .889 OPS in 5 contests.

IN A GROOVE: J.D. Davis enjoyed a monster homestand, batting .435 with 2 doubles, 2 home runs and 6 RBIs in 6 games vs. Arkansas and Northwest Arkansas. Davis has recorded 2 hits in each of his last 4 assignments, and enters tonight's game riding a 7-game hit streak.
