HOOKS HAMMER 'HOUNDS IN SERIES OPENER: The Hooks put together another offensive outburst on Wednesday night, beating the Midland RockHounds 11-6 in the opener of a four-game series. The Hooks have now won six straight games. Corpus Christi jumped out to an early lead against Midland starter Joel Seddon and would never relinquish it. Carmen Benedetti, who was returning from a stint on the disabled list, ripped a two-run triple in the second inning to give the Hooks a 2-0 edge. Anibal Sierra then hit an RBI single to make it 3-0. The Hooks then tacked on four more runs in the third against Midland reliever Cody Stull. Sierra collected a two-run single while Chas McCormick and Andy Pineda both notched run-scoring hits.

On the mound, right-hander Jorge Alcala gave up a run three early runs but settled down for the win. Alcala tossed six innings while allowing just those three runs and striking out four batters. The RockHounds trailed 8-3 heading into the seventh. Edwin Diaz cut the deficit to 8-5 with a two-run single against righty Ronel Blanco. In the top of the eighth, Lorenzo Quintana continued his hot hitting with a two-out, two-run triple into left centerfield to give the Hooks a 10-5 lead. Alex Winkelman came on to pitch in the eighth and locked down the victory with two solid frames.

CIONEL MAKES BIG LEAGUE DEBUT: LHP Cionel Perez was called up to the Houston Astros on Wednesday and made his Major League debut in Houston's 8-3 loss to Oakland. Perez entered the ballgame in the eighth inning, tossing a scoreless frame while allowing a hit and striking out a batter. He returned for the ninth inning and recorded the first two outs of the frame, ultimately throwing a total of 1.2 IP while allowing an earned run on two hits and striking out two batters.

This was Perez's second promotion to the big leagues. The 22-year-old was called up on June 29 and spent a couple of days with Houston, but was never brought into a game. He is the 102nd player in the 14-year history of the Hooks to make their major league debut. The hard-throwing southpaw is the first player to go directly to "The Show" from Corpus Christi since 2015 when RHP Michael Feliz, RHP Lance McCullers Jr., and RHP Vincent Velasquez earned received the call to Houston.

Perez registered a 6-1 record and 1.98 ERA in 16 games (11 starts) with Corpus Christi this season. He recorded 83 strikeouts and 22 walks in 68.1 innings pitched.

MINOR LEAGUE, MAJOR SUCCESS: Corpus Christi has won 10 of their last 11 games and are at a season-best 28 games over .500. The club's overall mark of 58-30 (.659) is the best overall winning percentage in Double-A. The Hooks own the second-best overall winning percentage among Minor League Baseball's full-season clubs, with the Midwest League's Bowling Green Hot Rods (Tampa Bay) the only club better at 60-29 (.674). The Texas League South first-half champs are 30-9 since May 26.

NO QUESTIONS FOR QUINTANA: Hooks catcher Lorenzo Quintana put together a record setting night on Monday in Corpus Christi's 15-6 win to complete a series sweep of Northwest Arkansas, belting a trio of homers in his first three at-bats of the game. He then went 1-for-3 with 2 RBI and 2 runs scored in Wednesday night's victory at Midland. In the last two games, Quintana is a combined 4-6 with three homers, 8 RBI, and 7 runs scored. Quintana also stole two bases on Wednesday night.

Quintana became the third player in club history to record a three-homer game, joining the ranks of J.D. Davis (2016) and Domingo Santana (2013). His five runs scored in the contest also set a new club record. Monday night marked Quintana's second multi-homer game of the year. Of the Cuban native's eight home runs this season, seven have come at the expense of Northwest Arkansas.

HELLO, HECTOR!: RHP Hector Perez was promoted to Corpus Christi from High-A Buies Creek on July 10. Perez is considered Houston's seventh-best pitching prospect, according to MLB.com.

Perez went 3-3 with a 3.84 ERA in 17 games (11 starts) in 72.2 innings in the Carolina League. At the time of his promotion, he leads the circuit in batting average against (.196) and is tied for second in strikeouts (83).

BIG TIME BATS: The Hooks set season-highs in runs (15) and hits (20) in Monday night's 15-6 win at Whataburger Field and exploded again for 11 runs on 13 hits in last night's win. Corpus Christi also had a nine-run outburst in Sunday's victory. The Hooks have scored 38 runs combined in the last four games.

Corpus Christi's offense has been impressive all season, as the team leads the Texas League in batting average (.287) and runs scored (491). CC is averaging 5.5 runs per game during the campaign.

BIG TIME ARMS: Corpus Christi's pitching staff has been sensational since the All-Star break (13 games) Hooks pitching holds a 2.50 ERA (32 ER) in 115.1 innings pitched.

Corpus Christi's 4-0 shutout of Northwest Arkansas on Saturday night was the team's seventh shutout victory of the season. The staff's 3.46 ERA is second in the Texas League while their 839 total strikeouts top the circuit.

SUPER SPEEDY: Corpus Christi's aggressive baserunning has been consistent from Opening Day, as the Hooks lead the Texas League with 118 stolen bases this season. Stephen Wrenn leads active Texas League players with 28 stolen bases in 2018. The only player to register a higher total is former Hooks Of Myles Straw, who collected 35 swiped bags before being promoted to Triple-A Fresno.
